### I. EVALUATION OF THE COURSE:

### • Technical Content:

The DENR-PENR Officer Felizardo B. Cayatoc issued a PENRO Special Order No. 2022-049 dated May 12, 2022 entitled "Authorizing the conduct of DENR Palawan IEC Officers and PENRO IEC Unit Capacity Building and Basic Course Training" held on May 18-20, 2022 at CityState Asturias Hotel, Bgy. Tiniguiban, Puerto Princesa City.

The training workshop involved the Information Officers all over Palawan representing the CENROs of Taytay, Roxas, Puerto Princesa, Brooke's Point, Quezon, Coron and some of the staff and personnel of DENR-PENRO Palawan IEC Team and from Regional Special Communications and Initiative Group (RSIG) headed by Ms. Madona P. Corado. The objectives are to equipped, capacitate and strengthen the skills of IOs of Palawan particularly on News writing and feature writing, basic photography and cinematography, public speaking & radio broadcasting and among others.

It also aims to be equipped in terms of responding environmental issues, stepping up information dissemination and enforcement for the sustainable protection of Palawan's environment.

During the lecture on Basic Photography, the resource person, Mr. Joemarian Casidsid of Juan Take Production taught and trained us individually on proper using and position of camera while taking photos, the button and function of cameras' icon and also the best weather in taking scene for cinematography. Mr. Casidsid highlighted that "Always Know Your Gear particularly the ISO, shutter speed and aperture".

Ms. Celeste Anna R. Formoso, Editorial Manager of Palawan News taught us that in News Writing it is important to highlight the LEAD or the 1<sup>st</sup> Paragraph—it must be catchy and impactful to the readers and must followed the 5W & 1H (What, When, Where, Who, Why and How). Also, news writing must be brief, concise, on point, focus on the action and get the reader on HOOK!

Mr. Darryl Gacasa, PENRO Palawan IT Assistant also discussed the Basic and Beginners Guide for Drone Flying in order for us to know more about drone installation, function and its uses. We also undergone actual installation of drone parts, its operation processes and procedures were discussed. Unfortunately, we did not have a chance to experience actual drone flying due to bad weather condition.

Mr. Rod Evangelista of RGMA Super Radio DYSP 909Khz Palawan was our last resource person. He highlighted that in radio broadcasting, the information that need to be shared to the public must be credible and truthful and must come from the heart. Also, there must be a vision on what to impart to the public, of what they need to know and to avoid using of unnecessary or foul or offensive words. He also invited us to guest in their radio program to experience actual radio broadcasting, which we take it as challenge and signified our willingness to visit their radio station on the next day (Saturday) to tackle about what transpire in the training and to share the new learnings gained during the training. And at the same time, it will be an opportunity to tackle some DENR plans, program/projects and upcoming activities.

### • Impression/Comments:

To the Resource Person: They were all knowledgeable on their topics, very professional and tried to discuss some technical terms in lay-man's terms so that everyone could easily understand. Encouraged the participants to ask questions and all the topic are very informative and useful in our new work assignment/designation and function. They are all specialists, highly respected and very technical persons in their field of specialization in a way that they delivered topics spontaneously so that participants will be comfortable to interact and respond.

**Co-Participants.** They are participative, discipline, cooperative, attentive, friendly, and very responsive to the topics and willing to learn new things and shared some experiences and ideas in relation to the topics.

**Facilitator.** The facilitator organized the learning event orderly and properly, provided action and information to all the queries of participants, shared information materials and souvenirs/tokens in relation to the topics and took extra efforts to respond on unexpected incidents happened during the events. The audio visual and sound system were tested and prepared in order.

**Venue.** The hotel is a best venue to conduct with this kind of learning events, very spacious with good ventilation since we are in a pandemic situation wherein public health protocol such as social distancing and wearing of face masks are observed. It has clean comfort rooms and discipline and attentive hotel's staff.

**Food.** The food they served are all good and delicious.

**Accommodation.** The rooms were clean, very comfortable, and highly recommended venue to relax and stay away from all form of stresses.

## II. RELEVANCE OF THE LEARNING EVENT TO PARTICIPANT'S WORK/FUNCTION:

It captured my interest in cinematography and simple video editing and at the same time normalized my feelings of being nervous in any activities and in public speaking for as long as you have a vision to impart credible and truthful information to the public.

Aside from the new learnings and knowledge gained, this training workshop also a great venue which formed friendship and camaraderie with other CENRO IOs and IEC Team of DENR Palawan considering the fact that most of the participants are coming from different CENROs in Palawan. Further, we have built partnerships with Mr. Rod Evangelista of DYSP Super Radyo through their Radio Station and the Palawan News for the airing and publication of DENR plans and programs/projects, existing policies, press releases and other related activities.

### II. RECOMMENDATIONS:

To include the other members of CENROs IEC Team in the training considering that most of the members were also newly appointed and beginners in terms of information dissemination and public speaking wherein most of them had fear to face the crowd and has not enough knowledge, skills and experience particularly on news writing, public speaking, video editing and basic photography among others.
- 2. The PENRO IEC Team to coordinate and request to the Central Office for possible funding for the procurement of latest camera and lens to capture best quality images/photos which can be used for the reports, news releases and information materials.
- 3. To conduct series of related workshop trainings that will empower, expose, capacitate and strengthen the skills and knowledge of CENROs and PENROs Information Officers and IEC Team Members.




