
**WHEREAS**, pursuant thereto, there is a need to create and adopt a Memorandum of Partnership between and among the said officials;

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 23 (E.O. 23), "Declaring a Moratorium on the Cutting and Harvesting of Timber in the Natural and Residual Forest and Creating the Anti-Illegal Logging Task Force (AILTF)," was issued in 2011 as means to protect the remaining forest cover, prevent flash floods, preserve biodiversity, allow natural regeneration of residual forest, among others;

**WHEREAS**, to further implement the mandates of Presidential Decree 705 (PD 705), otherwise known as the "Revised Forestry Code of the Philippines" and Republic Act No. 9175 (RA 9175), otherwise known as "The Chainsaw Act of 2002", it is necessary to forge partnership among Law Enforcement Units;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant E.O. 23, the AILTF shall be composed of the DENR Secretary or his duly authorized representative as Chairman and the Secretary of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), Secretary of the Department of National Defense (DND), the Chief of Philippines National Police (PNP), the Chief of Staff of Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) or their authorized representatives, as the members;

**WHEREAS**, the creation of AILTF at DENR-CENRO level is crucial as it is the front liner in the implementation of forest protection activities in the field;

**WHEREAS**, the CENRO Socorro, in the execution of its duties and obligations, encounters difficulties in the enforcement of anti-illegal logging law, rules and regulations due to the involvement of armed groups and suspected insurgents;

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act 7160 or The Local Government Code, specifically mandates the Local Government Units (LGUs) to proactively participate in the protection and management of the natural resources within their administrative jurisdiction;


**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing premises and mutual covenants herein contained, the Parties hereby agree to enter into a **MEMORANDUM OF PARTNERSHIP (MOP)** for the restitution of **ORIENTAL MINDORO SAGIP KALIKASAN (SAKAL) TASK FORCE** subject to the following:


1. The Oriental Mindoro SAKAL Task Force is composed of the DENR-CENRO Socorro as the Chairman and NBI, PNP, Philippine Army, Provincial Government/City/Municipal ENR Officers, ABC Presidents, all with respective jurisdictions in Oriental Mindoro, as members thereof;
2. The task force will lead in the anti-illegal logging campaign and shall perform their respective responsibilities/functions, to wit:
  - a. The Task Force Chairman shall be responsible for the strategic direction, operational planning, and execution of Anti-Illegal Logging Campaign in Oriental Mindoro;
  - b. The NBI, PNP, Philippine Army, Provincial Government/City/Municipal ENR Officers and ABC Presidents shall actively support and jointly participate in the enforcement of all applicable laws on illegal logging and provide essential advice to the Task Force in the conduct thereof. They shall also extend back-up support to the DENR-CENRO enforcement personnel when needed;




- c. The Task Force shall conduct proactive environmental education and information campaigns on Anti-illegal logging within their areas of jurisdiction; and
  - d. The officials and personnel concerned shall attend capability trainings and meetings relative thereto.
3. This Memorandum of Partnership shall take effect immediately upon signing by the Parties.

**I. OPENING PROGRAM**

The Task Force meeting was conducted by Monitoring and Enforcement Section (MES) of CENRO-Socorro headed by CENRO Rodel M. Boyles and DMO IV, Leo G. Capon together with some MES personnel. The meeting were attended by members from National Bureau of Investigation (NBI), PGDH-ENR Office, City ENR Office and Philippine National Police (PNP), Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO) and Association of Barangay Captain (ABC) president of Puerto Galera, San Teodoro, Baco, Naujan, Victoria, Socorro, and Pola. A total of 42 SAKAL Task Force members (28-male and 14 female) had attended the said meeting. The meeting started at 10:00 o'clock in the morning with an opening prayer followed by singing of Philippine National Anthem and roll call of attendees.

**Message**

CENR Officer Rodel M. Boyles expressed his gratitude to all the members of SAKAL Task Force for attending the meeting. He recognize the importance of partnership with NBI, LGUs-MENROs, Brgy. Officials especially with PNP in the protection and conservation of our Forest. He also pointed out the importance of the created Task Force pursuant to Executive Order (EO) No. 23 in safeguarding our natural resources. He said that the DENR being the Chairman of the Task Force is always prepared and willing to assist the members. Also, we can harmonize this group with the Task Force Charcoal & Mining by the Provincial Government. The review of the Memorandum of partnership is very important since the Task Force will only meet once a year but this time we can agree for a rotational host for Task Force meeting to sustain the group and to be fruitful and effective. Each member can propose or suggest policy that will be tackled during regular meeting or special meeting, he added.

CENRO Boyles highlighted some provision of DAO 18-2020 "*promoting tree plantation development and liberalizing harvesting and transport of planted trees and tree derivatives for inclusive growth and sustainable development*". He said that trees in private land shall be registered in the nearest DENR office for the issuance of Certificate of Registration and the owner may request transport permit if he/she utilized said trees outside the plantation. He also mentioned the elements of Section 77 of P.D. 705 "*cutting, gathering, transporting and mere possession is strictly prohibited*".



## **II. OBJECTIVES**

- a. To review Memorandum of Partnership (MOP) and resolution adopting the Oriental Mindoro Sagip Kalikasan (SAKAL) Task Force for the implementation of Executive Order no. 23.

## **III. PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION**

### **a. State of the Philippine Forest**

DMO Leo G. Capon presented and discussed the State of the Philippine Forest and the scenario in Oriental Mindoro. He discussed some benefits of Forest to us. He said that Forest is the main source of food, water, clean air, electricity, shelter and livelihood. He mentioned that the Philippine Forest is among the most diverse in the world but also among the most endangered (nanganganib). Philippine Forest is one of the Biodiversity hotspot in the world with ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> for fishes and 5<sup>th</sup> for plants, trees and mammals and 8<sup>th</sup> for reptiles. In our country there are 8,120 flowering plants, 3,500 indigenous trees, 33 gymnosperms, 640 mosses, 2,400 fish, 3,000 endemic plants, he added.

