






Figure 1. Inventory and inspection of water supply facilities in Gene Pool Station








Figure 2. Minor Repair of water supply facilities in Gene Pool Station.




Figure 4. Repairs and maintenance of signages in Iglit Station




Figure 5. Harvesting of cogon to be use for the repairs of kiosk or dirty kitchen in Magawang Station




Figure 10. Cleaning and maintenance of station (from top to bottom) Magtangkob, Iglit and Magawang station


