

Mining Act of 1995 Production Value refers to the total value or gross output of mineral extracted during the reporting period as defined in Chapter 1. Section 5 of the Revised IRR of the Phil

(under the term "Gross Output")

on the prevailing Estimated extraction fee payable refers to an estimate of the total extraction fee to be paid by the permittee covering the production during the reporting period and based

Extraction fee rate in the province city

Sales Quantity refers to the total volume of mineral sold during the reporting period expressed in cubic meter
Sales Value refers to the value of mineral sold during the reporting period. This value includes all cost of production, taxes invoiced to purchased, transport & trade mark-

Estimated Excise Tax Payable refers to an estimate of the total excise tax on minerals to be paid by the permittee to the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) covering the production during the reporting period and based on the rate prescribed by Section 217 (b) of the Revised IRR of the Mining Act of 1995
