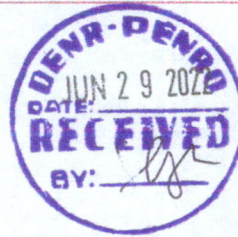

PROCEEDINGS OF THE COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT MEETING

Date : May 12, 2022
Venue : Camarin Multipurpose Hall, Brgy. Cambajao, Cajidiocan, Romblon

A. Preliminaries

- The prayer was led by Chieftain Novie Presaldo.
- Singing of the Philippine National Anthem by EcoMS I Mylene Evallar.
- Introduction of DENR staff and participants by Park Ranger April Montero.
- Brgy. Captain Brenda Rocero gave her welcome address stating her gladness having that meeting for her constituents/IP community to have knowledge about the basic forest laws and for them to share it with their peers. She also acknowledged the presence of the DENR staffs and the IP community. She also hoped that the topic that will be discussed that day will be absorbed and apply it when they returned to their respective community.
- Chieftain Novie Presaldo gave his message as well. He first acknowledged the presence of the DENR staffs for organizing a meeting to discuss the basic forest laws for their own benefit. Then, he promised that all the topics regarding the basic forest laws will be absorbed and will be applied on their community. He also stated that their community is committed in protecting and conserving our natural resources.
- Next is the inspirational message by Forest Ranger Ludwin Ruado. He acknowledged the presence of the participants attending the meeting. He assured that every DENR staffs are ready to impart their knowledges regarding the basic forest laws including Chainsaw act, PD 705, Wild life act, solid waste management and awareness about climate change. He appreciated the commitment of the IP community as partner of the DENR in protecting and conserving the natural resources of Sibuyan Island.

B. Highlights of the Event


- The meeting started with the first topic about importance of Sibuyan Island discussed by Forest Ranger Andy Regla. He asked the participants about how important the Sibuyan Island is for them. Chieftain Novie Presaldo said that Sibuyan Island is really important for them since it is the main source of their livelihood. FR Andy Regla discussed the history of Sibuyan Island and the essence of it to every Sibuyanons. He ended up his discussion by saying "Protektahan naton ang isla ng Sibuyan kay aton ini"
- FT-I Ernie Forcadas discussed the wildlife act. He first asked the participants if they knew someone who sells endemic plants and animals then followed up by educating them that possession, selling or collecting of wildlife is strictly prohibited. He also introduced some of the endemic plants and animals. Finally, he asks the commitment of the participants coupled with DENR on protecting the wildlife.
- Next, FT-I Ludito Rada acknowledged the presence of the participants. He then discussed the Chainsaw Act. Educating everyone that if ever they are planning to buy chainsaw they should comply all the requirements needed for it to be registered and they should buy it only on a registered and legal manufacturer.
- FR John Calven Galisanao give a short discussion regarding land matters.
- FT-I Ramer Manalon discussed about PD705. He first classified the forest products including trees, pulp wood, fire wood, bark of trees, resin, wood oil, honey, beeswax, etc. He explained that any person who shall collect, gathered, or possessed any kind of forest products from any forest lands, public or private without any license/permit agreement shall be guilty of qualified theft as punishable under the revised penal code and then discussed other provisions of PD705. He ended up the discussion by notifying everyone




that we should not abuse our nature and we should continue protecting and preserving our biodiversity.

