


Please be informed that CDS Staff FT I Chuckie Aguilos, FT I Rinades Jusos, FT II Karl Aries Sumandal and ECOMS I Jo Annie D. Corvera went to Barangay Port Barton, San Vicente, Palawan on March 31, 2022 to June 1, 2022 to do a refresher dive and practice the fish and reef assessment using reef check method and monitor a flying fox (kabog) roost site.

FT I Chuckie Aguilos and FT I Rinades Jusos were taught by FT Karl Aries Sumandal and ECOMS I Jo Annie Corvera the basics of fish and coral assessment. ECOMS I Corvera discussed how to identify different substrate and coral species. FT I Sumandal discussed how fish are identified by their family and the survey method using Reef Check. At the end of the activity, FTs Aguilos and Jusos were given a practical exam. The team proceeded to Barangay Port Barton for the refresher dive and do actual fish and coral survey to be conducted by FTs Aguilos and Jusos.

Another activity conducted in Barangay Port Barton is the site visit of the reported flying fox (kabog) in Poblacion. The site has been affected by Typhoon Odette.
