

In compliance with our target activity on Coastal Resources and Foreshore Management Unit (CRFMU) under the Technical Services Division, hereunder are our CY 2022 Second Quarter Accomplishment Report, to wit:

Pleased be informed that two (2) consultation meetings were conducted with regard to Marine Protected Areas (MPAs) within the province. The first consultation meeting was conducted on April 12, 2022 at Barangay Kasily, Sta.Cruz, Marinduque regarding the status of management plan and provision of assistance to Locally-Managed Marine Protected Areas (LMMPAs). This activity was participated by the LGU officials and constituents of Barangay Kasily, representative from the academe, Municipal Agriculture Officer Gerardo P. Diana, staff of the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO) and also the nearby barangay officials of Hupi, Balogo and Kamandugan, Sta.Cruz.

The objective of this activity is to be able the LGU officials and constituents to review and acquainted on the status of management plan of the "Sta.Cruz Marine Protected Area" located in Barangays of Kasily and Kalangkang, Sta.Cruz, Marinduque with Municipal Ordinance No. 45 series of 2008.

Municipal Agriculture Officer Gerardo P. Diana on the presentation of the management plan prepared in 2008.

The activity started on the discussion of the management plan prepared in 2008. It was signed/approved by former Mayor Ruben F. Revilla, together with Vice Mayor Alejandro C. Palamos and their Councilors. The plan included the bantay dagat which are the selected fisher folks duly trained by Municipal LGU and other government agencies and duly deputized by the Local Chief Executive. The MPA has an estimated area of 160 hectares buffer zone and 55.0 hectares core zone. Traditional fishing is prohibited as contained in the municipal ordinance. Under Section 4 of the ordinance, the area and boundaries plotted with geographic coordinates in buffer zone and core zone. The penalty clause under Section 6 within Marine Sanctuary Area/Core zone included the fine and imprisonment.



During the open forum the Municipal Agriculture Office promised to cooperate either financial or technical support. Accordingly, they have an allotment of approximately Php 200,000.00 for this year for the materials to be used in said MPA. It was agreed that installation of bouys/markers within the core zone and buffer zone area be conducted.

Another consultation meeting was conducted on April 20, 2022 in Barangay Silangan, Mogpog. Highlights of the meeting emphasized on the protection and conservation of coastal resources through law enforcement, Communication, Education and Public Awareness (CEPA), strengthening of stakeholders collaboration and cooperation, mangrove planting and identification of Biodiversity-Friendly Enterprises (BFEs).

The Community Marine Reserve (MCMR) has an area of 182.52 hectares with 169.00 hectares buffer zone, 8.45 hectares habitat zone and 32.45 hectares fish sanctuary zone. It covers the surrounding waters of Natangko and San Andres Islands.

The MPA is included in the Coastal Resource Management Plan (CRMP) of Mogpog that was formulated in 2005. Like other MPAs in the province, MCMR is managed by the local government unit (LGU) led by the Municipal Agriculture Office (MAO) and the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO). A proper MPA management plan though was not formulated 2006, but the stakeholders awareness on the establishment and maintenance of marine protected area and the national fisheries laws as well, may contributed to the Municipal Ordinance No. 13-2006.

During the meeting, it was agreed that installation of bouys/marker within the MPA be done. The sinker and bouys were already prepared and brought at Natangko Island with

25 pieces sinker and 25 pieces of bouys. Six hundred (600) meters length of rope which is included as materials to be used in the installation will also be provided by the Municipal Agriculture Office.

In view hereof, the CRFMU of PENRO Marinduque will continuously provide technical assistance to Locally-Managed Marine Protected Areas (LMMPAs) in order to formally create a Marine Protected Area Network in the province.






