ON MAY 23-25, 2022 AT VILLA CRISTINA HOTEL AND RESORT LOCATED AT ANTIPOLO CITY, PHILIPPINES

In compliance to Special Order No. 2022-348 issued on May 13, 2022 and Memorandum dated May 16, 2022, with corresponding instruction from PENRO Felizardo B. Cayatoc thru Travel Order No. 2022-05-19-1939 with inclusive dates from May 21 to 27, 2022, respectfully submitted is the report of the undersigned relative the above subject.

Pursuant to Special Order clothed with further instructions, it was presented that as part of the continuing endeavor to optimize the environmental law enforcement and protection efforts of the agency, it is necessary to conduct the "Basic Intelligence Seminar for Environmental Law Enforcers" throughout the country.

The actual and rigid seminar was conducted on May 23-25, 2022 at Villa Cristina Hotel and Resort. It was attended by at least sixty (60) participants represented almost all of the regional offices of DENR. The seminar had practical field exercises on how to gather data and information to form part in the intelligence cycle and/or system and other related activities.

## A. ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

The following topics were discussed by the Resource Speakers from the Philippine National Police Intelligence Group of the Directorate for Intelligence during the conduct of basic intelligence seminar:

- 1. Introduction to Intelligence
- 2. Observation and Description Exercise
- 3. Intelligence Cycle: Basic Principles of Intelligence Operation and Four (4) Phases of Intelligence Cycle
- 4. Introduction to Intelligence Tradecraft
- 5. Casing/Surveillance
- 6. Elicitation, Interview & Provocation
- 7. Practical Exercise (Casing/Surveillance)
- 8. Critiques
- 9. Cybercrime Monitoring and Investigation

## **B. COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Realistically, the Resource Speakers revealed that the above-mentioned topics and practical exercises are conducted for the duration of at least six (6) months. However, for the purpose of strengthening the enforcement units in different CENROs of the DENR, a compressed and realistic approach had been conceptualized for the seminar in order to abreast the participants on what intelligence cycle and systems really are.

Before the presentations of topics of different Resource Speakers, a **SECRET** reminder was always on top priority. As such, the participants neither allow taking photographs nor videos to the power point presentations that flashes in the screen. Subsequently, three (3) presentations more passed and the undersigned made the point of order to elaborate and made a humble request. Though, it is prohibited but the undersigned immediately requested for copies of their power point presentations in order for us to effectively disseminate those topics and strategies to other members of the enforcement team who are not able to attend the said seminar.






