Respectfully submitted is the narrative report relative to the above-cited subject.

On January 28, 2002, the DENR through this Office awarded a CBFMA Permit No. RIV-PAL-CBFMA-2002-28 to CARURAY AGRICULTURAL MARKETING ASSOCIATION with 4,470 hectares of forestland to manage and develop in accordance with the CBFM Agreement.

On May 19, 2017, Department of Labor and Employment approved the issuance of its Certificate of Incorporation and changed the name of the organization to CARURAY AGRICULTURAL MARKETING ASSOCIATION. This PO was still chaired by Mrs. Elsie L. Torres with 61 members presently (43 male/18 female).

CAMA was awarded with 50 hectares agro-forestry CARP Project in 2011 and also a beneficiary of NGP Project in 2018 with 35 hectares land area.

On February 23, 2022, the undersigned conducted monitoring on the said CBFM Area and also conducted inventory/assessment on the forest damages due to Typhoon Odette.
