SUBJECT: INSPECTION REPORT RE: CONSTRUCTION OF CAUSEWAY

OF IPILAN NICKEL CORPORATION IN BARANGAY MAASIN,

BROOKE'S POINT, PALAWAN

Respectfully forwarded is the memorandum of CENRO Brooke's Point, Palawan dated May 25, 2022 relative the above subject.

Per memorandum, CENRO Brooke's Point conducted inspection on May 23, 2022 together with the representative of Ipilan Nickel Corporation to the on-going construction of causeway in the offshore/seashore area of Barangay Maasin, Brooke's Point, Palawan. Presently, the length of dumped/filled materials for said causeway reached up to 102 meters with width of 10 meters. It was verified that the causeway is within the area applied for Miscellaneous Lease Agreement (MLA) fronting the alienable and disposable lands.

Further, CENRO Brooke's Point sent a letter on May 30, 2022 to Ipilan Nickel Corporation informing them and to suspend the on-going construction of causeway thru a Cease and Desist Order until such time that the Provisional Miscellaneous Lease Agreement be issued by the Regional Executive Director pending the final issuance of Miscellaneous Lease Agreement by the DENR Secretary.

Furthermore, the undersigned together with CENR Officer of Brooke's Point attended the Committee Hearing of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Palawan on May 31, 2022. During the hearing, it was found out that Ipilan Nickel Corporation has not acquired a Free and Prior Informed Consent (FPIC) from the Indigenous People. The Provisional Miscellaneous Lease Agreement is not yet issued by the Regional Office. That is the reason for the issuance of a letter/CDO to the company. Likewise, the Chairperson, Committee on Environment of Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Palawan advised the company to coordinate to the Office of NCIP for the issuance of FPIC or other reliefs in relation to the operations in the mining site of the company.

Respectfully forwarded is the Memorandum dated May 24, 2022 of the Chief, Enforcement and Monitoring Section regarding the above cited subject.

Please be informed per inspection conducted by personnel of this office on May 23, 2022 with the representative of the Ipilan Nickel Corporation disclosed that the mining compny is currently constructing causeway in the offshore/seashore area located at Barangay Maasin, Brooke's Point, Palawan. Per survey conducted starting from the shoreline, at present the length of the causeway is 102 meters with width of 10 meters with a total area of 1,174.86 square meters. It was verified and determined that the area where the company constructing their causeway is within the area applied for Miscellaneous Lease Agreement (MLA) located in the subject barangay.

During the inspection, the company's representative provided photo copy of the Application for Permit to Construct Causeway/Port approved by PPA Port Manager Elizalde M. Ulson dated April 5, 2022 which accordingly their basis or permit to proceed with the construction.

Per record, the Ipilan Nickel Corporation applied for Miscellaneous Lease Agreement on the offshore/seashore area containing an area of 118,580 square meters adjacent to Lot 1166, Pls 96 identical to Lot No. 5701, Cad 796-D intended for causeway and jetty port of the said mining company. The Appraisal and CSW Report and other documentary requirements were already submitted per our Memorandum dated December 21, 2021 and March 14, 2022 of other lacking requirements in compliance with the Memorandum of the PENRO dated December 28, 2021 received by this office on January 24, 2022. To this date, this office had not yet received an approved Miscellaneous Lease Agreement issued in favor of the said company.

In view hereof, it is recommended that Cease and Desist Order be issued to the company to suspend or stop the construction until such time that the lease agreement be issued/granted. Further recommended that EMB – PEMO Palawan is requested to validate the terms and conditions of the Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) and issuance of Notice of Violation be imposed, if warrants.

Attached herewith the inspection report, sketch maps and other documents for ready reference.

In response to verbal instruction of CENRO Conrado M. Corpuz regarding on the above subject.

Pleased be informed that on May 23, 2022 the undersigned personnel together with EMB personnel, EMS I Carl Anthony Madamag accompanied by Forester Marvin Arleguei, Head Environmental Department of Ipilan Nickel Corporation has conducted inspection/verification on the construction of causeway/port of Ipilan Nickel Mining Corporation at Barangay Maasin, Brookes Point, Palawan.

