

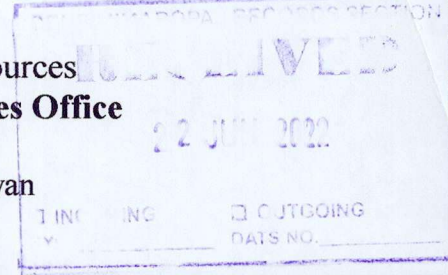

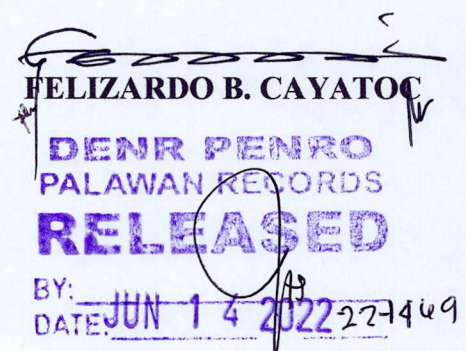



**ACTIVITY REPORT ON THE CONDUCTED MONTH OF THE OCEAN 2022**  
**CELEBRATION ON MAY 26-28, 2022 AT ROBINSONS PLACE PALAWAN AND**  
**SNAKE ISLAND-NATIONAL COASTAL AND MARINE CENTER FOR RESEARCH**

By virtue of Presidential Proclamation No. 57 issued on 11 December 1998, the Month of the Ocean is celebrated in the Philippines during the month of May. As mandated by the said proclamation, the DENR are directed to establish coordinative and oversight mechanisms to all organization and institutions involved in the celebration of the Month of the Ocean. This year's celebration with the theme "Protect and Restore Ecosystems and Biodiversity" highlights the importance and significance of conservation, protection, and sustainable management of Philippine coastal and marine resources. The activity aims to promote ocean conservation, protection and marine resources sustainability; increase the appreciation and understanding of the public about the DENR programs and projects especially on the coastal and marine environment; and to actively involve the students/public in increasing awareness through creative form activities such as environmental quiz bee, photo exhibit of marine protected areas and creative art painting.

The activity was conducted on May 26-27, 2022 in coordination with SIBOL, CENRO Puerto Princesa City, Palawan Council for Sustainable Development Staff (PCSDS), City ENRO, and Protected Area Management Office – Puerto Princesa Subterranean River National Park (PAMO-PPSRNP) at Robinsons Place Palawan and participated by a total of 100 individuals, composed of 38 males and 62 females.

On May 26, 2022, the program started at 10:45AM with opening prayer led by the Master of Ceremony, Research Assistant Edilita Demonguitan, followed by the DENR MIMAROPA National Anthem, featuring the Marine Protected Areas in MIMAROPA. TSD Chief Johnny P. Lilang welcomed the participants. After his speech, he was invited up front together with CDS Chief Rhodora Ubani, OIC CENRO PPC Pedro Velasco, Ms. Sheryl Docto of Palawan State University, and Ms. Geraldin Failon of Holy Trinity University to commence the ribbon cutting that signifies the photo exhibit being officially open to the public. OIC CENRO PPC Pedro Velasco, along with the SIBOL Deputy Chief, Mr. Marlito Guidote, and PPSRNP PASu Elizabeth Maclang, also gave their messages, emphasizing the significance of the event.

After lunch, the quizmaster, Forest Technician I Marjorie Joy Ortega, alongside Ms. Jannica Aurelio and the undersigned, began hosting the environmental quiz bee contest. A total of twenty-five (25) questions were created by the team in relation to the theme "Protect and Restore Ecosystems and Biodiversity" using the platform [www.mentimeter.com](http://www.mentimeter.com). The quiz was taken by a total of fifteen (15) college students from Palawan State University, Western Philippines University, and Holy Trinity University. These are the top 3 students who won the said interactive contest namely: Yendollane Trojello from WPU garnering 19,057 points followed by Glycell Jade C. Laboto from PSU garnering 13,354 points, and Cydel Aganon from HTU garnering 12,906 points.

CDS Chief Ma. Vivian Soriano, together with the SIBOL Site Team Leader, Ms. Joy Caseres, led the awarding ceremony and presented the grand prizes to the top 3 winners. The students and coaches were given certificates and consolation prizes for their active participation.

After the awarding, the participants were able to explore their creativity thru tote bag art painting. The activity concluded at 4:40PM with a group photo.

Afterwards, the photos of Marine Protected Areas in Palawan and other pictures and banners related to coastal and marine were exhibited at the Robinsons Place Palawan until closing time of May 27, 2022.

On May 28, 2022, the DENR PENRO personnel conducted the coastal clean-up drive at Snake Island – National Coastal and Marine Center for Research in relation to the month of the ocean celebration. The activity was participated by a total of forty-two (42) individuals composed of 13 males and 29 females.

The participants were divided into two (2) groups and classified into designated areas of the island, such as the southern area led by Law Enforcement Officer Dionisio A. Mahilum and the northern area led by Research Assistant Jamael B. Masacal. A total of 29 trash bags weighing 133 kilos were collected, covering a distance of approximately 1.5 kilometers.

The trash data form used was adapted from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration Marine Debris Program (NOAA MDP) standardized marine debris shoreline survey protocols.

