As part of the Communication, Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) of the Conservation and Development Section (CDS) of this Office, the undersigned personnel headed by Sr. EMS/Chief, CDS Ma. Vivian O. Soriano conducted Orientation on Marine Turtle Conservation with LGU Bacungan Officials, Barangay Tanod and Purok Leaders particularly within the coastal areas. The orientation was conducted at the Session Hall of Barangay Bacungan, Puerto Princesa City on May 24, 2022.

The activity began with the opening program which started with an AVP entitled "A Prayer for the Earth" followed by the singing of National Anthem. Thereafter, a welcome message was delivered by Hon. Gina G. Valdestamon, Punong Barangay of Barangay Bacungan.

The lecture proper followed. The undersigned, ECOMS I Arlene B. Basaya briefly presented DENR information which includes mission and vision, program & projects as well as the DENR officials/heads from the Central Office, Regional Office down to the PENROs and CENROs in Palawan citing also the areas of responsibility (AOR) of each officials. Also, presented the activities and services provided by the CENRO Puerto Princesa such as National Greening Programs (NGP), issuances and processing of land titling, tenurial instruments within forestland, monitoring and enforcement activities and established checkpoints within the jurisdiction of CENRO Puerto Princesa, among others.

The undersigned, Forester Jessie M. Escandalio then discussed the two (2) major events for the month of May – Month of the Ocean and International Day for Biological Diversity. Brief background on "Month of the Ocean" were presented: Proclamation No. 57 series of 1999 which declared May as Month of Ocean as it recognizes that coastal and marine resources provide both economic and ecological benefits, such as food, livelihood, recreation and other services, as well as biodiversity, aesthetic value, and shoreline protection. The Month of the Ocean 2022 theme: "Protect and Restore Ecosystems and

Biodiversity" which aims to understand the effects of multiple stressors on ocean ecosystems and develop solutions to manage and restore ecosystems and rich biological diversity found therein under changing environmental and social conditions.

On International Day for Biological Diversity (IDBD) 2022, it was discussed that the event is celebrated globally every 22nd of May to promote awareness about biodiversity and its connection to our lives. Likewise, the 2022 IDBD theme: "Building a shared future for all life," was explained that it is a reminder to all that we are interconnected and woven together in this one big circle called BIODIVERSITY. It was also mentioned that this year's IDBD marked the beginning of a year-long celebration of our Protected Areas for a Protected Future.

For the highlight of the activity, Sr. EMS/Chief, CDS Ma. Vivian O. Soriano gave an orientation on Marine Turtle Conservation. She discussed information on marine turtle conservation which includes basic biology: information on marine turtles, parts of marine turtles, difference between Pawikan and Pagong, information on the five (5) species of marine turtles in the Philippines, differences according to species, habitat, body structure, importance of marine turtles, life cycle of marine turtles, and threats to marine turtles. Also discussed proper handling, proper identification, measurement, tagging and releasing of marine turtles as well as brief information on hatchery management and hatchling releasing. She also emphasized that headstarting—the method of growing hatchling for a few months or years before they are release, is not a conservation practice in the Philippines. It is not recommended because it disrupts the life cycle of the turtle. Therefore, it becomes a threat to marine turtle populations in the country. Additional pointers against headstarting include the following:

- 1. It is illegal to keep threatened species under the Philippine Wildlife Act.
- 2. The hatchlings fail to imprint, and
- 3. The hatchling are unable to get their important 'lost years' life phase due to loss of infantile frenzy.

During the open forum, Kgd. Marlon Balmores and Kgd. Reymundo Benitez raised concerns in relation to the topic on headstarting because accordingly there is a private property owned by certain Mr. Castro located in So. Talaudyong of said barangay who are engaging in growing marine turtle and same were temporarily enclosed in a cut plastic drum. Accordingly, they had also witnessed the actual releasing of hatchlings within the site but intentionally do not to release all the turtles purposely for ecotourism and additional attraction and activity within the area.

Sr. EMS Soriano told that the team from CENRO Puerto Princesa will conduct a monitoring and site visitation in the area in order to assess and validate their activities. Also, to inquire for permits and licences to operate or any legalities for their operations. She also added that the office will also coordinate with the LGU Barangay for the conduct of joint inspection and validation at the site.

Other clarifications on the marine turtle conservation were also raised by some participants and explained.

During the activity, CEPA materials (posters) about GREEN Fins, Marine Turtle Conservation, PD No. 705 - Sec. 77 or the Revised Forestry Code of the Philippines and RA No. 9175 or the Chainsaw Act were provided to the LGU Bacungan for public information.

Furthermore, minimum health protocol observed during the conduct of activity such as wearing of face mask and social distancing.

A total of ten (10) females and nine (9) male attended the orientation composed of the Punong Barangay, Barangay Kagawad, Barangay Secretary, Barangay Health Worker, Purok Leader and Barangay Tanod.

The program was ended with closing message of Kagawad Marlon Balmores, Chairperson – Committee on Environment where he highlighted that the LGU Bacungan will strongly support with the plans and programs of the DENR particularly on marine turtle conservation considering that their barangay is one of the nesting sites of marine turtles within west coast of Puerto Princesa City.


