A. PRELIMINARIES

The PAMB meeting started at 9:50 am with a prayer led by Ms. Candice Joy Arnaiz followed by the singing of the National Anthem.

B. MEETING PROPER

I. Determination of Quorum

Ms. Faith Bangalisan made a roll call of members and declared the quorum of 31 out of 43 PAMB En Banc members.

II. Call to Order

In the absence of the PAMB Chair, Hon. Rosano B. Llanera, the Sangguniang Bayan (SB) Committee Chair on Tourism was voted to act as the Presiding Officer.

III. Presentation and approval of the provisional agenda

The Protected Area Superintendent (PASu) Mildred A. Suza presented the provisional agenda and the Presiding Officer seek comments, suggestions or additional agenda from the Board.

Hon. Templado requested to include the Bgy. Development Plan of Bgy. Masagana, EL Nido, Palawan, while Mr. David suggested to include the invitation to Regional Executive Director (RED) to personally attend the PAMB meeting.

The following were the provisional agenda for endorsement/adoption/acceptance:

1. Clarification on the requirements and development fee to be collected for Special Use Agreement in Protected Areas (SAPA) of non-profit projects of government agencies and Local Government Units (LGUs) per memorandum from the Regional Executive Director (RED) Maria Lourdes G. Ferrer dated October 6, 2021;
2. Comments on the conducted PAMB ENBANC held on September 24, 2019;
 - a. Barangay Ordinance No. 5, Series of 2018 "An Ordinance Regulating the Operation of Kayak in Small and Big Lagoon, Bgy. Bebeladan, El Nido, Palawan and imposing fees therefore and other purposes.
3. Presentation of Integrated Protected Area Fund (IPAF) collection and utilization based on Work and Financial Plan (WFP) from CY 2016 to date;

4. Presentation of Work and Financial Plan (WFP) for Integrated Protected Area Fund (IPAF) CY 2022 for approval and endorsement;
5. Presentation of Protected Area Suitability Assessment (PASA), Technical Working Group (TWG) and Work and Financial Plan;
6. PAMB Capacity Building;
7. SAPA application updates;
8. Updates on the Green Economy Model (GEM) implementation;
9. Bgy. Development Plan of Bgy. Masagana, EL Nido, Palawan;
10. Inviting Regional Executive Director (RED) to personally attend the PAMB meeting; and,
11. Toilet Projects in islands of El Nido.

Without further recommendations, Mr. Conrado David motioned for the adoption of the provisional agenda and was seconded by Hon. Jon Tumampil, Bgy. Chairperson of Cataban, Taytay. The body adopted and approved the provisional agenda.

IV. Review and approval of the Minutes of the previous meeting

The Presiding Officer sought for comments, clarifications or corrections in the minutes of the previous meeting.

There is no minor correction in the minutes, Hon. Cyril Zumarraga motioned for the approval of the minutes of previous meeting and was seconded by Mr. David.

The Committee members unanimously adopted and approved the minutes of the previous meeting.

V. Matters arising from the previous minutes

Hon. Zumarraga follow-up the status of project proposals of Bgy. Bebeladan, Corong-corong and Villa Libertad.

PASu Suza answered that among the 3 projects mentioned, pontoons and mooring buoys for Bgy. Bebeladan was already installed, Fishing buoys for Corong-corong on the bidding process. Nursery proposal of Villa Libertad is being subjected for review and endorsement to Regional Office. She further encouraged the other barangays to submit their proposals.

APASu Casel added that PAMO accomplished the Biodiversity Eco-Friendly (BDFE) training for the Peoples Organizations (PO) of Bgy. Sibaltan, El Nido, Palawan, the next target is for the proposed Dewil Mangrove Eco-tourism for Bgy. New Ibajay, El Nido, Palawan.

PENRO Saños suggested that the PAMO should acknowledge and reply the status of the project proposals of the proponent.

Hon. Cantuba further requested the PAMO to assist the barangays on preparation of their proposals.

