



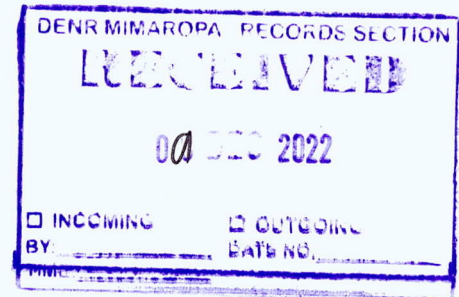


**SUBJECT : REPORT ON THE PHILIPPINE MACAQUE (*Macaca fascicularis*)

Submitted is the report of the Protected Area Coastal and Management Unit (PACMU) on the above subject matter.

One (1) Philippine Long-Tailed Macacque (*Macaca fascicularis*) was turned over to CENRO Roxas by Mr. George Monreal of So. Kayomito, Barangay Anoling, Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro. Upon interviewed, Mr. Monreal stated that he saw the species on his coconut plantation, lying on the ground and is wounded on its left arm. He then rescued it and decided to take it under his care before he decided to report it to Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO) Pinamalayan. The MENRO reported it to the CENRO Roxas and assisted the turned over activity of the species. The Philippine Long-Tailed Macacque was currently under medication, monitoring and rehabilitation at the Wildlife Rescue Center in Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro.

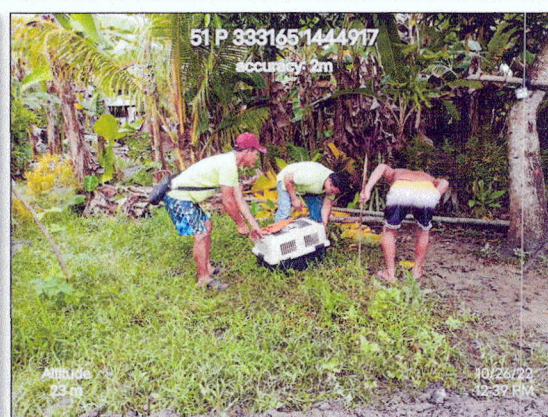
