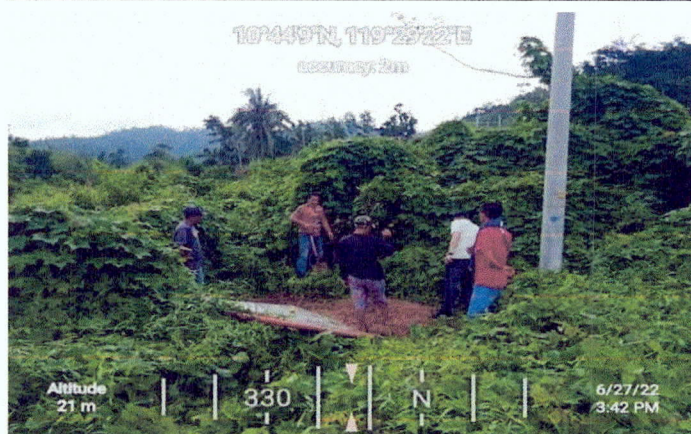

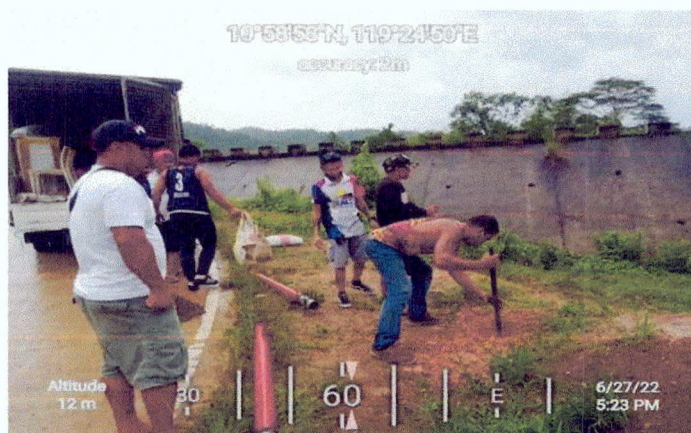


Photo showing during and after installation of the PA Signage at Barangay Cataban, Taytay, Palawan

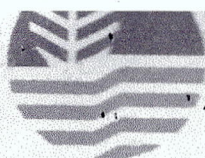