VI. Business of the day

- 1. Clarification on the requirements and development fee to be collected for Special Use Agreement in Protected Areas (SAPA) of non-profit projects of government agencies and Local Government Units (LGUs) per memorandum from the Regional Executive Director (RED) Maria Lourdes G. Ferrer dated October 6, 2021;**

PASu Suza presented the Memorandum from the Regional Executive Director (RED) Maria Lourdes G. Ferrer dated October 6, 2021 regarding the clarification on the requirements and Development fee to be collected for Special Use Agreement in Protected Areas (SAPA) of non-profit projects of government agencies and Local Government Units (LGUs).

Hon. Templado shared that the Barangays Bebeladan, Bagong-bayan and Palawan State University (PSU) have proposed projects in timberland area, they are asking how they can claim

proof of ownership to build their projects. He further added that according to the response of Regional Office, they must follow the SAPA guidelines, DAO 2021-07 and one-time payment for government project.

Hon. Antonio Cabras assured that their project in Kiminawit is within timberland. He further asked if the requirements for SAPA of government projects are different with private.

PASu Suza answered that the PAMO will provide checklist to barangays to guide them and based on the presented memo, same requirement are needed to be submitted.

Hon. Reynoso asks if there's no option regarding this matter, he admitted that this is difficult for them.

Hon. Llanera suggested if possible to create resolution requesting the Regional Office and the Hon. Secretary of DENR to waive the projects of BLGU and LGU.

Mr. David motioned to approve resolution requesting the Regional Office and the Hon. Secretary of DENR for the consideration to waive all SAPA fees for all Government projects from Municipal to Barangay level. Duly seconded by Hon. Cabras.

CENRO Valle added that the PAMB should provide a guide on creating the resolution regarding this matter. He further cited that according to ENIPAS, government projects were already waive in SAPA fees but the CENRO emphasized that the office cannot issue or provide authority or ownership over the area.

Hon. Cantuba asked if possible to create a resolution regarding the titling. The presiding officer, answered that it is possible.

Without further queries, Hon. Cantuba motioned to approve the resolution requesting the DENR Secretary to lift the moratorium on titling in El Nido. Mr. David second the motion.

2. Comments on the conducted PAMB ENBANC held on September 24, 2019; Barangay Ordinance No. 5, Series of 2018 "An Ordinance Regulating the Operation of Kayak in Small and Big Lagoon, Bgy. Bebeladan, El Nido, Palawan and imposing fees therefore and other purposes

APASu informed the Board regarding the Memorandum from the Regional Executive Director (RED) Maria Lourdes G. Ferrer regarding the comments on the Barangay Ordinance No. 5, Series of 2018 "An Ordinance Regulating the Operation of Kayak in Small and Big Lagoon, Bgy. Bebeladan, El Nido, Palawan and imposing fees therefore and other purposes. He further asked Hon. Antonio Cabras, the updates on their collection.

Hon. Cabras, answered that they have guidelines on utilization of the said fee, which states that 35% collected fees was for environmental projects, 25% are for the personnel manning the kayak in lagoon, while the 10% was provided to their local residents requesting for financial assistance. He further added that they can provide or make a presentation regarding the details of their collection, if needed.

3. Presentation of Integrated Protected Area Fund (IPAF) collection and utilization based on Work and Financial Plan (WFP) from CY 2016 to date

Mr. Herson Caliao presented the Integrated Protected Area Fund (IPAF) collection and utilization based on Work and Financial Plan (WFP) from CY 2016 to date. The 75% pf IPAF collection since 2016 was Php26,000,000.00, the highest collection was recorded during 2019 amounting to Php40,464,015.00 including all the fees being collected by the PAMO. A total of Php 56,314,178.77 was deposited to PA Retention Income Accounts as of October 2021.

He added that based on the WFP of 2019 amounting to Php10,485,000, Php3,757,421.39 was utilized and the remaining balance Php 6,727,578.61 intended to purchase pick-up, speed boat, motorcycle and 2 units of pontoons/mooring buoys. The un-utilized budget was included on the WFP of 2021 for implementation.

IPAF budget utilization of WFP 2021 is Php 17,078,816.00, where 3,321,893.00 was utilized as of November 16, 2021 including the salary of Contract of Service (COS) for the month of September 2021.

Mr. David acknowledge the effort of PAMO to present the details to the Board as it was requested by them. He further added that the PAMO should utilize the remaining balance.

Hon. Tumampil commented that the presentation should include the disbursements.

