

This pertains with KRA target on WFP 2022, please be informed that these section personnel conducted simultaneous monitoring of sightings of Dugong within the administrative jurisdiction of CENRO – Coron to determine the occurrence of the endangered marine species within the locality. There are several activities undertaken this quarter on monitoring of sighting of dugong to wit;

May 04-06, 2022

 Conducted coordination with barangay local officials of Bgy. Buluang, Busuanga, Palawan pertaining with probable sighting of Dugong on other coastal areas of said barangay.

Installation of IEC materials at public places of said barangay regarding on

protection and conservation of Dugong and other marine animals.

June 14, 2022

 Conducted coordination/dialogue meeting with barangay officials of Bgy. San Miguel, Linapacan, Palawan pertaining with probable sighting of Dugong on coastal areas of said barangay.

June 14-17, 2022

- Conducted dialogue/meeting with concerned Bgy. Officials and residents who
 participate on protection and conservation of Dugong at Bgy. Bogtong,
 Busuanga, Palawan.
- Conducted coordination with OIC, Barangay Kagawad Nelson Callix of Bgy.
 Concepcion, Busuanga, Palawan regarding the present situation on sightings of Dugong at coastal areas of the said barangay.
- Conducted ocular inspection/verification on the coastal areas of Sitio Bayuyan and Sitio San Vicente all in Bgy. Buluang, Busuanga, Palawan to determine the alleged sightings of Dugong from the concerned residents of said coastal area.

Conclusion

Upon inspection, there are no recorded sightings of Dugong (Dugong dugon). On the other hand, the local residents confirmed the presence of the said species in all of the barangays mentioned above for this quarter. The absence of the said species during the inspection is presume to be due to low tide. Also, the residents were aware that Dugong (Dugong dugon) is listed as a Vulnerable on the IUCN Red List of Threatened species. The local community is being supported by C₃ Philippines in the protection and conservation of the said species.


