Ang Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary o RIWS ay kinilala bilang isang **PROTECTED AREA (PA)** noong ita-15 ng Pebrero taong 2006, alinsunod sa Presidential Proclamation No. 1000 dahil sa taglay nitong lihas-yaman at samit saring buhay-iliang na kinakalangang pangalagaan at protektahan na may kabunang lawak na 1,983.86 hektarya.

- Bago pa man madeklarang PA, ang isla ay pinangangasiwaan na ng Katala Foundation, Inc. (KFI), isang Non-Government Organization (NGO) na naglalayong pangalagaan, protektahan at paramihin ang populasyon ng mga buhay-iliang gaya ng Katala.

- Sa kasalukuyan, ang isla ay pinangangasiwaan ng DENR-PAMO sa tulong ng Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) at KFI.

Ang mga bulaklak, buto at nektar ay nagsisilbing mga pagkain ng mga katala at iba pang uri ng hayop na nabubuhay sa isla.

Ang mga punong kahoy at bakawan ay nagsisilbing tirahan ng mga Katala at iba pang buhay liang at marine species.

Ang mangrove forest ay nagsisilbing harang sa daluyong, alon, malalakas na hangin o bagyo.

Ang mga punong kahoy at bakawan ay nakakatulong din upang mapigilan ang pagbabago ng klima.

Ang pagtaas ng populasyon ng marine resources ay maaaring pagkunan ng pagkain at hanapbuhay.

## Mga Likas-Yaman o Buhay-iliang

bird species

Gaya ng Katala, Bahad, Pikoy, Owl, White-bellied Sea eagle at marami pang iba (Widmann, Widmann 2008), kung saan ang populasyon ng Katala ay tinatantirang may higit kumulang na 304-388 indibidwal (Widmann 2018).

**68 species** ng punong halaman at bakawan ang makikita sa loob ng RIWS gaya Bugo, lanete, Taluto, Natio, Ipi at iba (Sopsop 2011);

**8 species** ng seagrass (*E. acoroides*, *T. hemprichi*, *H. ovalis*, *C. rotundata*, etc.);

**24 species** ng Malacofauna (sea cucumber species, bivalves, gastropods, etc.), **45 species** of gastropods and **19 species** of bivalves (Dolorosa et al. 2015);

**3 species** ng marine sea turtles (hawksbill turtle, green sea turtle at leatherback turtle); at

Marine mammals gaya ng dugong, bottlenose dolphin, spotted dolphin at short-finned pilot whale.

## Kahalagahan ng Seagrass at Corals

Ang coral reefs ay nagsisilbing tirahan ng mga isda at iba pang marine species;

Ang seagrass ay nagsisilbing pagkain ng mga marine sea turtles;

Nakatatulong din upang mapigilan ang pagbabago ng klima dahil pinapanatili nito ang tamang temperatura ng dagat;

Ang pagtaas ng populasyon ng marine resources ay maaaring pagkunan ng pagkain at hanap buhay.

Tinatayang 97% na napigigilan ang lakas ng alon na humahampas sa baybayin.
