Respectfully submitted is the report on Social Marketing and Mobilization/CEPA in compliance with our target activity for CY 2022.



In compliance with our CY 2022 target activity on Social Marketing and Mobilization for the month of May CY 2022 under the Coastal Resources and Foreshore Management Unit re: celebration of Month of the Ocean (MOO), respectfully submitted is the accomplishment report regarding the above-cited subject.

In line with the Presidential Proclamation No. 57, series of 1999 declaring May as "Month of the Ocean", the PENRO Marinduque celebrated the Month of the Ocean held on May 20, 2022. For this year's MOO, the theme adopted the UNESCO's Ocean Decade Challenge 2 "Protect and Restore Ecosystem Biodiversity", which is anchored in the United Nations Decade of the Ocean Science for Sustainable Development (2021-2030) message, "The Science We Need for the Ocean We Want". This is to emphasize the significance of conservation, protection and sustainable management of coastal and marine resources.

The activity was conducted in collaboration with four (4) barangays namely, Barangays Banuyo and Antipolo in Gasan and Daykitin and Caigangan in Buenavista. Those who participated were LGU Officials and their constituents, Philippine National Police (PNP) and Philippine Army (PA).

The activity started at around 6:30 in the morning. The DENR-PENRO Marinduque spearheaded the conduct of Coastal Clean-Up and afterwards Communication Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) regarding Ecological Solid Waste Management (R.A. 9003) and Gender and Development followed. The topics discussed comprised of:

- a.) Ecological Solid Waste Management (RA 9003)
 - ➤ What is RA 9003
 - What is Material Recovery Facility (MRF) and its physical components
 - Agencies involved in Implementing RA 9003 and their corresponding responsibilities
 - Kind of solid waste
 - Prohibition and corresponding punishments
 - Conceptual Framework of RA 9003
- b. Gender and Development (GAD)
 - What is RA 9710
 - What are the rights given by this law
 - Who are the Scope of Magna Carta
 - What are the responsibilities of the government

c. Gender issues

- Legal Mandates of GAD
- Magna Carta of Women
- Basic premises on gender equality
- Video Presentation "Impossible Dream"
- Five Gender Issues and What Should Be Done

Each barangay has a resource person from the DENR-PENRO Marinduque. A total of 206 participants with 93 males and 113 females joined the conduct of the activity.

Here under is the summary of the participants of each barangay in celebration of the MOO.

During the event, participants/volunteers consolidated data of trash collected in their designated locations. After the clean-up, each group segregated, counted, and listed the trash on the data cards provided. Accomplished data cards were gathered by the assigned coordinator from DENR and consolidated all information in the volunteer data forms.

Trash found/collected during the clean-up are mostly food wrappers (e.g. candy, chips, etc.). Other trash type are beverage bottles, foam pieces, grocery bags, plastic pieces and other plastics/foam packaging. There are also toys, shoes/slippers, cloth/clothing found. Several items for personal hygiene like sanitary napkin and diapers are present along the coastline. Trash collected amounted to a total of 24 sacks with 2,617 pieces of assorted waste.

Breakdown of trash collected during clean-up are the following, to wit:

The said celebration strictly followed the provisions on health and safety protocol issued by the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infection Diseases. Considering the COVID-19 pandemic, social distancing, wearing of facemask/shield and minimal physical contact among each participants were observed during the activity.

With the conduct of Month of the Ocean (MOO) through coastal clean-up, community participants were advised to avoid disposing trash that cause marine litter pollution.
