


I. INTRODUCTION

The Community-Based Forest Management (CBFM) is the national strategy for the sustainable development of the country's forest resources and social justice Pursuant to Executive Order No. 263 and Department Administrative Order (DAO) 96-29 The Community Based Forest Management (CBFM) is the national strategy for the sustainable development of the country's forest resources. This program aims to promote the socio-economic upliftment of forest communities and achieving sustainable development and management of forest resources. It recognizes the responsible and efficient utilization by organized and empowered local communities based on sound ecological and economic principles can result to sustainable management of forestlands and resources.

There are ten (10) Community Based Forest Management (CBFM) areas within the administrative jurisdiction of DENR-CENRO San Jose, Occidental Mindoro. The periodic monitoring aims to know the status of the DENR-CARP projects and other related CBFM activities within their respective areas in compliance with the existing rules and regulations, progress in terms of area development, organizational development, project implementation, and the implementation of the approved/affirmed Community Resource Management Framework based on FYWP and Five-year Work Plan. The details of this 4th quarter report for Calendar Year 2022 includes the observations/findings and schedule of activities to be undertaken on the aforementioned CBFM areas including issues and concern encountered by the different People's Organization.

Part of the technical assistance provided to the CBFM partners during the periodic monitoring and assessment is the conduct of a group meeting with some BOD's and members of the association purposely to determine the extent of development undertaken within their respective CBFM areas. The result of the information provided during the meeting including the onsite monitoring and assessment will be the basis in providing them effective recommendations towards sustainable management of their respective CBFM areas.

II. LEGAL BASIS

1. Under Executive Order No. 263, the Community Based Forest Management is a National Strategy to ensure sustainable development of the Country's Forestland Resources and providing mechanisms for its implementation. Thus, the DENR is mandated to work with Local Government Units (LGUs), People's Organizations (POs), Non-Government Organizations (NGOs), Religious Groups, Business and Industry sectors and other concerned organizations to ensure that communities are empowered to initiate and achieve the objectives of this Executive Order (Section No. 6.)
2. Furthermore, FMB Technical Bulletin No. 20 and Section 18 of DAO 2004-29 also indicates that the CRMF is a strategic plan of the community on how to manage and benefit from the forest resources on a sustainable basis. It describes the community's long term vision, aspirations, commitments, and strategies for the protection, rehabilitation, development, and utilization of forest resources. The CRMF shall provide specific activities for the first five (5) years, which shall serve as the Five Year Work Plan of the People's Organization.

Progress Report

The CDS-CBFM personnel conducted periodic monitoring of graduated and current DENR projects with the area of Tatsulok ng Pagkakaisa Community Based Forest Management Association Inc. on November 24, 2022. The CBFM partner is continuously exerting much effort in the maintenance and protection activities within the implemented projects such as CARP and e-NGP projects. Likewise, some members and officers are conduct replanting activities within their respective area using their personal funds.

In addition, The Igit La Primera Eagles Club-Faternal Order of Eagles donated PVC Pipes and Faucets in So. Himamara purposely to cater the water needs of the community within the CBFM area. At present, the newly installed faucets are now functional and the community has already benefited. The Wine and Vinegar production area was also monitored under Comprehensive Agrarian Reform Program (CARP) 2020. As of today, the market of the said product (wine) is being sold to their members while processing all the needed documents as basic requirements. Products will be available at the different stores in the adjacent Barangay and in the Municipality of San Jose.

The TPCBFMAI represented by Chairperson Norbel Atienza and attended Strategic Planning Activity via zoom together with the DENR-CBFM Personnel, CBFM partners within the SAMARICA area, Personnel from CDD Regional Office and CBFM partners from other Regions. The said activity is in preparation with the upcoming 2023-2032 CBFM Strategic Plan Consultation Workshop entitled ‘Supporting Community and Regional Consultation for the Updating of CBFM strategic Plan’.

Since, the CBFM agreement of TPCBFMAI is already expiring and subject for CBFM evaluation and assessment, the DENR CBFM personnel reiterated to some members and officers regarding their duties and responsibilities as CBFM partners and their compliance with the activities indicated in the CBFM agreement. Also, explained the importance of actively participating in all CBFM related activities for the member and officers. A copy of approved/affirmed CRMF and FYWP was already provided to the People’s Organization and

this office is waiting for their request for the cutting/harvesting of their planted trees within their CBFM area in compliance with the existing Laws, Rules and Policies. The PO is required to secure an ECC as indicated in the affirmation sheet duly signed by the Regional Executive Director Lormelyn E. Claudio, *CESO IV*.





