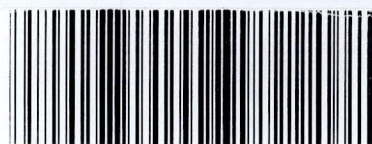

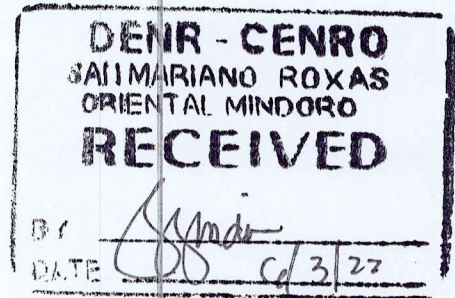

Warm Greetings! I hope this letter finds you well despite the pandemic.








PROJECT DESIGN

- I. Title** : Provision of Motorized Banca with Fishing Gears to Poor Fisherfolks
(AIP Reference Code 8000-1-8-7-16)
- II. Project Site** : Eight (8) Coastal Barangays of Gloria
- III. Budget Allocation** : Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR):
Php. 1,000,000.00 from Malinis at Masaganang Karagatan Award 2017
- III. Target Starting Date** : January 2022
- IV. Target Completion Date** : December 2022

V. Rationale:

The Municipal Government of Gloria has eight (8) coastal barangays namely Tambong, Kawit, San Antonio, Balete, Sta. Theresa, Guimbonan, Maragooc and Agsalin with 1,074 registered fisherfolks and 325 bancas. The municipality has three (3) Marine Protected Areas: Tambong, Sta. Theresa and Agsalin Fish Sanctuary with a total area of 184.6 hectares. Through continuous effort of the community, Bantay Dagat, LGU and other stakeholders in conservation and management, thus resulting these MPAs to be recognized and awarded for their best practices to continuously improve fish stock and other marine habitat. These results were evaluated by means of biophysical assessment which is being conducted twice a year.

The Agsalin Fish Sanctuary was awarded first prize winner for Best Locally Managed Marine Protected Area year 2017 given by Para EL Mar. It has paved way to join the search for Malinis at Masaganang Karagatan (MMK) 2017 bagging 2nd prize award amounting to Php One (1) million-peso worth of projects.

To progressively sustain efforts on protection, conservation, rehabilitation and management of coastal resources, support to community and fisher folks thru fishing gears and motorized boat interventions to motivate and help them augment their family income is pipelined.

VI. Objectives:

1. To conduct seaborne patrolling and apprehensions on illegal activities in the coastal areas of the municipality;
2. To augment the income of fishing families; and
3. To eliminate illegal fishing activities specially by using fine mesh net and active gear.

VIII. Project Management

2. **Municipal Agriculture Office thru CRM Coordinator** - leads in the project implementation activities, setting of project material specifications, group consultation, beneficiaries selection criteria, actual selection of beneficiaries, coordination with BAC, project material distribution and monitoring and evaluation activities.

3. **MFARMC** - conduct of meeting for project information dissemination, beneficiaries' selection and consultation and other barangay or group-level coordination activities.


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

IN RE: CONFISCATION OF NINE (9) PIECES OF LUMBER, FLITCHES AND BANCA HULL OF KALANTAS SPECIES HAVING AN AGGREGATE VOLUME OF 5.41 CUBIC METERS (2,295.00 BOARD FEET) APPREHENDED AT SITIO CURANGA, BARANGAY BENLI, BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO

ORDER

Records show that on January 18-19, 2021, at Sitio Curanga, Barangay Benli, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro, the Forest Protection and Law Enforcement Team of CENRO Roxas apprehended nine (9) pieces of lumber, flitches and banca hull of Kalantas species having an aggregate volume of 5.41 cubic meters (2,295.00 board feet), with an estimated fair market value of Php 103,275.00. Subject forest products had no claimant during the time it was apprehended and were hauled and deposited at the DENR-CENRO Roxas Oriental Mindoro compound for safekeeping. A Seizure Receipt and Seizure Order, both dated January 20, 2021 were issued by CENR Officer Alma E. Gibe, Seizure Officer.


Pursuant to Section 8 of DAO 97-32, the CENRO concerned posted Notices of Hearing on January 6, 2021, January 18, 2021 and February 2, 2021, in conspicuous public places within the locality, informing the claimant/s to appear and show cause why the apprehended items should not be confiscated in favor of the government. However, despite said notices no one came to claim ownership of the same, hence considered "ABANDONED."

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the apprehended nine (9) pieces of lumber, flitches and banca hull of Kalatas species having a total volume of 5.41 cubic meters (2,295.00 board feet), with an estimated fair market value of Php 103,275.00, are hereby **CONFISCATED** in favor of the government to be disposed of in accordance with existing DENR laws, rules and regulations governing the matter.
