## BRIEF BACKGROUND

The “Month of the Ocean” (MOO) is celebrated annually in the Philippines during the month of May by virtue of Presidential Proclamation No. 57 issued in 1998. It mandates the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) and the Department of Agriculture-Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (DA-BFAR) to spearhead the observance of the MOO in collaboration with the different sectors of the society through the conduct of activities highlighting the conservation, protection, and sustainable management of the country’s coastal and ocean resources.

For this year’s MOO, the theme will be adopting UNESCO’s Ocean Decade Challenge 2 “*Protect and Restore Ecosystems and Biodiversity*”, which aims to understand the effects of multiple stressors on ocean ecosystems and develop solutions to manage and restore ecosystems and the rich biological diversity found therein under changing environmental and social conditions.

In line with this, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources – Province of Romblon has lined-up a simultaneous Coastal Clean-up activity and Crown-of-Thorns Starfish (COTS) removal conducted on May 21, 2022, within the coastal areas of the province in celebration of the MOO.

The said event was participated by different private and government agencies spearheaded by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) in collaboration with DA-BFAR, PNP-DILG, Philippine Coast Guard, Romblon State University, the Local Government Units (LGUs) of the different municipalities, non-government organizations (NGOs) and the individual constituents of each municipality.

**MONTH OF THE OCEAN (MOO) 2022**  
**Coastal Clean-up and Crown-of-Thorns Starfish (COTS) Removal Activity**  
May 21, 2022

In line with the celebration of Month of the Ocean (MOO) for CY-2022, Department of Environment and Natural Resources – Province of Romblon conducted a synchronized Coastal Clean-up and Crown-of-Thorns Starfish (COTS) removal activity on May 21, 2022 at the province of Romblon.

A short program hosted by the Conservation and Development Section was held at the covered court of Canduyong, Odiongan, Romblon before proceeding to the activity. Opening prayer was given by SI Eric Hindap followed by the singing of the national anthem.

Punong Barangay Jerry Tambucon of Canduyong gave welcome remarks to the volunteers and expressed his gratitude in behalf of barangay Canduyong for the coastal clean-up and COTS removal activity in their barangay.

Afterwards, the participants/volunteers was acknowledge by the host. The activity was participated by DENR employees, BFAR, PNP-DILG, PCG, Romblon State University, Kadbayan MPC, TIELCO, LGU-MAO, BLGU, BFARMC/Bantay Dagat members, and constituents of Barangay Canduyong.

Then, MSD Chief Thelmo S. Hernandez, In-Charge of PENRO Romblon gave an inspirational message focusing on the theme of this year's MOO "*Protect and Restore Ecosystems and Biodiversity*". He emphasized that the protection and restoration of our marine ecosystems starts within us and by having a sense of ownership and responsibility, we can better protect our natural resources.

Consequently, representatives from academe, other national government agencies, and CSOs gave their words of commitment to the DENR's projects, programs and activities. They are very supportive of these activities and committed to render their full support and participation in the protection and restoration of our ecosystems and biodiversity.

Lastly, Engr. Raymund G. Inocencio delivered the closing remarks and gave final instructions before proceeding to the activity.

Volunteers dispersed onto the coastline of Canduyong to conduct the coastal clean-up activity. Meanwhile, the Office of Municipal Agriculturist-Fishery Sector, along with volunteers from BFAR, and Bantay Dagat members spearheaded the COTS removal activity. The activity was held at Canduyong Fish Sanctuary located at Sitio Bagulayag, Canduyong, Romblon. Fortunately, there was no outbreak of COTS in the area and only three (3) COTS were extracted and buried after.





Other municipalities that enjoined in the celebration of MOO are the municipalities of Looc, Ferrol, Sta. Fe, Calatrava, San Agustin, Magdiwang, Cajidiocan, and San Fernando, Romblon.

They have conducted coastal clean-up activities in their respective municipalities participated by volunteers from the different sectors of society. The municipality of Sta. Fe also conducted Crown-of-Thorns Starfish (COTS) removal activity and extracted a total of six (6) COTS at Subang Bay, Brgy. Danao Norte, Sta. Fe, Romblon.

Overall, a total of five hundred sixty-five (565) volunteers composed of 301 male and 264 female from ten (10) different municipalities in the province of Romblon have joined in the celebration of Month of the Ocean (MOO) 2022 through the conduct of coastal clean-up and Crown-of-Thorns Starfish (COTS) removal activity.


Approximately, about one hundred eighteen (118) sacks of non-biodegradable and residual wastes were collected and disposed properly in the corresponding landfill areas of each municipality. Meanwhile, only nine (9) COTS were extracted during the COTS removal activity at Odiongan and Sta. Fe, Romblon.

This is in compliance to the instruction regarding the abovementioned subject in celebration of Month of the Ocean 2022. Please be informed that DENR Sibuyan Sub-Station and Protected Area Management Office personnel assisted in the synchronized coastal clean up in the whole island of Sibuyan. A total of 239 individuals composed of 112 male and 127 female participated in the activity.

## RATIONALE

In connection to the celebration of the “Month of the Ocean” (MOO), which is celebrated annually in the Philippines during the month of May by virtue of Presidential Proclamation No. 57 issued in 1998. For this year’s MOO, theme is adopting the UNESCO’s Ocean Decade Challenge 2 “Protect and Restore the Ecosystems and Biodiversity”, which aims to understand the effects of multiple stressors on ocean ecosystems and develop solutions to manage and restore the ecosystems and the rich biological diversity found therein under changing environment and social conditions.

## HIGHLIGHT OF ACTIVITIES

The activity was conducted by the three municipalities of Sibuyan. LGU Magdiwang conducted their coastal clean up on May 20, 2022 headed by the MENR Office and participated by LGU Magdiwang personnel. There were 72 participants composed of 30 male and 42 female.

For LGU Cajidiocan, different coastal barangays were tapped of the LGU Cajidiocan for the conduct of the activity on May 21, 2022. Romblon State University also participated in the activity whereas students and staffs were encouraged to be involved in the Coastal Clean Up. There are 123 attendees in the Cajidiocan composed of 54 male and 67 female.
