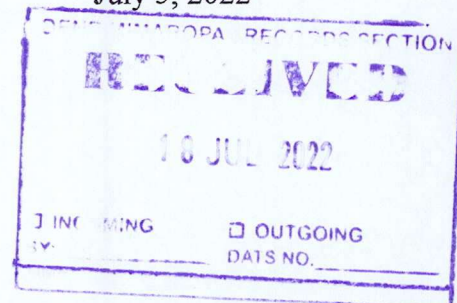

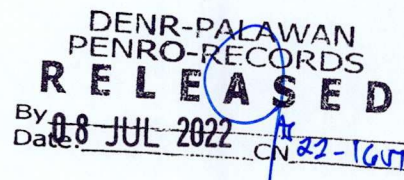

1. Report on the conducted coastal clean-up activity at Park Ranger Station, barangay Tumbod, Taytay, Palawan on February 2, 2022. This Office able to collect various types of non-biodegradable waste such as plastics (junk foods, candy wrappers & plastic labo), sacks and empty plastic bottles of softdrinks & mineral water. 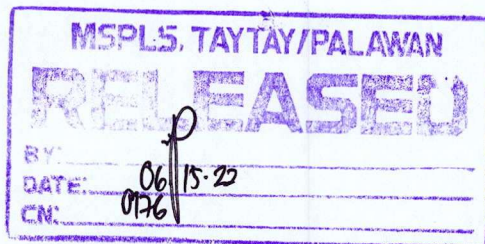


biodegradable. The collected garbage was properly segregated and the garbage that considered as biodegradable was buried in the sand for proper disposition.
