- ✓ The proponents do not have a valid mining permit (quarry/gratuitous permit) but have a permit/request given by the Barangay.
- ✓ The vehicle used to transport the sacks of aggregates was allegedly owned by the brother of Hon. Nonie Efre, Barangay captain of Abongan.
- ✓ The said aggregates will be used for house construction.
- ✓ The area is within Malampaya Sound Protected Landscape and Seascape.
- ✓ There were also no prior coordination with the PAMO-MSPLS regarding the extraction in the area.

➤ **Legal Basis**

- ✓ Republic Act 7586 (National Integrated Protected Area Systems Act) as amended by Republic Act 11038 (Expanded National Integrated Protected Area Systems Act)
  - Section 20 (**Prohibited Acts**)
    - Paragraph (p) and Paragraph (q)
    - Prohibits the undertaking of mineral exploration and extraction and the undertaking of commercial and large-scale quarrying.
- ✓ Republic Act 7942 (Philippine Mining Act of 1992)
  - Section 2 (**Declaration of Policy**) - All mineral resources in public and private lands within the territory and exclusive economic zone of the Republic of the



Philippines are owned by the State. It shall be the responsibility of the State to promote their rational exploration, development, utilization and conservation through the combined efforts of the Government and private sector in order to enhance national growth in a way that effectively safeguards the environment and protects the rights of affected communities.

- Section 19 Areas Closed to Mining Applications

- Paragraph f:

- Old growth or virgin forests, proclaimed watershed forest reserves, wilderness areas, mangrove forests, mossy forests, national parks provincial/municipal forests, parks, greenbelts, game refuge and bird sanctuaries as defined by law and in areas expressly prohibited under the National Integrated Protected Areas System (NIPAS) under Republic Act No. 7586, Department Administrative Order No. 25, series of 1992 and other laws.

- Chapter 19 (Penal Provisions)

- Section 103 - Theft of Minerals

- Any person extracting minerals and disposing the same without a mining agreement, lease, permit, license, or steals minerals or ores or the products thereof from mines or mills or processing plants

➤ **Comments and Recommendations**

- ✓ The extraction activity is deemed illegal Pursuant to Section 103 of RA 7942.
- ✓ The permit/request given by the barangay is not considered as valid mining permit for extraction of quarry resources. The government agency tasked to accept, process and evaluate applications is the Provincial/City Mining Regulatory Board pursuant to Sec 70 of CDAO 2010 - 21