PASu Suza answered that the balance is allocated for payment of the purchases such as pick-up, motorcycle, speed boat and fishing buoys. She further added that, to date, the PAMO is waiting for the authority to purchase for bidding to commence. The PAMO already re-submitted the requirements to DBM this year.

4. Presentation of Work and Financial Plan (WFP) for Integrated Protected Area Fund (IPAF) CY 2022 for approval and endorsement

CENRO-Taytay, Planning Officer Lanie Jane Rey presented the Work and Financial Plan (WFP) for Integrated Protected Area Fund (IPAF) CY 2022 for approval and endorsement. The computed amount for the Work and Financial Plan CY 2022 is Php13,489,000.00, to procure of support and facilities, hiring of staff and enforcement personnel and targets under the Protected Area Management and Development, Biodiversity Conservation and Ecosystem Management, Partnership and Resiliency Building, Improved Sustainable Financing, PAMB Operationalization, Enforcement of Environmental laws in PA, Program Management and Supervision.

Hon. Zumarraga asked proposed exact location of 35 fishing buoys to be procured. Ms. Rey replied that these are the project of Mabini with a Php50,000.00/lot cost, she further asked if one of the members have an idea how much fishing buoys costs, to revise the computed amount.

Hon. Zumarraga suggested to move the capacity building on first quarter of 2023, since election is about to come.

Hon. Llanera also added to include the monitoring and collection of Crown-of-Thorns (COT) on the WFP. Capacity building will still be included since not all members are ex-officio.

PASu Suza answered that the PAMO can hold a 1-day orientation regarding PAMB matters for the newly elected members. The PAMO will decide the dates and venue.

Mr. David emphasized that including capacity building and monitoring and collection of COT was important. He further asks if there's supplementary budget.

Ms. Rey answered that we can submit Work and Financial Plan for supplementary budget in a separate presentation but the approval of RED takes time.

Hon. Zumarraga asked if possible to include a salary for drivers in each barangay.

PASu Suza answered that we cannot accommodate such requests, recently the nursery proposal of Bgy. Villa Libertad was revised because they included the wages for their staff. She reminded the members that we have allocated are Forest Protection Officers (FPO) in each barangay.

Hon. Zumarraga said that the drivers can be the operating person of dump trucks collecting trash in compliance with guidelines of LGU.

Hon. Llanera instructed the secretariat to confirm if this is possible.

Hon. Zumarraga if we can provide 2 FPOs each barangay.

Ms. Rey answered that FPOs became a regular target in WFP, the budget has been fixed though the member can suggest to make it 2 per barangay, depending on the budget we have. She further added that we have guidelines to follow, the hired FPO should monitor a certain hectare of forest to justify why we are hiring.

CENRO Valle added that the regular area per FPO is 2,000 hectares. If the barangay has conservation area of 4,000 hectare and above, it is suitable for them to have 2 FPOs.

Hon. Zumarraga asked that if this WFP will be approved, how we can add the propose 2 FPOs per barangay.

PASu Suza reminded the members, that the approval of PASA was delayed because it needs to be affirmed by the PAMB enbanc thus, it was not implemented this year. This PAMO will work on supplemental, we will have another meeting to answer the queries of barangay chairpersons and the preparation of another WFP.

Mr. David asked if there is no provisional budget for the suggestions of Bgy. Chairpersons to resolve the budget upon approval.

Ms. Rey mentioned that the said FPOs can be hired under Program Management Services (PMS), we just have to adjust the amount in PMS and re-define the UACS to hire 2 FPOs in barangays who needs it.

Hon. Zumarraga said that only 10 barangays have truck.

Hon. Llanera asked the members who preferred 2 FPOs per barangay. Majority of the Board voted for the said question. And the secretariat noted the proposed additional FPO for each barangay.

PENRO suggested that 1 FPO will report to the PAMO and the other one depends on the barangay.

APASu Casel asked how much will be the budget for the COT collection.

Hon. Llanera suggested to make it Php50,000 which was noted by the Secretariat.

Without further queries, Hon. Rodante Reynoso motioned for the approval of Work and Financial Plan (WFP) for IPAF CY 2022 to include all additional input from the Board, duly seconded by Hon. Cabras. Majority of the Board voted for the approval.

