Forwarded is the memorandum dated July 4, 2022 from CENRO Taytay along with the Report on the conducted Inspection and Monitoring at Barangay Corong-corong, El Nido, Palawan.

The inspection and monitoring activity was conducted on June 1, 2022 in response with the letter from the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO) of El Nido, reporting that Banig Resort in Brgy. Corong-corong is extracting coral boulders and upon their inspection on March 4, 2022, an estimated 2 cubic meters of coral boulders was in the possession of the said resort. However based on the conducted inspection by the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO), there was no hauling of coral boulders observed in the beach area of Brgy. Corong-corong, El Nido, Palawan.

Respectfully forwarded is the memorandum dated June 28, 2022 and acted by this Office on July 4, 2022 from Protected Area Superintendent (PASu) Mildred A. Suza of El Nido-Taytay Managed Resource Protected Area (ENTMRPA), El Nido, Palawan.

This pertains to the letter dated May 23, 2022 of MENRO Raul B. Maximo, CE of El Nido regarding the report of a concern citizen that Banig Beach Resort in Barangay Corong-Corong owned by Mr. Peter Tan is extracting coral boulders. Based on the investigation made by their Office it was confirmed that an estimated two (2) cubic meters of coralline boulders was in their possession. However, the report made by PAMO-ENTMRPA shows that there was no hauling of coral boulders observed in the mentioned area, thus the undersigned concurred with the recommendation of PASu Mildred A. Suza to continuously conduct the patrol and monitoring and file appropriate actions needed if violation is found in the area.



: INSPECTION REPORT

On March 04, 2022, The MENRO Enforcement Unit responded to a report that Banig resort located in Bgy. Corong corong, El nido was collecting coralline boulders upon the inspection it was confirmed, an estimated 2 cubic meters of coralline boulders was in their possession at the beachfront of the resort and is to be used as pavement that may seem as breakwater in front of the said resort. The team communicated with the owner of the said resort named Mr. Peter Tan and was told that collection or mere possession of the abovementioned items is prohibited by laws, under R.A 7586 section 20 paragraph a, R.A 8550 section 91 and R.A 9147 section 27 paragraph f. The owner replied that they will return the items to the sea where it was collected.

However during the reinspection on March 23, 2022, at around 9:00 am the MENRO Enforcement Unit found out that the coralline boulders was not returned to the sea where it was taken instead it was used in the concreted pavement that may seem as breakwater at the beachfront of the said resort.