Progress Report

A composite team from CDS-CBFM Unit personnel, Barangay Local Government Unit (BLGU) of Poipoy representatives, Officers and members of Madayangdang CBFM association conducted on-site assessment on November 11-12, 2022 to monitor the extent of development undertaken by the members within the awarded CBFM area. As part of the monitoring, the team conducted small group meeting and discuss and resolve issues and concerns of the People's Organization if there is any.

The maintenance and protection activities such as pruning, elimination of vines and continuous foot patrolling is continuously undertaken by the People's Organization as part of their silvicultural treatment of the plantation in order to protect established plantations from timber poachers, illegal entry and collection of forest resources and an intensive and continuous foot patrolling is undertaken. The installed PVC pipes monuments along the boundary of the CBFM area are maintained and protected.

The MCBFMAI represented by Chairperson Herminio De Pedro attended Strategic Planning Activity via zoom together with the DENR-CBFM Personnel, CBFM partners within the SAMARICA including the CBFM Federation President of Occidental Mindoro Mr. Norbel Atienza, Personnel from CDD Regional Office and CBFM partners from other Regions. The said activity is in preparation with the upcoming 2023-2032 CBFM Strategic Plan Consultation Workshop entitled 'Supporting Community and Regional Consultation for the Updating of CBFM strategic Plan'.

The members of the Organization are still engaged in hog-raising, carabao and goat-raising, and planting of various agricultural crops. Most of the members are hired and being paid for their daily services rendered in the farm lots of certain individuals and construction projects within the CBFM area and adjoining Brgy's. of Calintaan, Occidental Mindoro to sustain their

daily needs. Also, inventory of planted trees within the CBFM area was completed as one of the activities in the formulation of CRMF & FYWP.







Progress Report

On November 4 & 10, 2022, monitoring was conducted by CDS-CBFM Unit personnel, Barangay Local Government Unit (BLGU) representatives, Officers and members of Canturoy CBFM association conducted on-site assessment on November 4 & 10, 2022 to monitor the extent development undertaken by the members within the awarded CBFM area.

Maintenance of the constructed Small Water Impounding System (SWIS) is regularly undertaken and created committee of the PO to oversee the above stated water facility and to assure the continuous flow of water supply. Also, Majority of the members of the community are still engaged in hog-raising, carabao and goat-raising, and planting of various agricultural crops. Some CBFM members engaged in sari-sari (put-up) stores as an additional source of income to sustain their daily needs. Most of the members are hired and being paid for their daily services rendered in the farm lots of certain individuals, construction projects within the CBFM area, and adjoining Brgy of Manoot, Rizal, Occidental Mindoro to sustain their daily needs.

The Canturoy CBFM Association represented by Chairperson Danilo Z. Roca attended Strategic Planning Activity via zoom together with the DENR-CBFM Personnel, CBFM partners within the SAMARICA including the CBFM Federation President of Occidental Mindoro Mr. Norbel Atienza, Personnel from CDD Regional Office and CBFM partners from other Regions. The said activity is in preparation with the upcoming 2023-2032 CBFM Strategic Plan Consultation Workshop entitled ‘Supporting Community and Regional Consultation for the Updating of CBFM strategic Plan’.

Harvesting of planted trees within the CBFM area is ongoing. Based on the monitoring, the People’s Organization has already transported 396 pieces of Gmelina lumber with a total volume of 5,922.42 bdft. All record/data was recorded and kept by the CBFM Secretary for future references and to determine the total volume of harvest as indicated in the affirmed/approved CRMF. Likewise, Most of the members are collecting wildlings/seeds in preparation of their seedling production as part of their activities to be undertaken as indicated in the FYWP.



Also, woven mangyan textiles, tribal beaded bracelet and necklaces are locally sold to prospected/interested buyer in the municipality of San Jose and adjoining municipalities in the province as additional source of income of the members. As of today, construction of awarded Small Water Impounding Structure is on-going for the provision of water supply for the forest nursery to be planted on the established e-NGP CY 2021 plantation and to cater the water needs of the community. Progress Report

A composite team from CDS-PSU Personnel, Barangay Local Government Unit (BLGU) Mapaya representatives and Officers and members of Kahuyang Guinto CBFM Association conducted periodic monitoring on October 26, 2022 to validate the extent development undertaken by the members within the awarded CBFM area. 