DMO Capon presented the map showing the rapid loss of Forest cover from 1900 to 2010. From the total land area of 30 million, 21 million hectares of Forest in 1900, 6 million in 1988 and 800,000 hectares in 1999 and still shrinking at an average rate of 2% per year. He mentioned the top causes of Deforestation such as corporate large scale mining, massive forest conversion such as slash and burn which destroys or eradicates everything in a certain area even the smallest insects and plants, illegal logging by legal licensees and non-licensees and unsustainable forest management which leads to Global Warming.

He also discussed some Government actions to prevent Deforestation:

1. Declaring a moratorium on the cutting and harvesting of timber in the natural and residual forests and creating the anti-illegal logging task force (EO 23). Total ban on the cutting and harvesting in natural and residual forests throughout the country;
2. Continuous apprehension of illegally cut/transported forest products, filling of case and closure of wood processing plants';
3. Implementation of National Greening Program (EO 26 and 193).

He also presented the scenario in Oriental Mindoro which has two (2) classification such as Forestland with 49% forest cover and 51% A&D. Forestland has six (6) categories such as civil reservations, national parks and GRBS/WA, established timberland, established forest reserves, fishpond and unclassified. Forest cover are classified as Closed Forest, Open Forest and Mangrove with a total of 80,775 hectares, he added.

He also mentioned the major causes of deforestation in Oriental Mindoro such as timber poaching, charcoal making, forest fire (in cogonal area such as Bansud, Gloria) and slash and burn agriculture. Slash and burn agriculture is the most destructive causes of Deforestation in our province. Being the primary agency in protecting, managing and conserving our natural resources, we admit that we cannot



do this alone. It's everybody's concern that is the reason why we created this Task Force to collaborate with other agencies in protecting our natural resources.

**b. Review of Memorandum of Partnership and Resolution**

Forester Mindaros facilitated the review of the Memorandum of Partnership (MOP) and Resolution 2022-01 "Adopting the Oriental Mindoro Sagip Kalikasan (SAKAL) Task Force for the implementation of Executive Order No. 23. They corrected the official address and the spelling of the names of signatories. They also reviewed the "WITNESSETH" of the MOP of which they included the Presidential Decree 705 (PD 705), otherwise known as the "Revised Forestry Code of the Philippines" and Republic Act No. 9175 (RA 9175), otherwise known as "The Chainsaw Act of 2002". They also reviewed the duties of the Task Force.

Chief of Police, PLTCOL Nonato P. Banania, Jr of Naujan Municipal Police Station suggested to include the 1ST PMFC and 404<sup>th</sup> B Maneuver Company, RMFB and the body agreed. Also, the body agreed to finalize the MOP and Resolution before signing.

**c. Way forward**

Forester Mindaros announced that there will be a DENRO training on May 24-26, 2022 (tentative dates) and a meeting on the last quarter of the year.

**VII. OPEN FORUM**

**Question 1.** Chief of Police, PLTCOL Nonato P. Banania, Jr of Naujan Municipal Police Station ask if we can facilitate in a short time the issuance of cutting permits.

**Answer-** CENRO Rodel M. Boyles said the revision of manual of authorities is on-going to reduce the time of the issuance of cutting permits. The issuance of permits for the tree plantations (50 pcs. above) in private land is in CENRO level but for planted tree in private lot (1to 49 pieces) the issuance of cutting permits is in the Regional Office. The wood recovery permit is partial lifted and for 5 cubic meters (cu.m.) and below, the DENR Community Environment and Natural Officer (CENRO) or the implementing Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Officer (PENRO) will be the approving authority, while the regional executive directors cover timber volume above 16 cu.m. to more than 1,000 cu.m.

CENRO Boyles also partially explained the DAO 2020-18 "Promoting tree plantation development liberalizing harvesting and transport of planted trees and tree derivatives for inclusive growth and sustainable development". Tree plantations should be registered in this office and personnel of this office will conduct inventory to get the total volume of the plantation. He also explained the method in obtaining the volume of a tree. He requested the PNP to inquire first in the office if they encounter lumbers derived from registered



plantations. He mentioned that next year, seedlings donation will cater private lot owners so he encouraged the participants to plant trees because they serves as carbon sink.

**Question 2.** City ENRO, Wilfredo C. Landicho inquire about those lumbers brought to furniture shop for furniture making, is there a need to get a permit when transporting?

**Answer-** CENRO Boyles said they can hold the furniture's and coordinate to CENR Office for verification of permits. Those furniture shops are being monitored by this office. We have a list of furniture shops per municipality. We advise them to use lumbers with permits issued by DENR otherwise upon monitoring we apprehend those lumbers without permits, he added.

CENRO Boyles also mentioned the municipalities under CENRO-Socorro and CENRO-Roxas. The Municipality of Pinamalayan, Gloria and Bansud which is under the jurisdiction of CENRO-Socorro before is now under CENRO-Roxas.

**Question 3.** Chief of Police, PLTCOL Nonato P. Banania, Jr of Naujan Municipal Police Station ask what will they do to the expired Chainsaw permit?


**Answer-** The owner should renew the Chainsaw registration upon or before the expiration date or else those are subject for apprehension of this office. The Philippine Coconut Authority (PCA) is not authorized to issue Chainsaw permit pursuant with Republic Act 9175 "*Chainsaw Act of 2002*".

## VIII. CLOSING REMARKS


