AGREEMENT (FLAG) COVERING A TOTAL AREA OF 47.31 HECTARES LOCATED AT SITIOS MACANDRING AND PETPETEN,

BRGY, LANGOGAN, PUERTO PRINCESA CITY.

This has reference to the above mentioned subject pertaining to the application for Forest Landuse Agreement (FLAg) of Langogan Power Corporation for their 6.8MW Langogan Hydroelectric Power Project (HEPP) located at Sitios Macandring and Petpeten, Brgy. Langogan, Puerto Princesa City in compliance to the instructions stated in the said fax message.

Replotting of the geospatial data Infrastructure Section accordingly the area being applied has an overlapped of around 308 sq. m. with the NGP site which was established in 2017. Relative thereto, respectfully forwarded is the Memorandum dated May 13, 2022 of Forester Dexter A. Bolido, NGP Coordinator. Based from verification on the ground conducted by Forester Bolido together with the former site manager/coordinator of concerned NGP partner and Mr. Andy Fernandez, a representative from Langogan Power Corporation (LPC), disclosed that there is no overlapping in the NGP area however the nearest portion is close to overlap.

With regards to the resubmitted proof of financial capability and payment of three (3) years government rental fees amounting to PhP92,547.60 for the Special Land Use Permit (SLUP) issued, we are also forwarding the letter dated April 27, 2022 of Mr. Steven William Dorland, Chairman of LPC together with certified copies of Bank Certification and Official Receipt Nos. 7460986 T amounting to PhP92,547.60 dated November 20, 2017 and 4886771 E amounting to PhP55,920 November 17, 2017 representing the three (3) years rental fees and Performance Bond respectively.

Further, it was clarified in the letter of Mr. Dorland that the submitted clearance from the National Commission on Indigenous Peoples' Compliance Certificate (Certificate of Compliance to the FPIC Process and Certification that the Community has given its Consent) is same with the Certificate of Precondition (certified copy of said document is hereto attached).
