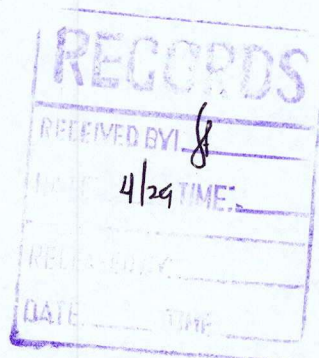

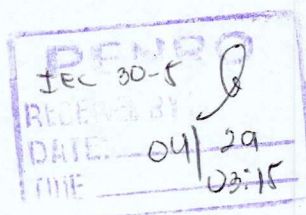

LECTURE CONDUCTED RE: ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND CLIMATE CHANGE MITIGATION