VII. Committee Reports

1. Executive Committee Meeting

Ms. Bangalisan informed the Board that there is a conducted PAMB Executive Committee (ExeCom) meeting held on August 19, 2021 at Jurias Garden Hotel, Bgy. Maligaya, El Nido, Palawan. She also mentioned that during the meeting the request of Royal Premiere for the deferment of their SAPA Annual fee was presented and endorsed by the committee for affirmation of enbanc.

Mr. David defended that the reason of their approval was because we are in a pandemic situation.

Hon. Cantuba asked if their application was already approved. It was confirmed by Ms. Bangalisan.

Hon. Cantuba mentioned that the approval of this application was not thoroughly deliberated. To date, they closed the right of way of local fisherman and threatening them using firearms. The proponent also did not comply with their requested copy of map of their project.

CENRO Valle also said that the PAMO is also looking for their original map having 80 hectares while easement was not observed.

PENRO Saños suggested to request the proponent the submission of original map since their approve land cover was only 30 hectares. PASu Suza commented that the map has been requested to Royal Premier thru series of request letter from PAMO.

372 Hon. Cantuba motioned for the deferment of the request of Royal Premier SAPA Annual
373 Fee, duly seconded by Hon. Sitjar. Majority of the Board voted for the deferment of the said request
374 until the map has been submitted by the proponent both to PAMO and barangay.
375

376 Ms. Bangalisan added that there is another PAMB Execom conducted held on October 12,
377 2021 at PAMO Conference, Bgy. Masagana, El Nido, Palawan, among the agenda discussed
378 includes the proposed filming of Survivor Russia, hence endorsed to enbanc, subject for
379 affirmation of the Board.
380

381 Hon. Zumarraga mentioned that such filming activities should have proper coordination
382 with the concerned barangays for issuance of barangay certification. The concern was noted by
383 Secretariat to include as one of the requirements.
384

385 Hon. Reynoso reiterated the comments of Hon. Zumarraga. Hon. Cantuba further added
386 that the proponent should be present during meeting to personally answer the queries to them.
387

388 PASu informed the Board that the survivor coordinated with the PAMO days before the
389 event. She also mentioned that based on the previous PAMB meeting, it was agreed that filming
390 activities do not need to be presented in PAMB meeting as long as they are compliant to terms and
391 conditions and paying filming fees. The PAMO also ensured that the proponent will not violate
392 the terms and conditions provided and they submit affidavit of undertaking.
393

394 Mr. David motioned for the approval of the proposed filming activity of Survivor Russia,
395 duly seconded by Hon. Cabras. Majority of the Board voted for the approval.
396

397 **2. Committee on Project Development**

398

399 Ms. Bangalisan reported the updates on Project Development Committee presented during
400 the PAMB execom meeting held on October 12, 2021. The project of Department of Public Works
401 and Highways (DPWH), Manlalic Bridge II Flood Control was endorsed and subject for
402 affirmation of the enbanc.
403

404 The said project is on-going but they already submitted the complete plan and all necessary
405 requirements in securing PAMB endorsement.
406

407 Without further queries, Hon. Cantuba motioned for the endorsement of Manlalic Bridge
408 II Flood Control, duly seconded by Hon. Ricky Ballena. Majority of the Board voted for the said
409 project.
410

411 **3. Committee on Conflict Resolutions**

412

413 Ms. Bangalisan presented the "Resolution Adopting the Guidelines of Management
414 Strategies for Tourism Activities in Big and Small Lagoon in El Nido, Palawan". She added that
415 the said resolution was endorsed by the Execom for affirmation of PAMB enbanc. Consultation
416 with the stakeholders was made before the approval in execom.
417

418 Since it was already discussed on the previous enbanc meeting, Hon. Cabras motioned
419 for the approval of "Resolution Adopting the Guidelines of Management Strategies for Tourism
420 Activities in Big and Small Lagoon in El Nido, Palawan", duly seconded by Mr. David. Majority
421 of the Board voted for the said project.
422

423 Hon. Llanera explained that the LGU Tourism have a proposal of constructing boardwalk
424 in Big Lagoon, worth of twenty million to be funded by their loan, if approval becomes favorable.
425

426 Mr. David answered that resolution can be revoked if there is a proposal for development.
427

428 APASu informed the Board that the Tourism has already communicated with the PAMO,
429 it was highlighted on the letter the propose development in Big Lagoon, amounting twenty million.
430

431 Hon. Cabras commented that the said development was promising. He also mentioned
432 that this boardwalk proposal can affect their kayak operation in Lagoon.
433

434 Hon. Llanera compared the situation in Coron. The LGU can create and ordinance, with
435 the provisions of barangay share. He further added that the LGU has loans for the proposed
436 development.

