

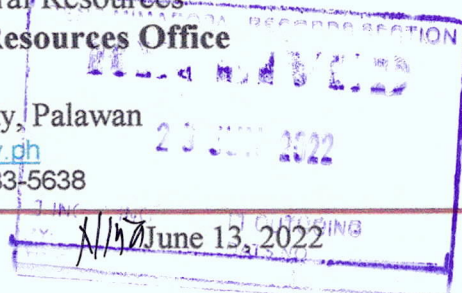





Please be informed that the undersigned joined the activity on “Coordination Meeting and MPA Management Board, Stakeholder’s Convergence and MPA Network Summit Workshop” held at Ysidore Garden, Roxas, Palawan on May 19, 2022. The event was organized by C3 Philippines and Roxas Municipal Agriculture Office. The attendees are the Marine Protected Area Management Council of the fourteen (14) coastal barangays of Roxas, Palawan.

ECOMS I Corvera lectured about Green Island Bay Profile. The data presented is from the 2017 Coastal and Marine Ecosystem Management Project (CMEMP). From the data, the coral cover of Roxas is categorized as “Poor” and the seagrass cover is categorized as “Fair”. The mangrove data from the 2019 survey identified twenty-five (25) species in Roxas, Palawan. Other wildlife stranding response and annual monitoring activities of CENRO Roxas were also presented.
