Respectfully submitted the report of two (2) wildlife species turned over to CENRO Roxas, Oriental Mindoro.

Two (2) Juvenile Asian Palm Civet (*Paradoxurus hermaphrodites*) or commonly known as “musang” or “alamid” were turned over to CENRO Roxas, Oriental Mindoro. It was hand over by Mr. Heny Malicse, the Barangay Captain of Barangay Maliwanag, Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro on June 01 at 9:00 in the morning. According to Capt. Malicse it was caught in the wild by a resident and surrenders it to the barangay. It was checked by Protected Area Coastal Management Personnel before it was turn in to the Wildlife Rescue Center (WRC) that is located at So. Banti, Barangay San Roque, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro for rehabilitation and monitoring before it will be release back into the wild.