Prior to the conduct of the inspection/verification, the team made a courtesy call with the Ipilan Nickel Mining Corporation management and informed them about the purpose.

Hereunder are the information and details of the inspection/verification conducted.

- 1. Prior to actual inspection on the area while waiting to for the rain to stop at Ipilan Nickel Office, the team made an interview to Forester Marvin Arleguei and asked regarding on the permits pertaining to the construction/operation of causeway/port. They provide of copies from Port Management Office-Palawan duly approved by Elizalde M. Ulson, port manager dated April 5, 2022; Permit to cut issuing from the Philippine Coconut Authority Province of Palawan (PCA); Copy of Appraisal Report on MLC 045306-13 of Ipilan Nickel Corporation represented by Carlo A. Matilac under Plan MLC-045301-D with an area of 118,580 sq.m.
- 2. Further, the team proceeded to the subject area and conducted ocular inspection to verify if there is on-going construction of causeway/port. As per inspection, there was an ongoing construction of causeway/port seen in the area;
- 3. It was observed also that the river is still flow naturally;
- 4. Further investigation, based on the record on file of this office that Ipilan Nickel Corporation had already applied by Miscellaneous Lease Agreement (MLC 045306-13). However, still waiting for the approval by the Regional Executive Director, secured ECC from EMB and SEP Clearance from PCSD.

Assessment and Evaluation

- 1. There was an on-going construction of causeway/port due to approval of Marlon N. Sendaydiego, Manager Engineering Services Division and Elizalde M. Ulson, Port manager;
- 2. No cutting of trees found during the inspection;
- 3. The mining company had secured ECC and SEP Clearance from the concerned agencies;
- 4. No approved or issuance by Regional Executive Director regarding on the application of Miscellaneous Lease Agreement by the Ipilan Nickel Corporation

Recommendation/s:

- 1. The undersigned recommend for the meantime to stop the construction of causeway/port while waiting for the approval of Regional Executive Director for the application of Miscellaneous Lease Agreement and other pertinent documents regarding on the construction.
- 2. Also recommended that before the start of operation, the mining company must secure all necessary documents pertaining to mining operation.






Pictures above showing the initial construction of causeway/port by Ipilan Nickel Corporation located at Barangay Maasin, Brookes Point, Palawan








Pictures above showing the river located near the construction of causeway/port of Ipilan Nickel Corporation

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This Certificate shall cover the extraction of nickel laterite ore within the 2,835.06-hectare Mineral Production Sharing Agreement (MPSA No. 017-93-IV) of area located at Barangays Ipilan, Mambalot, Maasin, and Calasaguen, Municipality of Brooke's Point, Province of Palawan. The proposed *Ipilan Nickel Project* shall have a maximum annual production rate of one million (1,000,000) dry metric tons (DMT) of nickel ore through surface mining method. It shall have the following components:

- 1. Mining/extraction area;
- 2. Crushing and screening plant with approximate rated capacity of 250 t/day;
- Primary stockpile area with a land area of 10 ha and composed of solar/wind drying pads, ore stockpile, settling ponds, and equipment service area;
- Coastal/secondary stockpile area with a land area of 20 ha and located near the causeway;
- 5. Haul roads;
- 6. Causeway to be located at Barangay Mambalot; and
- 7. Support facilities which includes administration facilities, medical facilities, a campsite/living area, an assay laboratory, workshops, a water supply system, power generation and fuel storage are, oil storage area, sediment control structures, waste overburden storage area and waste management facilities.

This Certification is issued pursuant to the provisions of Presidential Decree No. 1586 and in accordance to DENR Administrative Order No. 2003-30. Non-compliance with any of the provisions of this Certificate shall be a sufficient cause for the cancellation of this Certificate and/or imposition of a fine in an amount not to exceed Fifty Thousand Pesos (\$\mathbb{P}\$50,000.00) for every violation thereof, without prejudice to imposition of penalties under other environmental laws. The EMB, however, is not precluded from re-evaluating and correcting any deficiencies or errors that may be found after issuance of this Certificate.
