The certification should manifest that the proposed or existing tourism facilities is within the ambit of the forest land use plan as incorporated in its comprehensive land use plan and approved tourism framework plan for the locality.

In addition to the abovementioned requirements, you are hereby instructed to submit an inspection report relative to the subject application which shall also include 100% timber inventory and photo documentation with geotags.
