


SUBJECT : REPORT ON THE MONITORING ACTIVITIES OF WILDLIFE
ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OF PENRO MARINDUQUE FOR
THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER CY 2022

In accordance with the target of this Office under Operation against illegal environment and natural resources Mobilization of Wildlife Enforcement Officers (WEO), please be informed that the undersigned personnel of Monitoring and Enforcement Section conducted the following activities covering the period of October 18, 2022 to November 22, 2022 in relation with the aforementioned subject target, to wit;

- On October 18, 2022, Forest Technician I Michael Vencint M. Sualog and FT I Randy R. Pantoja facilitated the turn-over of one (1) Brahminy Kite (*Haliastur indus*) which was turned over by Mr. Edward A. Montenegro of Brgy. Buliasnin, Boac, Marinduque. The said wildlife was released in Barangay Bantay, Boac, Marinduque.
- On October 19, 24, 26-27, 2022 & November 02-03, 08, 10, 14-15, 17, & 22, 2022 Forest Ranger Jonathan Telan, FR Menchie Randovan, Forester I Bernadine I. Jasul and Jelomy H. Mahayag conducted the actual inventory of butterfly permittee. A total of Ninety Four (94) Local Transport Permit with different butterflies species such as *Danaus Genutia*, *Attacus Atlas*, *P. Romansubia*, *I. Leuconoe*, *Vindula Dejone*, *P. Valeria*, *P. Rumansubia*, *P. Demoteus*, *P. Palinurus*, *Danaus*, *Chrysippus*, *P. Lowi*, *A. Semperi*, *Troides*, *Rhadamantus*, *Romansovia*, *Appias Albina*, *Graphium Agamemnon*, *Euploea Mulciber*, *Hecabe*, were inventoried and documented in preparation for the application of Local Transport Permit.

**SUBJECT : TURNED-OVER OF ONE (1) BRAHMINY KITE (*Haliastur indus*)
IN BARANGAY BULIASNIN, BOAC MARINDUQUE**

Respectfully forwarded is the report of FT I Michael Vencint M. Sualog et.al dated 20 October 2022, relative to the turned-over of one (1) Brahminy Kite (*Haliastur indus*).

Per report, the said wildlife was turned-over to this office by a certain Edward M. Montenegro of Brgy. Buliasnin, Boac, Marinduque and received by the personnel of this Office for assessment and observations. It was recognized as a Brahminy Kite (*Haliastur indus*) and considered a least concern species. There is no injury or fracture on its body. As per interview with Edward A. Montenegro, said wildlife was unintentionally knocked against the canal wall and fell into the water on October 16, 2022 in the afternoon. Its wingspan is 90 centimeters, and it is in good enough physical condition to be released into its habitat. Thus, on October 18, 2022, the said wildlife was released in Barangay Bantay, Boac, Marinduque.

SUBJECT : REPORT ON THE RESCUE AND RELEASE OF ONE BRAHMINY KITE

Respectfully submitted is the report on the Rescue and Release of One Brahminy Kite to wit;

Mr. Dante M. De Luna verbally coordinated this office on October 17, 2022 about the report of Mr. Roel Merlin, a security guard in the Provincial Capitol, that a wildlife was rescued by some Edward A. Montenegro in Barangay Buliasnin, Boac, Marinduque.

Accordingly, at around 2:00 PM of the same day, the undersigned proceeded to the area and coordinated with the Barangay LGU of Buliasnin to verify the report. Kagawad Charlie S. Magalang, the barangay official on duty, confirmed that Mr. Montenegro is a resident of Brgy. Buliasnin and accompanied the team to the area where the wildlife is temporarily confined.

During the interview with Mr. Montenegro, on October 16, 2022 at around 1:00 PM while he was going to the rice field to gather their harvest, he noticed that a bird was stocked in the irrigation canal. He immediately went to the area to check it. In his assumptions, while the bird is going to capture its prey, it accidentally bumped against the wall of the canal and fell into the water that cause in unable to fly. He rescued the wildlife and brought it home. Upon seeing the wildlife, it was identified as Brahminy Kite (*Haliastur indus*).

Mr. Edward A. Montenegro voluntarily turned-over the bird to the team for further observation and necessary action. The team placed the wildlife to a comfortable cage, brought to this office to monitor its physical condition in order to determine whether it needs to be rehabilitated or it is fit to release back to the wild.


On October 18, 2022, it was decided to free the Brahminy Kite because there was no observable physical injuries and it is showing a very active behavior that are signs that it is fit for release and can survive to the wild. Before the release, the undersigned together with FT-II Carlo M. Watiwat coordinated with BLGU Bantay to inform them that a wildlife will be

released in their area. Eventually, the activity was conducted together with Brgy. Captain Renato L. Lope of Brgy. Bantay, Boac, Marinduque,

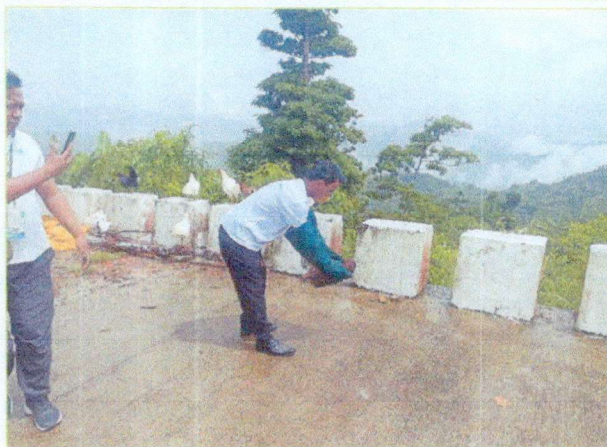
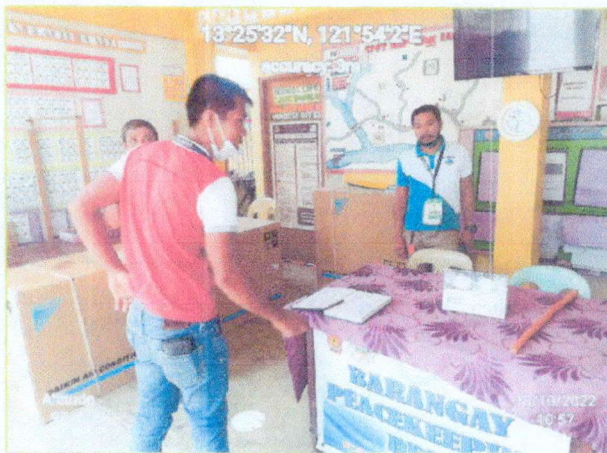
