



Highlights on the Observance of World Ocean's Day Province of Romblon (2nd Qtr., C.Y. 2022)

BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE

The DENR as the primary government agency responsible for the conservation, management, development and proper use of the country's environment and natural resources led in the observance of the United Nations' World Oceans Day on June 8, 2022 with the theme "Revitalization: Collective Action for the Ocean."

This event is in accordance to the adopted resolution 63/111 of 5 December 2008 of the UN General Assembly. The concept of a World Oceans Day begun in 1992 at the Earth Summit in Rio de Janeiro as a way to celebrate our world's shared ocean and our personal connection to the sea, as well as to raise awareness about the crucial role the ocean plays in our lives and the important ways people can help protect it.

The United Nations considers oceans as "essential to food security and the health and survival of all life, power our climate and are a critical part of the biosphere." The official designation of World Oceans Day is an opportunity to raise global awareness of the current challenges faced by the international community in connection with the oceans.


Likewise, being island province, most of the people lived along coastal areas and majority of them earned income from both farming and fishing industry. The highly vulnerable sector in these coastal communities faced greater impact of climate change, global warming, overfishing, and problems on microplastics and mismanaged coastal development. Raising environmental awareness and mobilizing collaborative action serve both mitigation and adaptation measures in addressing this concern.

GOAL AND OBJECTIVE/S

The activity aims to enhance awareness of all concerned stakeholders and mobilize local support towards specific environmental actions.

Specifically, its objectives are:

- 1.) To coordinate with key stakeholders particularly LGU's and PO's on the significance of the environmental event; and
- 2.) To mobilize support from its key stakeholders in the conduct of relevant environmental actions.



METHODOLOGY

The methodology covers the hanging of tarpaulin; local coordination with key officials of LGU's/PO's/communities; short lecture with pledge of commitment; distribution of CEPA materials, and the conduct of Coastal Clean-up.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Results show that hanging of tarpaulin in DENR premises increased stakeholder's information and participation on the Observance of World Ocean's Day featuring the theme: "Revitalization: Collective Action for the Ocean."

Likewise, the concerned personnel of CDS had coordinated with key officials of LGU's as well as PO's and the communities in Romblon, Romblon that resulted to mobilization of local resources in support to the successful conduct of this environmental event.

On June 9, 2022, technical personnel from CDS delivered short lecture to the participants and administered pledge of commitment. On the said lecture, participants learned on the basic information on World Ocean's Day like brief history, importance/value of oceans, and strengthen support/commitment of the participants in this event. Then, various CEPA Materials also distributed to them.

Lastly, sixty (60) participants voluntarily collected trash along the beach of Ginablan, Romblon, Romblon. This environmental effort supports the national mandate in keeping our beaches clean.

CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The observance of World Ocean's Day successfully conducted in collaboration with the LGU's, PO's and the concerned communities.

With this, we highly recommend that this Office shall observe this environmental event every year covering the entire Province of Romblon.






