Submitted is the report on the monitoring activity at Wildlife Rescue Center (WRC) of CENRO Roxas, Oriental Mindoro.

The team conduct monitoring activity on the Wildlife Rescue Center (WRC) located at So. Banti, Barangay San Roque, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro. The following activity undertaken was to monitor the health status of the wildlife species and check if it is ready to be release back into the wild. Also, conduct inventory of the existing wildlife species in the rescue center. As of March 2022, there were four remaining wildlife species in the facilities, out of four one of them was released back into the wildlife. The office acquired the custody of three (3) wildlife species through donations by a concern citizen. As of to date, there were six (6) species rehabilitated and monitored in the facilities. Moreover, the activities undertake was the monitoring of the improvement of fence as stipulated in the work and financial plan of the WRC Program FY 2022. As of to date, the activity is still on going as part of the improvement of Widlife Rescue Center.




