Per memorandum, CENRO Puerto Princesa, submitted the LAWIN Patrol Plan for the 3rd Quarter CY 2022 from the period of July to September 2022. CENRO Puerto Princesa have two (2) Sectors with total of eighteen (18) Patrollers and six (6) of them are forest protection officers under on Job Order Contract.

The north sector has approximate 100,000 hectares of natural forest and 406.13 hectares NGP graduated areas while the south sector has approximate 83,000 hectares of natural forest and 979.65 hectares NGP graduated areas. A total of 188,561.77 hectares of conservation areas are the planned target for LAWIN Patrol.

Respectfully submitting the Lawin Patrol Plan for July to September 2022 of CENRO Puerto Princesa.

Please be informed that CENRO Puerto Princesa is composed of two sectors with a total of Eighteen (18) Lawin patrollers. The North Sector (with approximately 100,000 hectares of natural forest and 406.13 hectares of NGP graduated areas) is under the leadership of Assistant Forest Protection & Law Enforcement Chief For. Arjay Gregas and Team Leader FR Raymund Sapalo and FR Neil James Verzosa. While the South Sector (with approximately 83,000 hectares of natural forest and 979.65 NGP graduated areas) is led by Assistant Forest Protection & Law Enforcement Chief For. Lim Bryan Kutat and Team Leader FT1 Rommel Adato, FR Roldan Mercado and FR Armando Dolor.

A total area of 188, 561.77 hectares is planned target for LAWIN patrol.

Conservation targets	Forest loss will be reduced by 6% per year starting 2017. Maintain the water quality of rivers, streams, lakes, wetlands and other water bodies within the next five years to guarantee sufficient supply of clean water for both rural and urban areas. Maintain the remaining natural forest and residual forests to serve as habitat and breeding grounds for the endemic species specially those identified as indicator species. The visibility of the patrollers will be increased to raise the awareness of the community regarding environmental issues and concerns.


