# PROGRESS REPORT-FOCUS GROUP DISCUSSION (FGD)

Proposed Establishment of Critical Habitat (CH) in Ginablan Wildlife,
Mangroves & Bird Sanctuary

Sitio Cahuyong, Ginablan, Romblon, Romblon

(2<sup>nd</sup> Qtr., C.Y. 2022)

#### I. BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE

# A. History

The Municipality of Romblon is the capital town of the province and composed of three islands with an aggregate area of 9,085.8607 hectares. It is bounded on the north and northwest by Tablas Strait, on the south and east by Sibuyan Sea. It has 31 barangays with three island barangays namely Barangays Alad, Cobrador and Logbon. Known as Marble Country of the Philippines, this municipality harbors vast natural resources that have many ecotourism potentials in particular its coastal & marine resources, and the rich cultural heritage.

In the lower mid-portion of this municipality found Barangay Ginablan with an area of about 145 hectares and geographical coordinates of 12°32' North, 122°15. It has population of 763 as of 2020 Census. The said barangay is 12 kilometers away from the town proper. As one of the unique coastal barangays, it possessed about 1.3-hectare lagoon that served as habitat of vulnerable and endemic Philippine Wild Duck locally known as "Pato del Mar" and other threatened bird species located at Sitio Cahuyong. Also found within the area is about 2 hectares mangrove area with extensive coralline sand flats, sea grass beds, offshore coral reefs and diverse marine species. Moreover, these natural resources threatened by rapid urbanization that needs to be sustainably protected, conserved and managed by all its stakeholders.

Accordingly, Section 4 and 25 of Republic Act No. 9147, otherwise known as the "Wildlife Resources Conservation and Protection Act" and the Rules 25.1-25.5 of Joint DENR-DA-PCSD Administrative Order No. 01, Series of 2004, and Executive Order No. 578 of 2006, the DENR issued Memorandum Circular No. 2007-02 that set the "Guidelines on the Establishment and Management of Critical Habitat.

## B. Goal and Objective/s

The activity aims to establish Critical Habitat in Ginablan Wildlife, Mangroves and Bird Sanctuary at Sitio Cahuyong, Ginablan, Romblon, Romblon.

Specifically, its objectives are:

1.) To identify/validate the presence of threatened species found in Ginablan Wildlife, Mangroves and Bird Sanctuary; and

2.) To determine the trends in use of resources, trends in status of selected resources, and trends in the number of households benefiting from the use of resources through Focus Group Discussion (FGD) with stakeholders in preparation to the conduct of population estimates and rapid habitat assessment.

# C. Methodology

The area proposed as Critical Habitat (CH) identified by DENR- PENRO under Conservation and Development Section (CDS) and funded under WFP 2022. The concerned CDS Team determined relevant issues and concerns existed in the area with support of photo documentation. The used of Global Positioning System (GPS) and Drone technologies applied to document vegetation and anthropogenic activities.

Using focus group discussion (FGD), the concerned technical personnel collated data and information in support to determine the trends in use or status of selected resources and the household benefited from it. In addition, it designed to get the local's view on their current environment as well as the sources of their livelihood in this barangay.

# **D.** Significance of the Activity

Primarily, the conduct of FGD of the proposed Critical Habitat in Ginablan Wildlife, Mangroves and Bird Sanctuary at Sitio Cahuyong, Ginablan, Romblon, Romblon served as input/baseline data on the scheduled conduct of population estimates and rapid habitat assessment in the next quarter.

Then, it deemed essential in ensuring the proper development, conservation and management efforts of the concerned entities for sustaining the biodiversity, thus improving the economic and livelihood of the communities in particular fisherfolks.

Initial results of this activity increased awareness and mobilized support from the local government units for effective and efficient management, conservation and enhancement of the area's critical habitat, thereby promoting it as potential ecotourism hub in the Municipality of Romblon.

In addition, the activity will generate data and information as basis for sustainable interventions needed in the area. Lastly, it also supports the objectives of the Municipal LGU of Romblon, Romblon towards developing the area for ecotourism.

#### II. COORDINATION

The concerned CDS Personnel coordinated with Municipal LGU of Romblon in particular Municipal Agriculture Office (MAO); Barangay LGU of Ginablan and Ginablan Fisherfolks

Association (GIFA) Inc. and adjacent coastal communities located at the capital town of Romblon, Romblon.

Based on this activity, the concerned offices in LGU's as well as the PO were supportive on the proposed establishment of the first Critical Habitat (CH) in the Province of Romblon as initiated by the DENR.

#### III. FGD RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

The FGD facilitated by ECOMS II Raymund G. Inocencio from CDS and actively participated by selected key stakeholders from LGU's, PO's, and DENR. The flow of the discussion were leveling of expectations in the conduct of FGD as a strategy, determination of main issues for discussion, trends on the resource uses/status especially fishery monitoring, priority species for monitoring, and the pertinent issues or human threats/pressures that affect the survival of the threatened species and its natural habitat.

