This pertains to the conduct of weekly joint checkpoint operation in partnership with the member of Oriental Mindoro Sagip Kalikasan (SAKAL) Task Force that was formed during the Multi-Sectoral Forest Protection Council (MFPC) meeting on August 2019. 

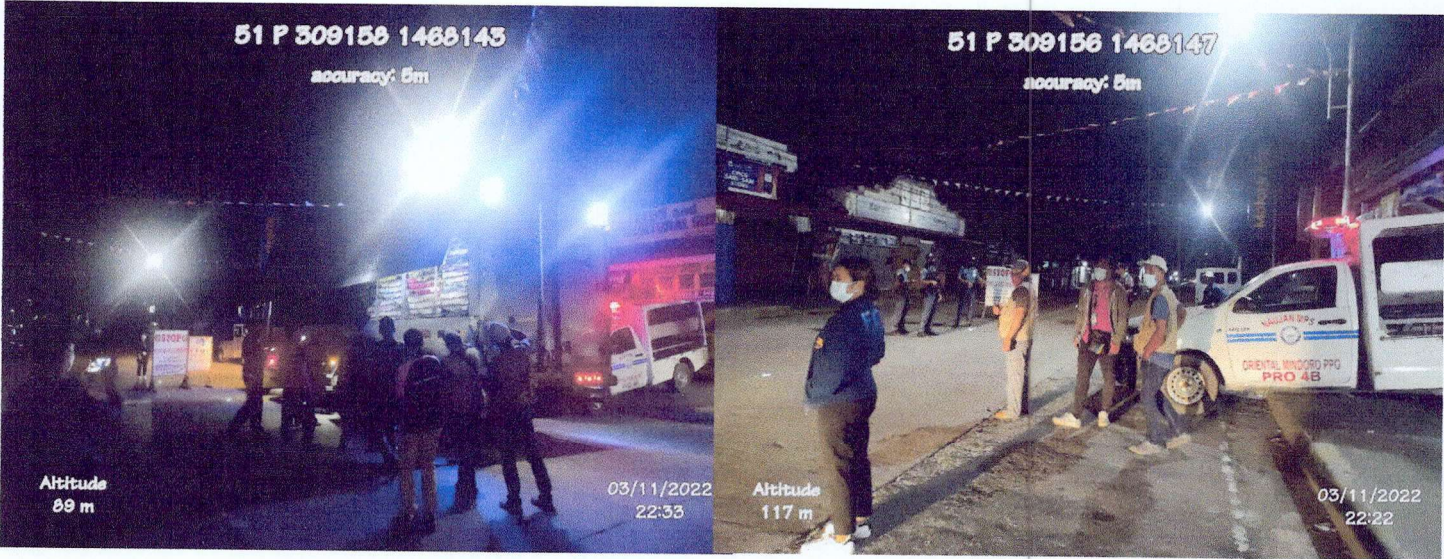
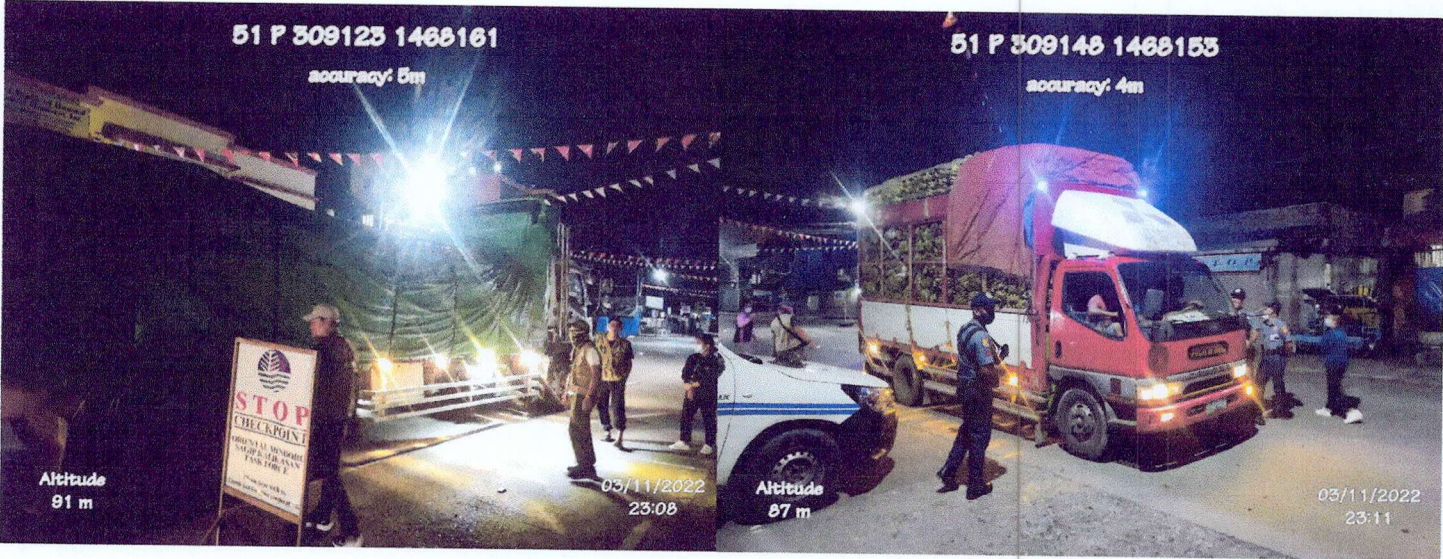
