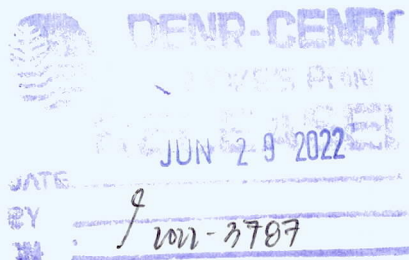


Respectfully forwarded herewith are copies of reports/updates in summary of Lawin Patrolling conducted within the area of jurisdiction of CENRO Brooke's Point, Palawan with patrol data submitted from May 24 to June 20, 2022.

Based on the said summary, a total of 50.550 kilometers of foot and seaborne patrolling activities within the forestland area/conservation area was accomplished, equivalent to 101.10% of the 50 kilometers monthly target of this Office computed based on the 600 kilometers annual target indicated in the approved Work and Financial Plan for CY 2022. Observation records show that the forest conditions in the areas patrolled are mainly characterized by advanced secondary forests however significant observations of open cultivated areas are also recorded.

Moreover, for this period one (1) typhoon related threat was documented during patrolling activities at Barangay Panitian, Sofronio Española, Palawan last May 17, 2022 with follow-up response categorized as Level 3 or no further action is required.

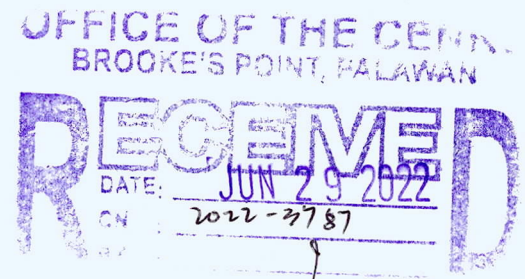

THE MONTH OF JUNE 2022**



Respectfully submitted herewith is the LAWIN Report/Update for the month of May 2022. This report provides summary of patrols conducted by this Office with patrol data submitted from May 24 to June 20, 2022. The patrol distance covered by each patroller for the specified dates and patrol IDs are likewise included. Moreover, for this period, environmental threat recorded only includes one (1) typhoon related threat documented during patrolling activities at Barangay Panitian, Sofronio Española, Palawan on May 17, 2022 with after patrol response categorized as Level 3 or no further action required.

Based from the summaries of results of queries and reports run via SMART Database, the patrol distance (Km) covered in each Patrol Sector is summarized as follows:

\*Note: For June 2022, a total of 55.658 Kms was reported as accomplishment to the CENRO Planning Officer on June 27, 2022. This includes the 3.752 Kms not reported last May 2022 and with two (2) patrol data for June with only 1/3 of the distance patrolled accounted for as it contains return routes thus was reported to FMB Lawin Help Desk for updating and which were just recently updated (June 28, 2022). However, per review, patrol distance covered for patrol IDs 817 to 820 had been further updated and was reduced from 9.984 Kms to 8.203 Kms. Accordingly, there is an excess/over reported 1.356 Kms. Therefore, to ensure that the total reported accomplishment in Kms per record of Planning Officer coincides with that of the submitted monthly reports (MOVs), the said 1.356 Kms will be deducted from the total accomplishment for July 2022.

As described in the table above, the forest condition in conservation areas covered by LAWIN Patrols of CENRO Brooke's Point for the month of June 2022 is dominated by **Advanced Secondary Forests**. Significant number of observations of open cultivated areas is also documented. High observations of moderate regeneration is also recorded which may indicate forest cover recover; however, considerable number of observations of areas with sparse regeneration are also documented.

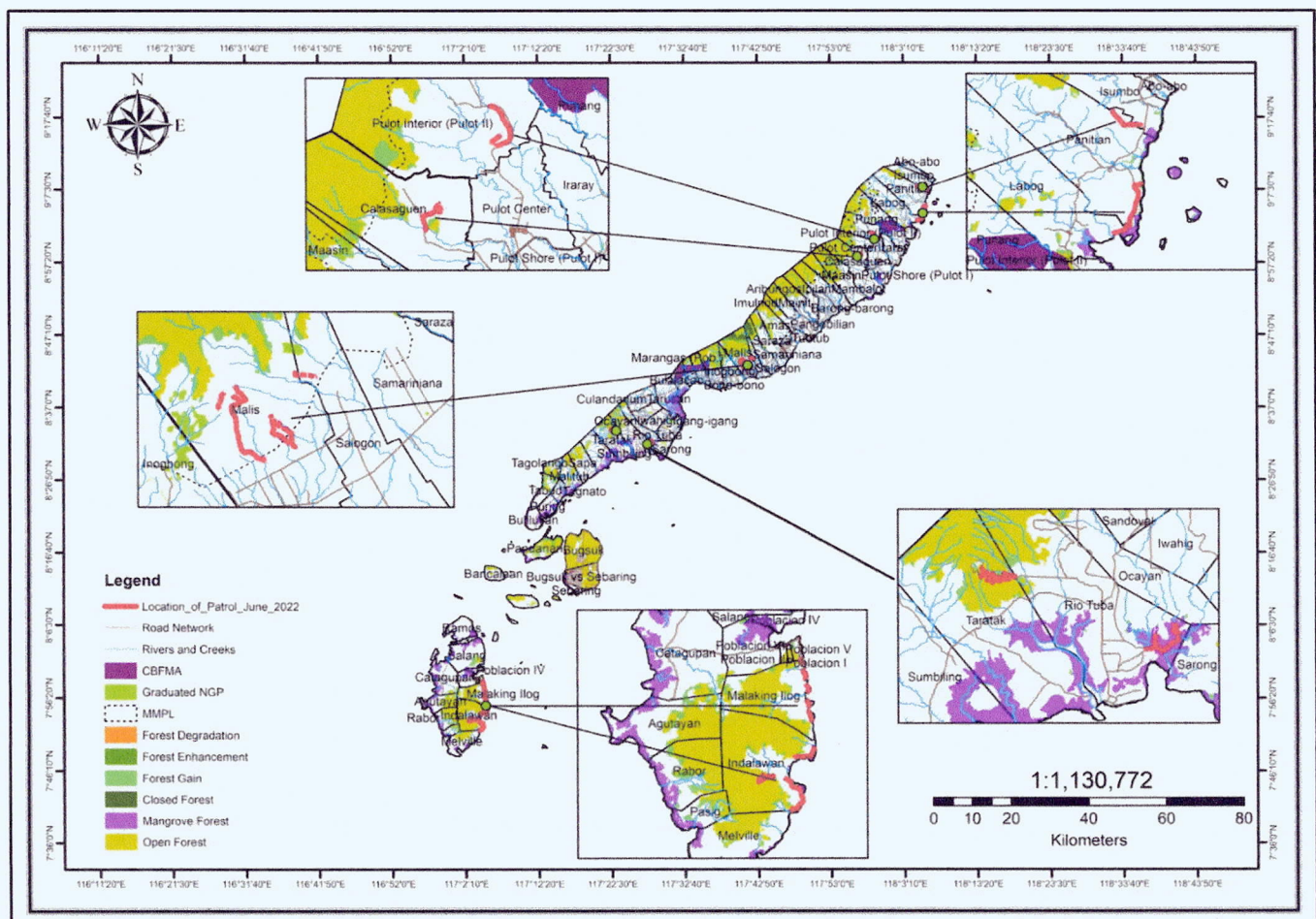
