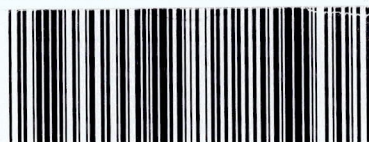

SUBJECT : **SUBMISSION OF REPORT ON THE ASSISTANCE TO THE CONDUCT OF SECOND QUARTERLY MEETING OF ORIENTAL MINDORO MARINE PROTECTED AREA – LAW ENFORCEMENT NETWORK (ORMPA-LEN) ON JUNE 28, 2022**

Please be informed that the Chief, Conservation and Development Section (CDS) and the undersigned have attended and provided technical and logistical assistance to the conduct of the second (2nd) quarterly MPA-LEN of Oriental Mindoro on June 28, 2022 at Vencio's Gerden Hotel and Restaurant, Tawiran, Calapan City.

The activity was spearheaded by the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro thru the Provincial Agriculturist's Office – Fisheries Management Division and the Malampaya Foundation, Inc. It was presided by the Vice-Chairperson of the OMMPA-FLEN, Baco Municipal Agriculturist Hilario M. Bacay. Participants of the meeting are network members, representatives – Coastal Resource Management Coordinators of different municipalities, Municipal Agriculturists, Provincial Legal Office, and national agencies such as Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources, PNP-Maritime, Philippine Coast Guard and Department of Environment and Natural Resources Office thru the PENRO.

The first on the agenda was the approval of the minutes of the previous meeting. Issues and concerns raised was about the Seasonal Closures of the MPAs. It was also agreed in the meeting that a cluster meeting shall be conducted in order to discuss in details the common and raising concerns of the protected areas composing the network. This Office, however, expressed its intent and support in the conduct of these activities, in order also to provide assistance to the community regarding coastal managements such as provision of livelihood thru the Biodiversity-Friendly Enterprise (BDFE).

Members of the network have reported/shared their plans/programs/activities related to coastal and marine resources for CY 2022. For DENR, For. Amor Asi presented the activities under Coastal and Marine Ecosystem Management Program which are continues provision of technical assistance to Marine Protected Area Network and formulation of Integrated Coastal Management Plan. Furthermore, Forester Bea Fortu presented the accomplishment of activities under Greefins. The agency have committed on the provision of technical assistance to the Oriental Mindoro Monitoring Team during the assessment of reefs, mangroves and seagrasses. The PENRO shall create a Special Order for the selected trained divers to be a member of the ORMT which shall be endorsed to the PGOM-PAgO Fisheries Division.

Further, Forester Amor discussed about the integrated coastal management as a national strategy to ensure the sustainable development of the country's coastal and marine environment and resources. It was explained that Integrated Coastal Management Programs of the LGU shall be in line with the National ICM program and shall be consulted with the relevant stakeholders. LGUs shall update their respective ICM program to reflect changing social, economic and environmental condition and emerging issues. Municipal and city governments shall consider ICM as one of their regular functions. Thru the discussion, agreements and commitments were raised and scheduling of activities of several municipalities were calendared.

This Office also provided the food during the conduct of the second quarterly meeting at Vencio's Garden Hotel and Restaurant, Tawiran, Calapan City, Oriental Mindoro.