437
438 Noted by Hon. Cabrasas.

439
440 **4. Committee on External Communication and Public Information**

441
442 Ms. Faith informed the Board that the Committee on External and Public Information
443 convened on September 12 and 22, 2021 to discuss the planned activities in celebration of
444 ENTMRPA anniversary. The original plan was to have an IEC on the afternoon of October 8, 2021
445 but due to the increase of COVID19 positive in the municipality it was re-scheduled to October
446 29, 2021, since Emergency Operation Committee (EOC) made restrictions on mass gatherings, the
447 anniversary was conducted to a half-day event in Bgy. Maligaya, El Nido, Palawan, an open space.

448
449 **5. Committee on Project Development**

450
451 The Committee Chairperson, Engr. Daria Eboras presented the following projects were
452 deliberated by the Committee during their meeting on November 16, 2021 at PAMO Conference
453 Room.

454
455 **SAPA Application of El Nido Enclaves Resort**

456
457 Engr. Eboras presented the SAPA Application of El Nido Enclaves Resort owned by the
458 Enclaves Resort Inc. represented by Ms. Levya G. Pasion located at Sitio Pinangantengan,
459 Pasadena, El Nido, Palawan with a total of 15, 500 square meters in a timberland area.

460
461 As per inspection conducted by the CPD, there is no development in the area and complied
462 with all lacking requirements. It was recommended for PAMB approval.

463
464 Without further queries, Hon. Mateo Cantuba motioned for the approval of the proposed
465 SAPA Application of El Nido Enclaves Resort, duly seconded by Hon. Conchita Panaguiton.
466 Majority of the Board voted for the approval.

467
468
469 **SAPA Application of the Last Paradise Resort**

470
471 She further presented the SAPA Application of The Last Paradise Resort owned by Mr.
472 Jorge Dela Torre represented by Ms. Rosalinda Arenas located at Seven Commans, Buena Suerte,
473 El Nido, Palawan having a total of 5,124 square meter in a timberland area.

474
475 There are no signs of development in the area, thus the Committee recommended the
476 approval for the said proposal.

517 The proposed project consists of 181 Residential Lots; 15 commercial areas, office, clinic,
518 Swimming pool basketball court, road system, support facilities, waste water management facility,
519 solid waste management facilities.

521 Without further queries, Hon. Tamayosa motioned for the approval of El Nido Hilltop
522 Village II Residential lots duly seconded by Hon. Ballena. Majority of the Board voted for the
523 approval.

525 **El Nido Prime Residences Residential lots**

526
527 El Nido Prime Residences Residential lots is also owned by the JD Paradise Realty
528 Development Corporation at Bgy. Bagong-bayan, El Nido, Palawan with a total land area of
529 92,279 square meter, to be constructed in Alienable and Disposable (A&D) land.

530
531 The proposed project consists of 290 Residential Lots; 20 commercial areas, office, clinic,
532 Swimming pool basketball court, open/common spaces, road system, support facilities, waste
533 water management facility, solid waste management facilities

534
535 Without further queries, Hon. Delos Santos motioned for the approval of El Nido Prime
536 Residences Residential lots duly seconded by Hon. Reynoso. Majority of the Board voted for the
537 approval.

538
539 **5. Presentation of Protected Area Suitability Assessment (PASA), Technical**
540 **Working Group (TWG) and Work and Financial Plan**

541
542 PASu Suza informed the Board that the PASA and Work and Financial Plan (WFP) was
543 already discussed during PAMB Executive Committee but needs affirmation from the PAMB
544 Enbanc. She further discussed the proposed Technical Working Group (TWG) on the
545 implementation and conduct of PASA.

