This pertains on the subject above, the undersigned together with Park Rangers of this office performed marshal duty at Big and Small Lagoon located at Miniloc Island, Barangay Bebeladan, El Nido, Palawan.

The team performed marshal duties by collecting reservation slots and continuous monitoring inside the lagoon. As per duty, some of the boats have no reservation slots, reservation slots were sent via other boat, excess number of guests and guests refusing to wear their lifejackets. In addition, there were guests swimming where most of the corals were present. Further, there were also observed tour guides climbing the taraw to take photo for their guests and leaving them unattended.

There were already reports regarding tour guides and guest climbing the taraw to take photos, the team recommends additional personnel to monitoring inside the lagoon and to conduct communication education and public awareness (CEPA) regarding policies and guidelines inside big and small lagoon.

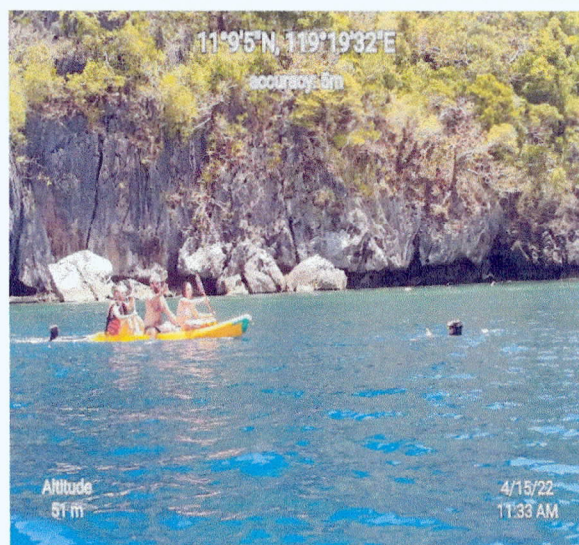
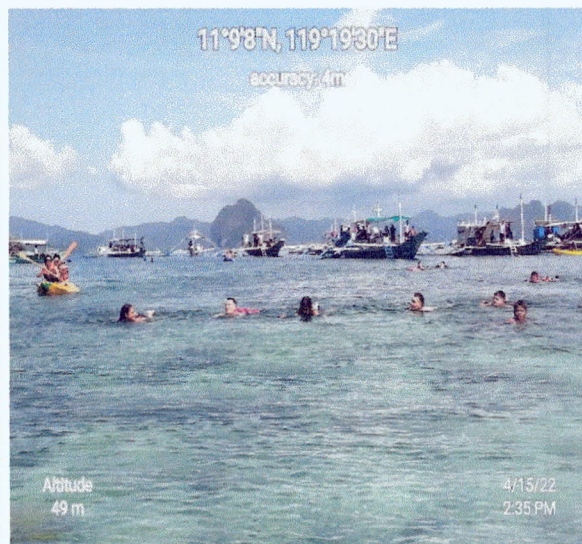
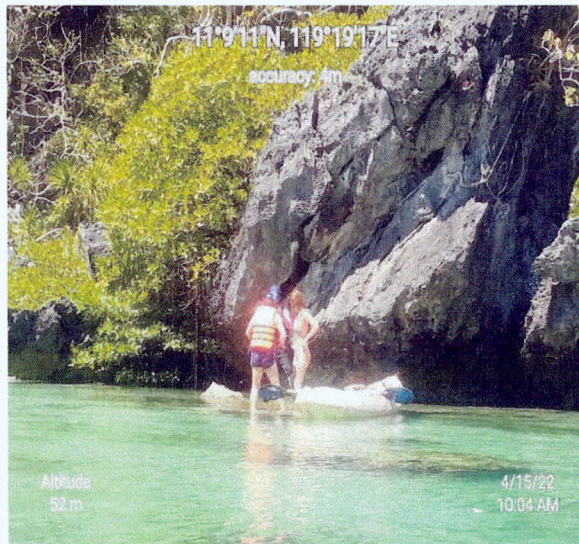


Photo shows the guests swimming around the undesignated areas where corals are present.

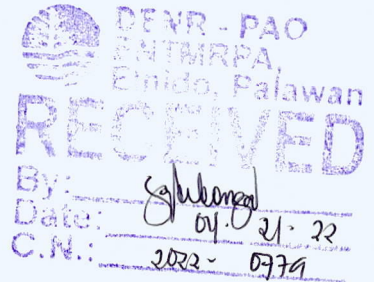

**SUBJECT** : **REPORT ON TURTLE NEST AT BIG LAGOON, MINILOC ISLAND, BARANGAY BEBELADAN, EL NIDO, PALAWAN**



This pertains on the subject above, the undersigned together with park ranger of this office conducted monitoring on the turtles nest transferred from small lagoon to big lagoon located at Miniloc Island, Barangay Bebeladan, El Nido, Palawan dated April 4-6. The turtle nest was observed last March 19, 2022 around 5:30 pm by the land guard of Miniloc island during his visit to small lagoon, he then transferred the turtle eggs due to the predators present in the area.

Further, the team also observed turtle tracks where the turtles often lay their nest, due to the present of predators such as monitor lizard the turtle false tracks occur.

