SECRETARY IN BEHALF OF PENRO - MARINDUQUE FOR THE CONVEYANCE OF A PORTION OF A PROPERTY OWNED BY THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF MARINDUQUE TO THIS OFFICE

This matter refers to the request of PENRO – Marinduque for representation as regards the conveyance of the lot, wherein our office building is situated, which is currently owned by the Provincial Government of Marinduque.

The DENR, through former Regional Executive Director (RED) Vicente P. Paragas, entered into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) dated June 1, 2006 with the late Provincial Governor of Marinduque Carmencita O. Reyes, as authorized under Sangguniang Panlalawigan (SP) Resolution No. 637, series of 2006, for the conveyance of the lot which is currently occupied by PENRO-Marinduque for its office building and other facilities. However, based on available records, the MOA between the Provincial Government of Marinduque and the DENR was unsigned and there were likewise no available records nor reports whether such conveyance pursuant to the MOA was perfected nor any documents were executed in relation thereto.

To this day, PENRO-Marinduque has been occupying its office building for several years without any title or document of any sort to legalize our possession of the property. Thus, this Office through the undersigned has expressed desire to request from the Provincial Government of Marinduque, through the Honorable Governor Presbitero J. Velasco, Jr., with regard to the conveyance of the lot in which PENRO – Marinduque's building is situated to formalize our proprietorship therein and to further strengthen DENR's field offices.

At present, we are planning to construct a storage room and a probable expansion of the office within the property to meet the needs of our agency, however we cannot initiate such action without having a legal right or title over the said property. Enclosed herewith are



the photographs of PENRO – Marinduque's existing buildings and facilities within the subject lot for your perusal. Also enclosed is a sketch plan for your reference.

In relation to this, we are seeking for your support and guidance in securing the necessary formalities and we humbly request for your representation, being the highest authority of the DENR, to act for and on behalf of the agency and this Office.

We trust that you find our humble request worthy of your attention and consideration.
