

NIPA PALM PLANTING ACTIVITY AT BRGY. BULIASNIN, BOAC, MARINDUQUE ON JUNE 7, 2022

On June 7, 2022, the Marinduque State College (MSC) under the Research Extension office headed by Dr. Doreen Mascareñas and ENR Ambassadors conducted a Nipa Palm Planting activity at Brgy. Buliasnin Boac, Marinduque.

NIPA PALM PLANTING ACTIVITY IN CELEBRATION OF WORLD OCEANS DAY AND CORAL TRIANGLE DAY AT BRGY. LAON, MOGPOG, MARINDUQUE ON JUNE 9, 2022

In Line ith the Local Celebration of World Oceans Day (WOD) and Coral Triangle Day (CT Day), the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office-Marinduque planted one hundred fifty (150) palm seedlings of Nipa (*Nypa fruticans*) winthin Enhanced National Greening Pogram (NGP) area at Brgy. Laon, Mogpog, Marinduque on June 9, 2022.

This activity was participated by the Philippine National Police (PNP), Marinduque State College (MSC)-ENR Ambassador and Barangay Local Government Unit (BLGU) of Laon, Mogpog, Marinduque.