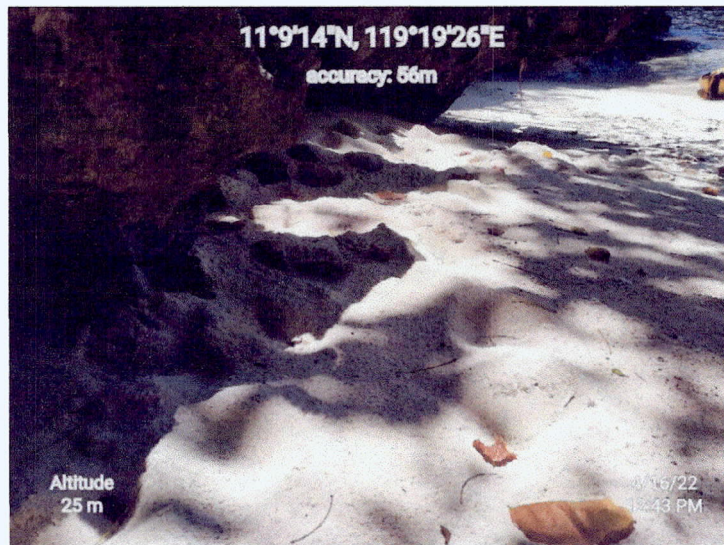
There were already reports regarding turtle nest observed at small lagoon, the team recommends continuous monitoring on the area.

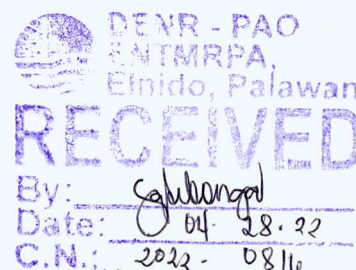

This pertains on the subject above, the undersigned together with Park Rangers of this office performed marshal duty at Big and Small Lagoon located at Miniloc Island, Barangay Bebeladan, El Nido, Palawan.

The team performed marshal duties by collecting reservation slots and continuous monitoring inside the lagoon. As per duty, there were observed guests swimming at the deep part of the lagoon and guests climbing the taraw to take photos. The team also observed lacking of kayaks due to exceeding number of guests arriving between 10:00 am to 3:00 pm at Big Lagoon. In addition, the team also observed guests *kayaking* where the corals are present.

The team recommends additional personnel to further monitor inside big and small lagoon. The team also recommends putting marking bouys around the coral area where the kayaks were constantly passed by.

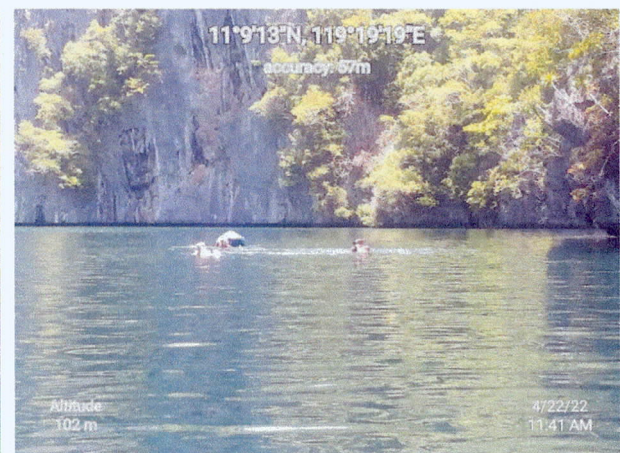
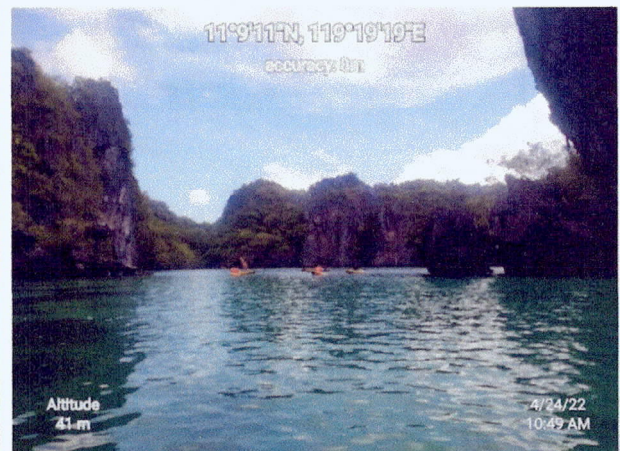
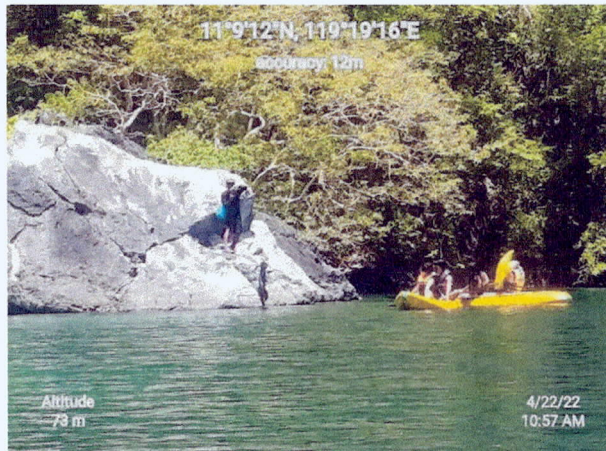
