Please be informed that CENRO Brooke's Point hired FPOs together with Blue Guards hired by Municipal LGU Bataraza were continuously doing protection and conservation activities within and nearby the PA vicinities including regular monitoring and seaborne/foot patrolling to detect any illegal activities that could affect the PA and the wildlife therein. Likewise coordination and linkages with other law enforcement agencies was continuously strengthened to ensure that the existing laws, rules and regulations were implemented to protect and preserve the island's biodiversity.

Per report showed an increasing number of birds (*Kamaso*) for this month with a highest count of 18, 120 conducted by FPOs on April 26, 2022. There were also three (3) heads of Marine Turtles laid 260 eggs and transferred properly to the hatchery area and 234 eggs of marine turtles hatched and properly released and assisted to reach the seashore this month.

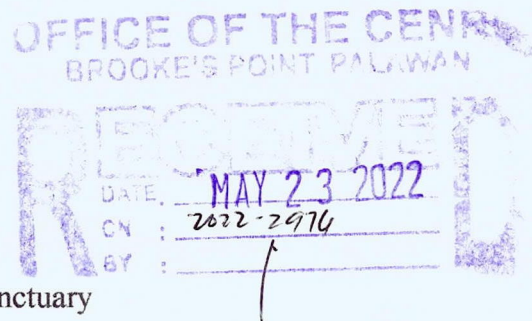

## MONTHLY PROTECTION AND CONSERVATION ACTIVITIES WITHIN PROTECTED AREA

### Activities Conducted:

a. Monitoring of Marine Turtle Nesting Sites

The assigned Forest Protection Officers (FPOs) in the island conducted regular monitoring of the Marine Turtle Nesting Sites. There were 3 heads of Marine Turtles that laid 260 eggs and are transferred properly to the hatchery area to protect the eggs from wild nest predation and to increase the number of eggs to be hatched. Proper handling with extra care to eggs was applied and proper documentation with stick marking with stated number of eggs transferred and date of eggs laid was put beside the nest.

A total of 234 eggs of marine turtle hatched this month and hatchlings were properly guided to reach the seashore. *(Please see attached photos/documentation).*

b. Monthly Bird Counting

Assigned FPOs conducted bird counting regularly at the island in daily basis to monitor the number of birds specially Kamaso in the island. This month, there were highest counts of 18,120 heads of Kamaso counted. According to the FPOs assigned in the island, the continuous increase in the number of birds counted is maybe due to the good weather condition and maybe there is sufficient food supply in the nearby islands.

c. Coastal Clean-Up

Assigned FPOs were also tasked to conduct coastal clean-up regularly. This month, they have collected 23 sacks of mix nonbiodegradable garbage such as plastic bottles, plastic bags, Styrofoams, nylons, ropes and rubbers.

They also conducted hauling and disposal of the sacks of garbage to the mainland Bataraza.

d. Monitoring of Tabon Birds Nesting Sites

FPOs hired by the DENR CENRO Brooke's Point with assistance from Blue Guards hired by LGU Bataraza conducted monitoring of Tabon Birds Nesting Sites within the forested area of the island. Nesting Sites monitored, recorded and documented.

e. Seaborne/Foot Patrolling

The assigned FPO's major task is to conduct daily foot patrolling and/or seaborne patrolling within the vicinities of the island to detect any illegal activities that could cause harm to the wildlife living within the protected area including nearby marine areas. During seaborne patrolling, Fishermen ducking near the island's shoreline were investigated and oriented properly regarding the policies being implemented in the island and advised them to leave the vicinity of the island to avoid harm and disturbance to the wildlife.

f. Other activities

1. Maintenance of the Ranger Station

FPOs assigned in the island together with the Bantay Dagat were regularly cleaning inside and outside the ranger house.

2. Rat Trap Installation and Retrieval


FPOs continuously conducting installation of mouse traps. No rats trap/retrieved since there were 2 cats temporarily deployed in the island as approved by PAMB Members during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter PAMB Meeting.

3. On-going preparation of CEPA Materials (pamphlets and policy signages).


4. Conduct of IEC/Orientation to visitors in the island regarding the rules and regulations being implemented in the island and further assisted the visitors in the conduct of coastal clean-up. This month there were 59 visitors in the island 21 are male and 38 are female.

5. Participated/Attended Protected Area Information System (PAIS) User Acceptance Testing via zoom application.

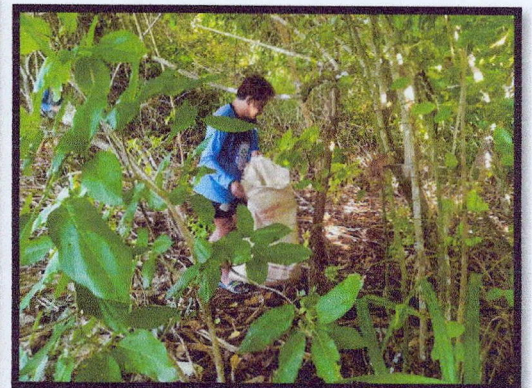