- FR Andy Regla gave his short discussion about ENIPAS act which pertains to the rights given to the Natives. He also shared that the legislation of Mt. Guiting -Guiting Natural Park was done with the enactment of ENIPAS.
- FR Dalvern Fesarit gave his discussion about solid waste management. He shared that garbages should be segregated into biodegradable and non-biodegradable. As per FR Fesarit, participants can make a compost pit for them to put their biodegradable wastes. In that way we could lessen the wastes at the same time we are also helping our environment.
- Last discussion about Climate Change was given by FR Mark Adonis Romero. He first shared why we are experiencing climate change. After that he asked the participants about what they can do to help our environment to lessen the effects brought by climate change. Chieftain Novie Presaldo answered that the easy way to help our environment is to plant more trees. FR Romero agreed with Chieftain Presaldo's answer. At the end of his discussion, he inspired the participants by sharing the benefits of planting trees.
- After the discussions, DENR staffs assisted the participants on their lunch break.
- Later on, open forum was conducted. Participant Reynaldo Diego asks regarding the assistance that the DENR might offer to avoid landslide. EcoMS I Mylene Evallar answered that we can provide seedlings of fast-growing trees like Acacia Mangium, Mahogany, and Gmelina wherein they can plant on their communities. FT-I Ramer Manalon added that the DENR had a National Greening Program wherein they are the one who is in-charge of the plant seedlings. He also said that if ever the participants could identify a public land on their community, some of the DENR staffs will go there to conduct an inspection then organize a tree planting activity there. FR Andy Regla also added that they need to tell their concerns to the PAMB to have a fund regarding the tree plantation on their community to avoid landslide. Reynaldo Diego also asks about the assistance of the DENR regarding the watershed, according to him the watershed resource deteriorate because of the illegal forest activities done by the people outside their vicinity. FT-I Manalon told him that the reason why it happened is because of the lack of trees, he also added that kaingin farming was happening within their ancestral domain. The upland people are the one who's responsible on protecting that since that is their respective area. On the other hand, FT-I Manalon said that if they noticed someone who's doing illegal forest activities they can coordinate with the DENR and also to their Barangay officials.
- After the open forum, the participants elected their Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson for the formation of Forest Protection Community Volunteers (FPCV). Mr. Novie Presaldo as their Chairperson and Mr. Proseso Diego as their Vice-Chairperson.
- To end the gathering, FT-I Rolando Galicia gave his closing remarks. The meeting was ended at exactly 3:30 pm.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT MEETING

Date : May 13, 2022
Venue : Brgy. Hall of Lumbang Weste, Cajidiocan, Romblon

A. Preliminaries

- Invocation was led by Mr. Ramon Regala.
- It was followed by singing of the Philippine National Anthem led by EcoMS I Mylene Evallar.
- Introduction of DENR staff and participants was done by Park Ranger April Montero as the facilitator of the meeting.
- Brgy. Kagawad Ruben Fajilan gave his welcome address stating his deepest gratitude as DENR staffs organized a meeting wherein basic forest laws (PD 705), ENIPAS act solid waste management and climate change will be discussed for them to share it with their constituents most specially to the IP community residing near the protected area. As per him, it is very helpful to their community for them to be aware on what to do and what to avoid. He is very much thankful to the DENR on organizing a meeting to impart their knowledges and to inspire their community to protect our beloved nature.
- IPMR Ramon Regala also gave his message. He first acknowledged the presence of the DENR staffs and all the participants for that day. He shared how important for him is the environment. It is where they get their source of living like fruits and vegetables, woods for building a structure and many more. Since they are living in an upland area, they are the one who is responsible on protecting it. Thus, as per him, the meeting organized by the DENR is very much helpful for them.
- Next is the inspirational message by Forest Ranger Ludwin Ruado. He acknowledged the presence of each participants who spent their time to join us as we discuss the necessary topics that may help them deepen their knowledges about the nature. He assured that every DENR staffs are very much eager to impart their knowledges regarding the basic forest laws including Chainsaw act, PD 705, Wild life act, solid waste management and awareness about climate change. He also stated his gratitude for the cooperation given by the Brgy. Officials of Lumbang Weste, Cajidiocan, Romblon in making that meeting possible. To end his message, he said that he just hoped that everyone will absorb the knowledges given by the designated speakers and for them to share it also with their family, friends and peers.

B. Highlights of the Event

- The meeting started with the first topic about importance of Sibuyan Island tackled by Forest Ranger Andy Regla. He asked the participants about their own perception about the importance of Sibuyan island. Some of them answered that it is where they get their food like rootcrops, fruits and vegetables and some of them said that it is where they get woods for building a structure like their house. As per FR Andy Regla, since we are getting our benefit to the nature we should keep protecting and preserving it. He discussed the history of Sibuyan Island and the essence of it to every Sibuyanons and ended up his discussion by saying "Protektahan naton ang isla ng Sibuyan kay aton ini"
- FT-I Ernie Forcadas discussed the wildlife act. He first introduced some of the endemic wildlife that can be found here in Sibuyan then followed by asking the participants if they knew someone who sells endemic plants and animals. He then educated the participants that possession, selling or collecting of wildlife is strictly prohibited. Finally, he asks the commitment of the participants to help the DENR staffs in protecting wildlife. The participants agreed to the commitment.




