

SUBJECT : **REPORT ON THE KNOWLEDGE SHARING WORKSHOP  
ON ACTION FOR CLIMATE EMPOWERMENT (ACE)**

In connection with the recently attended workshop of PENRO IEC Officer Irene A. Mixdon regarding the memorandum invitation of The Director, DENR Climate Change Service, and Concurrent Director, DENR Gender and Development Office pertaining to the **Knowledge Sharing Workshop on Action for Climate Empowerment (ACE)** with the theme *"Localizing Actions for Climate Empowerment"*.

Moreover, the DENR Climate Change Service led the workshop in collaboration with DENR-PENRO Palawan on April 21, 2022 at PENRO Palawan Training Hall. A total of forty-five (45) participants from this office, different LGU's and offices such as PCSD, Palawan Provincial Planning Office, CIO, PPDO, PIO, and students from WPU and PSU have joined in this activity.


The participants have done three (3) group exercises wherein each participant stated the following requested information: his/her name, affiliation, one (1) object in the house that can be helpful during disasters, their expectations from the activity; in the 2<sup>nd</sup> group exercise the participants stated the benefits of living near the ocean, mountain, city and lowland areas; in the 3<sup>rd</sup> group exercise the participants classified the Adaptation vs. Mitigation based on the different pictures given to the participants respectively.

Further, the participants engaged in three (3) workshop activities: in the first workshop, participants stated their observations and experiences about climate change, its causes, measures to adapt to climate change in which the answers through meta cards was integrated into the presentation/knowledge sharing on climate change concepts; in the second workshop, the participants were asked on different ways to expand knowledge and skills on climate change mitigation and adaptation in which answers were incorporated into the ACE elements template, matrix and discussions were also included stating the communities will acquire awareness, knowledge and skills on climate change solutions that should also be gender-sensitive and participatory in nature in manila paper; and in the third workshop, the participants were asked for their perspectives on how local climate actions or solutions are outlined, as well as how the six (6) elements of Action for Climate Empowerment (ACE) are applied to local climate actions in which their responses in meta cards were synthesized and incorporated into the ACE Local Climate Actions matrix. Finally, workshop assessment and presentation of the output were conducted.

A Question and Answer (Q and A) portion was also held wherein PCSD, WPU, PSU, PCSD, IAYSP conducted exchanged questions tackling their concerns on future collaborations, appointment with PENRO and IEC Officer. The PENRO IEC Officer Irene A. Mixdon answered the questions and addressed the concerns of the participants specifically the DENR efforts in addressing the climate change issues in a long-term and strategic plans and action.

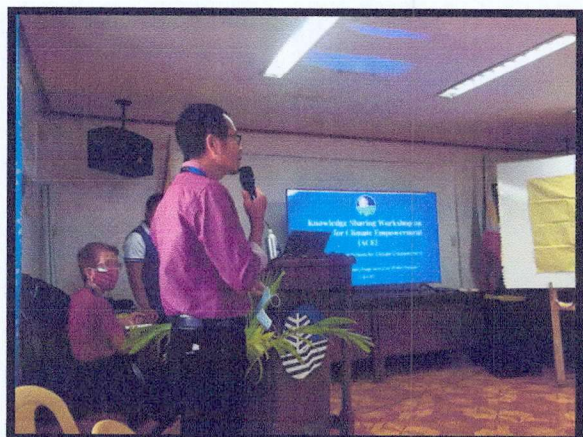
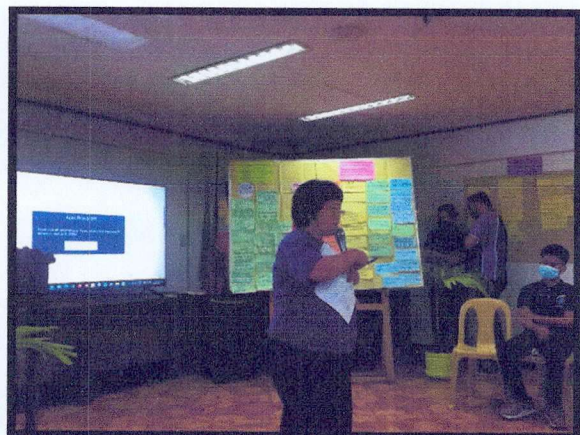
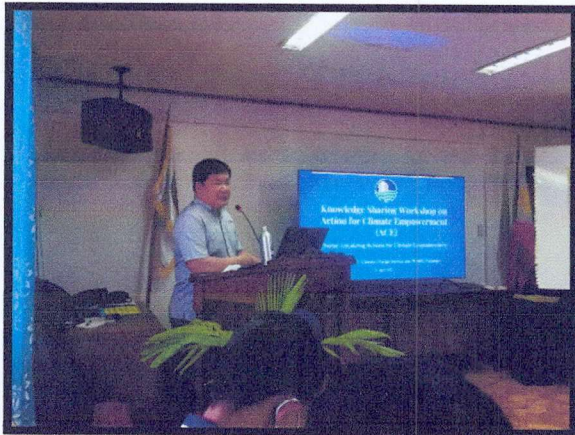
