10. WORKSHOP

During workshops, the participants were divided into three teams (Team Narra, Team Quezon and Team Rizal). Activities conducted during workshop are as follows:

- a. Scenario of actual apprehension of moving conveyance (topdown) loaded with lumbers;
- b. Presentation of apprehension report and pertinent attachments
- c. Drafting and presentation of the following:
 - application for Search Warrant
 - Motion two (2) alternative devices
 - Return of Search Warrant

11. COMMENTS

The following inconsistencies were noticed by the speakers during presentation of output for each activity workshop:

- a. Apprehension Report:
 - Should be specific in describing the apprehended items especially on conveyances;
 - Always identify yourselves, establish your authority, ask to present permits, inform their violation, and always informed their rights (Miranda Doctrine);
 - Pictures should be clear, as much as possible showing the suspect/s still onboard on the conveyance;
- b. Drafting application for Search Warrant
 - Should be specific in detailing the exact location of the subject house, as the owner has maybe other houses;
 - Should be specific for the place to be searched, and the items to be searched;
 - Finally, the authentication of those who made the surveillance pictures and video
- c. Motion for two (2) alternative devices
 - Make sure that the specification of the gadget/mobile phone to used has been correctly stated

12. ISSUES CLARIFIED DURING THE ORIENTATION - WORKSHOP:

- a. What agency will issue a certification concerning wildlife subject for filing a criminal complaint under RA 9147. Pursuant to SEP Law, the PCSD will issue such certification;
- b. For close van passing through a forest product monitoring station/checkpoint, search could only be allowed if the driver gave his consent (warrantless search) if he resist, request for the assistance of PNP;
- c. For Chainsaw, though the suspects are engaging in illegal logging activities but not caught in the actual use of chainsaw which supposed to be supported by pictures, better file complaint under Section 7 item 1 of RA 9175. But if the perpetrators were caught in the actual use of chainsaw, file complaint under Section 7 item 4 of RA 9175;
- d. For Plea Bargaining, it should be understood that there must be mutual agreement between the prosecution and the defense party. Even if the court finds merit for the motion for plea bargaining however, if the complainant refuse to accept it, then no plea bargaining should be happened;

13. RECOMMENDATIONS:

- a. Regular conduct of refresher training course for all personnel under Enforcement Section;
- b. Give considerable time for workshops to enable enforcers to be familiarized on the required actions/procedures to be taken on the subject activity;
- c. Training for team leaders how to handle a team in times of operations/investigations;