- FT-I Ramer Manalon discussed about PD705. He first classified the different examples of forest products including trees, pulp wood, fire wood, bark of trees, resin, wood oil, honey, beeswax, etc. He discussed to the participants that if any person who shall collect, gather, or possess any kind of forest products from any forest lands, public or private without any license/permit agreement shall be guilty of qualified theft as punishable under the revised penal code and then discussed other provisions of PD705. He ended up the discussion by notifying everyone that we should not abuse our nature and we should continue protecting and preserving our biodiversity.
- FT-I Rolando Galicia gave his discussion about solid waste management. He shared that wastes should be segregated into biodegradable and non-biodegradable. As per FT-I Galicia, participants can make a compost pit for them to put their biodegradable wastes. He also shared a short story about a sea turtle that is affected by the water pollution brought by the wastes thrown on the sea. He inspired the participants to dispose their wastes properly to avoid the situation stated on his short story. Finally, he said we need to put in our heads the 4R's (Reduce, Reduce, Recycle and Restore).
- Then, the topic about Climate Change was given by FR Mark Adonis Romero. He first asks the participants, on their own knowledge, what are the cause of climate change. Mr. Teddy Palmes answered that one of the causes of climate change is non-proper waste disposal. After that FR Adonis Romero asked the participants about what they can do to help our environment to lessen the effects brought by climate change. Mr Fajilan answered that we need to reduce our wastes and start planting more trees. FR Romero agreed with the answer of Mr. Fajilan. He explained how climate change takes place and what help does the trees provide to reduce the rapid effect of the climate change. At the end of his discussion, he inspired the participants by sharing the benefits of planting trees.
- After that, FT-I Ludito Rada acknowledged the presence of the participants. He then discussed the Chainsaw Act. Educating everyone that if ever they are planning to buy chainsaw they should comply all the requirements needed for it to be registered and they should buy it only on a registered and legal manufacturer. He also stated that when using a chainsaw make sure that the operator must have a cutting permit. Most specially when cutting an endemic tree species. As he explaining it, he said all the necessary requirements to have a cutting permit.
- FR Andy Regla gave his short discussion about ENIPAS act which pertains to the rights given to the Natives. He also shared that the legislation of Mt. Guiting -Guiting Natural Park was done with the enactment of ENIPAS. FR Andy Regla gave some of the law stated on ENIPAS act like hunting of wildlife, collecting of plants or gathering of forest products from the Protected area without PAMB consent is illegal. He also explained the PAMB that stands for Protected Area Management Board, which includes the Congressman, Governor, all Mayors of each municipality, Brgy. Captains of Barangays that are close to the PA, and other Government and Non-government agencies. PAMB is the one that leads the people in taking care of the Protected Area.
- After the discussions, DENR staffs assisted the participants on their lunch break.
- Later on, open forum was conducted. Kagawad Osmundo Ramiro asked if they are going to register the chainsaw of their Barangay even if it is only used for road clearing once a typhoon hit our province. FR Ludwin Ruado answered yes and they must comply all of the requirements needed for it to be registered. Kagawad Ramiro asked again that if ever someone from their barangay asked a permission to the Barangay Captain to cut a tree for personal use and someone reported it to the DENR without coordinating with the Barangay officials and the DENR staffs went to the area to verify it, is the permission from the



Barangay officials valid? FR Ruado answered that it is case to case basis. Any person is not allowed to cut a tree specially if it is natural grown trees. Not unless if it is within their private area providing that they have a cutting permit from the DENR and registered chainsaw. If the tree is classified as a fast-growing tree then it may also be considered but it depends on the inspection that will be done by the Forester/Forest Technicians of the DENR.

- After the open forum, the participants elected their Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson for the formation of Forest Protection Community Volunteers (FPCV). Kagawad Teddy Palmes as their Chairperson, Kagawad Osmundo Ramiro as their Vice-Chairperson and Kagawad Illuminada Mejido as their secretary.
- To end the gathering, FR Ludwin Ruado gave his closing remarks. The meeting was ended at exactly 3:55 pm.


