(WTMU) FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER 2022

This is in compliance with PENRO Special Order No. 010 dated February 07, 2022 relative on the creation of teams of Wildlife Traffic Monitoring Unit within the province of Marinduque covering the period of November 22, 2022 to December 15, 2022 to wit;

- On November 22-24, 2022 Forest Rangers Florante G. Fandialan Jr., FR Rica Quennie D. Radovan together with Forest Protection Officers assigned within seaports and airport of Brgy. Buyabod, Sta. Cruz, Marinduque, Brgy. Masiga & Dos Gasan, Marinduque and Barangay Balanacan, Mogpog, Marinduque conducted regular monitoring of possible wildlife transportation. Likewise, conducted coordination within Philippine Port Authority (PPA), Philippine Coast Guard and Terminal Port Manager (TMO) within the area.
- On December 07, 2022 Forest Protection Officer Eduardson N. Buatis assigned within Balanacan Port coordinated with PSSg. John Carlo F. Silo of Philippine Marintime Police regarding the monitoring activity and functions of the team as Wildlife Traffic Monitoring Unit.
- On December 15, 2022 Forest Ranger Jerahmeel Bronce together with Forest Protection Officer assigned within port of Sta.Cruz conducted monitoring of port.

Please be informed that Marinduque Airport within Barangay Masiga, Gasan Marinduque were temporarily closed due to pandemic and their operations were temporarily stop.

As to wildlife and forest products/minerals, no transportation was monitored during the said period.

Further, informational materials such as flyers regarding Republic Act No. 9147 "Wildlife Conservation and Protection Act" and other DENR forestry laws, rules and regulations were also distributed as part of public awareness. Hanging of tarpaulin was also displayed inside the premises of port.














PORTS AND AIRPORT ON NOVEMBER 22-24, 2022

This is in compliance with PENRO Special Order No. 010 dated February 07, 2022 relative On the creation of teams of Wildlife Traffic Monitoring Unit within the province of Marinduque covering the period of Novembe 22-142022.

Please be informed that on November 22, 2022, the undersigned conducted monitoring of Sea Ports of Brgy Buyabod, Santa Cruz, Marinduque and coordinated with CG Yarias, there were regular passenger boat travelling from Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro to Marinduque and vice versa and no possible transport/travel of Wildlife species.

On November 23, 2022, the undersigned went to the seaport of Barangay Poblacion-Dos, Gasan, Marinduque, and coordinated with CG SN1 Ynuardi M. Mallorca, there were regular passenger boat travelling from Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro to Marinduque and vice versa. Afterwards went straight to Marinduque Airport, Masiga, Gasan, Marinduque, still there were no schedule of flights. In Cawit Pier, there were no available schedule of departure and arrival of boats.

On November 24, 2022, the monitoring was also conducted at Balanacan Port, Mogpog Marinduque and coordinated with Pat Errol B. Estayo, for the continuous monitoring of wildlife trade and transport.

As to wildlife and forest products/minerals, no transportation was monitored during the said period.