WHEREAS, the Committee agreed to favorably endorse the above activity provided that the proponent shall:

- a. acknowledge the ENTMRPA-PAMO and LGU of El Nido in the documentation and further furnish this office a copy/ies of the documentation at least one (1) month after the conduct of the activity;
- b. Strictly observe no collection of any marine/terrestrial resources within protected area without clearance from Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD);
- c. not damage the natural landscape and seascape of the protected areas and shall not contribute stress on living organism;
- d. Coordinate with the DENR-PAMO of El Nido from time to time to ensure that all activity/ies are consistent in Protected Area Management Plan (PAMP), PAMB policies, and other environmental laws, rules and regulations;

- e. pay the corresponding protected area administrative fees (Filming Fee) before the conduct of activity per Section 7 of DAO No. 2016-24 Revised Rate of Fees for Entrance and Use of Facilities and Resources in Protected Area;
- f. strictly follow the approve twelve (12) locations and schedule submitted to the PAMO and shall immediately inform the PAMO of any changes that may occur subject for approval; and,
- g. follow the terms and conditions and any violation shall be a ground for cancellation of the visitor's permit and will be subjected to penalties and legal sanction.

WHEREAS, the Big and Small Lagoon are the highlights in tourism activities within El Nido, Palawan;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Antonio D. Cabras Jr. and duly seconded by Mr. Conrado N. David to adopt the following policies and guidelines.

Title- This document shall be known as the "Guidelines of Management Strategies for Tourism Activities in Big and Small Lagoon in El Nido, Palawan"

Scope- These guidelines shall apply to tourism activities that are offering Island Hopping in Big and Small Lagoon.

Purpose- these guidelines aimed to properly regulate the tourism activities and the environmental impact and to promote sustainable tourism activities and practices.

Policies- In consideration of the protected area status of ENTMRPA, it is hereby declared that:

- a. Only DOT-accredited Tour operators with Business Permit within the Protected Area can benefit in the booking reservation of big and small lagoon;
- b. Strictly no entity may enter the Big and Small Lagoons without a QR Code/ Booking Confirmation and payment;
- c. Booked entity are allowed to enter one lagoon per day;
- d. Each DOT-accredited El Nido Tour Operators will be allowed up to fifteen (15) pax per lagoon on a first come-first served basis subject for review in the future.
- e. Bookings for the Big and Small Lagoons will start on 8:00 in the morning and 4:00 in the afternoon;
- f. Kayaking is allowed during low tide provided that walking at the entrance in big and small lagoon or disembarking from the kayak is prohibited; and,
- g. In case there will be an untoward incident/s (i.e illness, delayed flight and storm gale warning) the reservation will still valid if there is still available slots on that day of tour provided that they will have to present the medical certificate for illness and flight details.

Lagoon Marshall- The Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) staff will serve as Lagoon Marshall with the following functions;

- a. Maintain order and safety in the Lagoons;
- b. Monitor and record the tourist entry in the lagoons;
- c. Monitor and record the boats and boat operators/ crew, tour guide in lagoons;
- d. Collect the QR Code/ Booking Confirmation upon entry into the lagoons;
- e. Prevent and report any violation/s of the management guidelines in the Lagoons (i.e grilling, anchoring in corals, loud music, dragging kayak, alcohol consumption, fishing, littering, *bailing water out of a boat*); and,
- f. In case of emergency, the marshal will assist/s the safety officer;
- g. Facilitate reporting of violations from tour operators, resorts and other visitors of the lagoons:

Safety Officer- The Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) will hire personnel that will serve as Safety Officer with a relevant training/s and capabilities to impose the following functions;

- a. Conduct regular routine inspection in Small and Big lagoons to ensure the safeness of the tourist/s;
- b. Oversee the activity inside the big lagoon (i.e kayaking, stand-up paddle board and the like);
- c. In case, there will be an emergency, they will perform the first aid and life saver; and,
- d. They will be the first to come and the last to depart in lagoons;

Kayak- Kayak Operator/s may conduct business in Big and Small Lagoons with the following requirements;

- a. Endorse by the Protected Area Management Board (PAMB);
- b. With business permit;
- c. All health protocols specified by the local government must be complied with; and,

- d. Third party accident insurance policy must be submitted; and,
- e. Wearing of life vest while kayaking is mandatory:

*Meanwhile, travel and tour operators with permission to enter the lagoons can bring their own kayak for their guests.

Adjudication- All violators shall be subject to proper adjudication procedures for administrative action/s.




