PATROLLING/MONITORING REPORT OF MONITORING AND ENFORCEMENT TEAM OF TECHNICAL SERVICES DIVISION WITHIN THE CONSERVATION AREAS THRU LAWIN FOREST AND BIODIVERSITY PROTECTION SYSTEM IN BARANGAY DAMPULAN, TORRIJOS AND BARANGAY SIHI TO BARANGAY YOOK, BUENAVISTA,

MARINDUQUE FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE, CY 2022.

In compliance with the target activities of Technical Services Division, Monitoring and Enforcement (MES), please be informed that the undersigned had conducted patrolling/monitoring of forest threats within conservation areas covering of Barangay Tungib-Lipata, Buenavista to Dampulan, Torrijos and Barangays of Sihi to Barangay Yook, Buenavista, Marinduque.

Be informed further, that the team had coordinated with the concerned Barangay Local Government Units before the conduct of patrolling/monitoring within their conservation areas. In Barangay Dampulan, Torrijos, the undersigned proceeded to the SIFMA areas and conducted patrolling/monitoring thereat. In our patrol route, the team noticed some felled trees which accordingly, they were affected by the recent Typhoons. The Team continued the patrolling and were able to detect some stumps of Gmelina trees ranging to 35cm-65cm in diameter. Per verification, the said trees were outside the SIFMA areas. The team measured the stumps of the said trees and geotagged it for documentation. Moreover, the said cutting of trees was recorded in the Cyber Tracker/LAWIN application. In Barangay Sihi to Barangay Yook, the team was accompanied by Forest Protection Officer Ireneo P. Villanueva of Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) in patrolling/monitoring at Barangay Sihi (Mt. Malindig area) to Barangay Yook, Buenavista, Marinduque, no forest threats or illegal activities were recorded in the patrol route.

On the other hand, the team have accomplished a total distance of 11.67 kilometers as an output of LAWIN patrolling activities in the said Barangays.

In view hereof, follow-up verification/investigation must be conducted with regards to cutting of trees within the conservation areas of Dampulan Torrijos and continuous patrolling/monitoring within the said areas and information disseminate regarding environmental (forestry) laws is hereby recommend.

Please find attached geo-tagged photos of the said activity and generated patrol data from Cyber Tracker thru LAWIN/SMART system apps.




