EXISTING FOREST PROTECTED THROUGH LAWIN

FOREST AND BIODIVERSITY PROTECTION SYSTEM

The LAWIN Forest and Biodiversity Protection System are conducted within Protected Area, other isolated timberland and mangrove forest.

The total area of conservation area of Marinduque is approximately 12,255.11 hectares of open forest and 2,634.37 hectares of mangrove forest. If compared to proclaimed timberland the approximate area of upland forest is approximately 15,385.14 hectares while the mangrove forest is approximately 3,721.27 hectares. On the other hand, the proclaimed timberland which is also within the conservation area is 8,826.32 hectares of upland forest and 2,043.36 of mangrove forest. The remaining 4,019.80 hectares that falls within Alienable and Disposable land while 8,236.73 hectares of forest land are not included in the conservation of LAWIN. However, both areas are patrolled regularly by our field personnel.