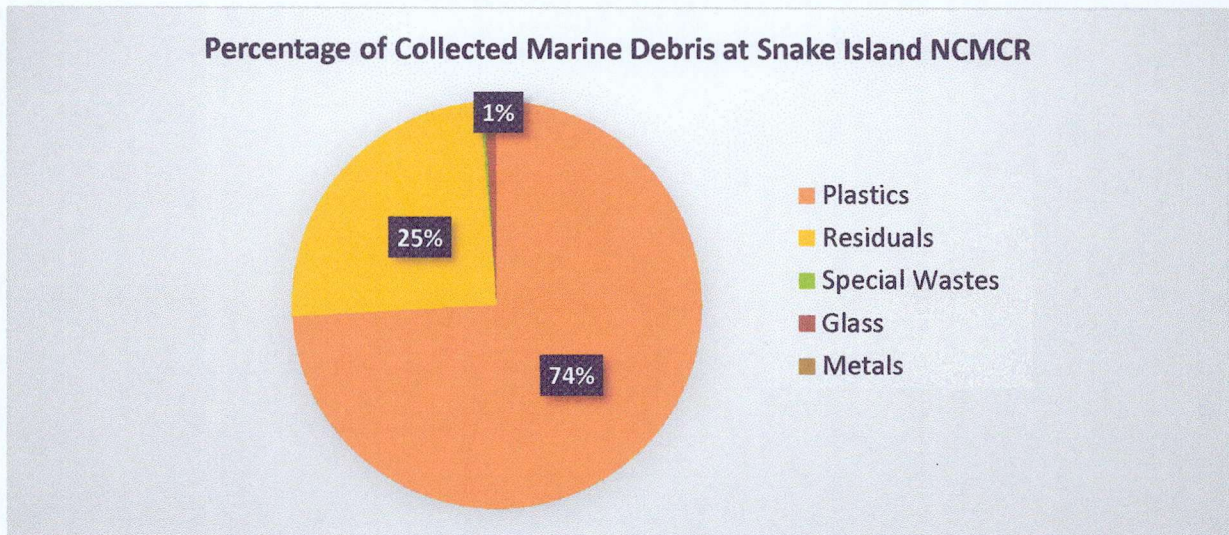


Figure 2: Bar graph showing the percentage of collected marine debris at Snake Island NCMCR on May 28, 2022

Later, the participants were instructed to classify the collected marine debris using the Trash Data Form to witness the types of marine debris that dominates the coastal areas. After the sorting, the type of marine debris that dominated the island was Plastics (3, 817 pieces) followed by Residuals (1,270 pieces) and Glasses (50 pieces). (See figure 2 for the percentage of debris collected).

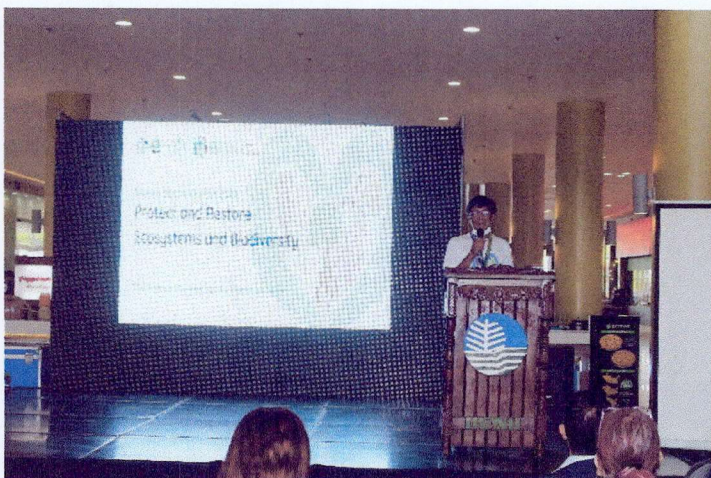

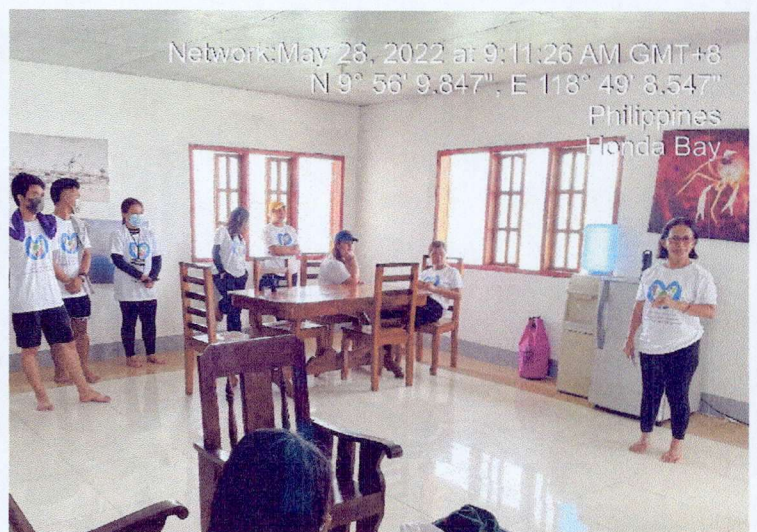
