On June 14, 2022, the Mt.Calavite Wildlife Sanctuary held a meeting at the Municipal Gymnasium of Paluan, Occidental Mindoro with sphere headed by Protected Area Superintendent Orlando R.Ramos. The consultation meetings conducted with the local communities inside the protected area highlighted the following agenda, to wit:

1. Indigenous People Right Acts (IPRA LAW 8371)
2. National Integrated Protected Area System Act (RA 7586)
3. Revised Forestry Code of the Philippines Section 68 of PD 705

The meeting are composed of (34) individuals in which (3) are females and (31) are males. The meeting started with a prayer followed by introducing of the participants by themselves. The discussion of the first topic is opened by Punong Balayan Ryan Parisan it was discussed and has been properly moved into the second topic which is also discussed and properly close and end up into the last topic but before the last topic has been moved there is a suggestion/request of different Punong Balayan/Leaders in which they agreed to have another meeting to be conduct once the schedule agreed has been finalize.



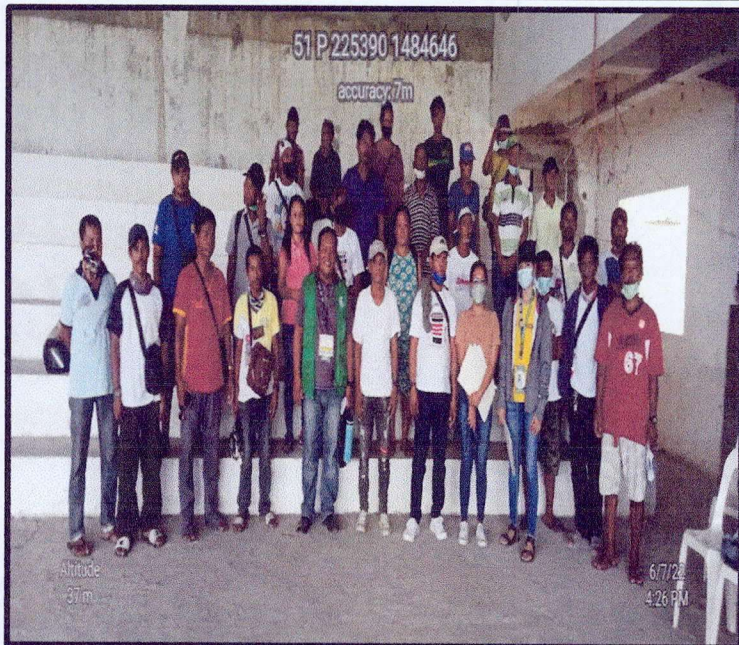




















The meeting was officially adjourned at 4:27 PM assisted by the 3 MCWS Personnel.
