

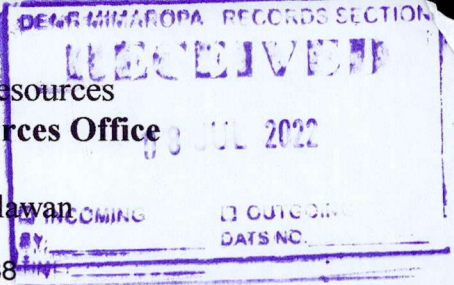

Forwarded is the memorandum dated May 30, 2022 of CENRO Coron along with the report on the conducted coastal clean-up on May 25-26, 2022 under Green Economy Model (GEM) implementation CY 2022.

Per report, the said activity was conducted in three (3) barangays; Barangay Bintuan, Guadalupe, and Tagumpay all in the municipality of Coron, Palawan which was participated by 107 individual composed of 67 men and 41 women from Barangay Local Government Unit, and other participating stakeholders from the Philippine Coast Guard, Philippine Maritime Police, DENR staffs and volunteers.

Approximately, 120 kilograms of solid waste materials were collected from the identified sites, comprising mostly of Styrofoam, nylon fishing lines, plastic wrappers, plastic bottles, and other residual waste. A brief Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) campaign about Republic Act 9003, also known as the "Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000," was also undertaken to raise awareness of the adverse impact of improper waste disposal on the coastal and marine environment.





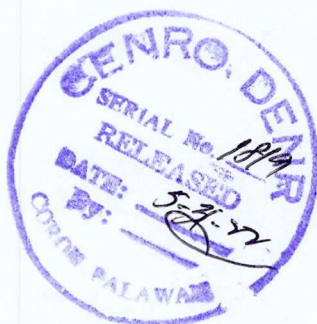
Respectfully forwarded is the report of FT I Nikki E. Ripalda regarding the conduct of Coastal Clean-up under the Green Economy Model Project implemented for CY 2022 in conjunction with the celebration of the "Month of the Ocean".

On May 25-26, 2022, this office conducted Coastal Clean-up activity in three (3) barangays; Barangay Bintuan, Guadalupe and Tagumpay all in the municipality of Coron, Palawan. The said activity were participated by 107 individual composed of 67 males and 41 females from Barangay Local Government Unit, and other participating stakeholders from the Philippine Coast Guard, Philippine Maritime Police, DENR staffs and volunteers.

Solid waste materials collected comprising mostly of styrofoam, nylon fishing lines, plastic wrappers, plastic and glass bottles and other residual wastes with the estimated total of 120 kilograms.

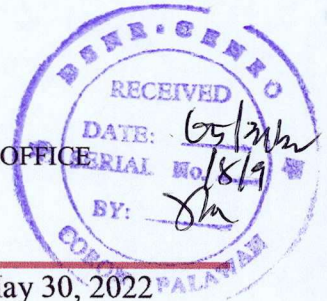

Please be informed that on May 25-26, 2022, this office organized a Coastal Clean-up as part of the implementation of Green Economy Model project in accordance to "Month of the Ocean". In coordination with the Barangay Local Government Unit, and other participating stakeholders from the Philippine Coast Guard, Philippine Maritime Police, DENR staffs and volunteers, the activity was successfully carried out on identified sites within the Barangays of Bintuan, Guadalupe, and Tagumpay with a total of 107 participants (67 males and 41 females).

Approximately, 120 kilograms of solid waste materials were collected from the identified sites comprising mostly of styrofoam, nylon fishing lines, plastic wrappers, plastic bottles and other residual wastes. A brief Information and Education Campaign about Republic Act of 9003 also known as the "Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000" was also undertaken to raise awareness on the adverse impact of improper disposal of wastes on the coastal and marine environment.

In accordance with the goal of GEM, this activity aims to accelerate the rehabilitation of degraded ecosystems and promote environmental protection and conservation of the coastal areas in Coron, Palawan.

SIMULTANEOUS COASTAL CLEAN-UP REPORT UNDER GREEN ECONOMY MODEL IMPLEMENTATION CY 2022

The DENR led a simultaneous coastal clean-up as a component of the implementation of Green Economy Model in conjunction with the celebration of the Month of the Ocean. It was conducted along the polluted coastal areas Bgy. Bintuan, Bgy. Guadalupe and Bgy. Tagumpay, Coron, Palawan on May 25-26, 2022.

With the active participation of Barangay Local Government of Bintuan led by Brgy. Captain Larry B. Pe together with DENR staffs led by CDS Chief Ferdinand Gatchalian, and representatives from Philippine Coast Guard. The team have gathered estimated 40 kilograms of solid waste materials from Sitio Lusong, Bgy. Bintuan. Most of the wastes collected were styrofoam, plastic and glass bottles that were presumably brought by the tide. On the afternoon, the team went to Sitio Deguiboy, Barangay Guadalupe to conduct the said activity. It was participated by 35 individuals from BLGU and volunteers from community. The wastes collected were roughly estimated to be 35 kilograms composed of nylon fishing line, plastic wrappers, can and glass bottles.

The clean-up site in Barangay Tagumpay is one of the densely populated coastal areas in Coron town. The solid wastes collected were assumed to be coming from the households. There are 33 active participants in the activity, with representatives from PCG, PMP, and volunteers from the community. There are comparatively 45 kilograms of collected garbage mostly plastic sachets, sanitary napkins and diapers.


During the conduct of this activity, the DENR staff briefly discussed Republic Act of 9003 otherwise called the "Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000" to bring light on the issues about the unfavourable outcome of improper waste disposal on the coastal/marine ecosystems and to promote ecological consciousness among the participants.


Nearly 120 kilograms of solid waste materials composed of styrofoam, nylon fishing lines, plastic wrappers, plastic and glass bottles and other residual wastes were collected on the three barangays and were subjected for proper disposal and segregation.



Barangay Tagumpay

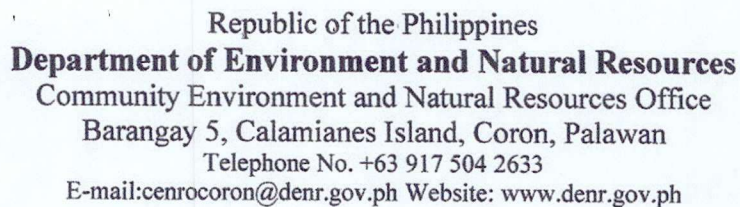

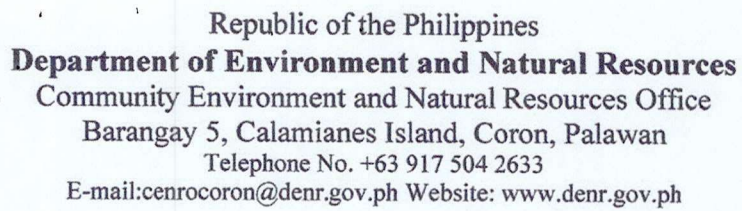

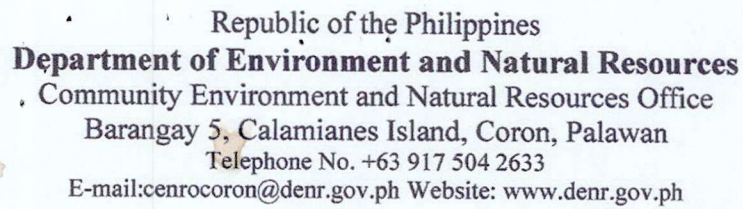