# A. Leveling of Expectations

The participants expressed their expectations of the activity, facilitators, and co-participants; identified the expected outputs and outcomes and demonstrated understanding of the objectives on the said FGD.

The participants efficiently and productively discussed subject matter at hand in due time. Identified outputs and outcomes were the result of identification of main issues for discussion, trends on the resource uses/status especially fishery monitoring, priority species for monitoring, and the pertinent issues or human threats/pressures.

#### B. Main Issues Discussed

The resource uses chosen for monitoring were pertaining to fishing and gathering of shellfish and other coastal and marine products; presence of Philippine Wild Ducks (Pato del Mar) and other threatened birds; and the various coastal and marine resources (beaches, coral reefs, mangroves, lagoons, islet) found within and adjacent to the proposed critical habitat.

#### C. Trends on Resource Use/Status

The trends/status on resource use were generally declining particularly in terms of fish catch and gathering of shellfish and other coastal/marine products as compared in the past years. For instance, many subsistence fishermen caught 2 to 30 kilos of pelagic fish like Tamban, Talakitok, Hasa-hasa in previous years but this year around 11/2 kilo or less had been caught only using the same fishing gear (spear, push net, bottom gill net, scare line and net) and the time spent in fishing. Other species of fish caught were Katambak, Buyawis, Dalagang-bukid, Isdang-

bato, Tapuyok, Tuna, Tulingan and Magudlom. With regard to gathering of shellfish, one subsistence fisherfolk gathered around ¼ kilo of Sikad-sikad and Kuyapot within two hours during low tide.

Furthermore, the number of Phil. Wild Ducks observed in the lagoon of the proposed critical habitat observed to be declining from thousand in previous years to less than 400 individuals at present.

Lastly, the presence of islet, beaches, coral reefs and other coastal and marine resources adversely affected due to anthropogenic activities, urbanization, settlements and tourism developments.

# D. Priority Species Observed

The priority species observed for monitoring were birds, reptiles and mammals. Among the bird species were Pato del Mar, Alimukon, Kabog, Banog, Punay, Kusi, Kilyaw, Agumuom, Gitgit, Kurukutok, Tagutihot, Bukaw, Bahaw, Tangkali, Tikling, Lapay, Dugwak, Salimbabatang and Pikoy. Another reptile observed in the area was Bayawak (monitor lizard). The marine reptiles include Pawikan or marine turtle species while the marine mammals include Lumba-lumba (Dolphin) and Balyena (Whale).

#### E. Issues or Human Threats/Pressures

The main issue gathered in terms of fishery is the encroachment of commercial fishing vessels operating in waters within 15 kilometers (9 miles) of the Philippine coast — a zone that's off-limits for commercial fishing.

Other human threats/pressures observed that could adversely affect the proposed Critical Habitat (CH) were limited employment, encroachment of some informal settlers along the coastal area, urbanization causes biodiversity loss as well as land and water pollution, and unregulated tourism development.

# **IV. SUMMARY**

The main sources of livelihood in the Municipality of Romblon, Romblon were fishing, farming and marble quarrying. The development in these sectors shows significant disturbances in balanced ecosystem and compromises the biodiversity in the area.

Several threats observed such as encroachment of some informal settlers along the coastal area, urbanization and unregulated tourism development causes biodiversity loss as well as pollution of coastal areas are among the factors to be considered on the proposed establishment of Critical Habitat (CH).



#### V. RECOMMENDATIONS

Initial results of the field works and FGD validated/confirmed the presence of endemic and vulnerable Phil. Wild Ducks (Pato del Mar) and other wildlife species as well its threatened habitat caused by anthropogenic activities.

With this, we highly recommend that this Office will facilitate the conduct of population estimates and rapid habitat assessment of the proposed establishment of Ginablan Critical Habitat (CH) per DENR Memorandum Circular No. 2007-02.

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

A RESOLUTION ENACTING AN ORDINANCE DECLARING SITIO CAHUYONG, BARANGAY GINABLAN, ROMBLON, ROMBLON A WILDLIFE, MANGROVES AND BIRD SANCTUARY.

WHEREAS, Sitio Cahuyong in Barangay Ginablan, Romblon, Romblon is a diverse coastal ecosystem consisting of extensive coralline sand flats, mangroves, sea grass beds, and offshore coral reefs which are home to scores of various marine species;

WHEREAS, Sitio Cahuyong, is the best known flyway in the municipality for migrating birds which is the haven for migratory birds from other places seeking refuge from the winter climate of other countries;

WHEREAS, the birds use this place as a major refueling station as well as a wintering ground wherein the birds stop by the island on their journey back to their nesting grounds;

WHEREAS, the ecological balance in the Municipality of Rombion particularly in Barangay Ginablan is improving with the advent of statutes on wildlife conservation and preservation;

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WHEREAS, wildlife among birds are among divine endowment to man which are to be protected from harm because they are part of the ecological balance and food chain;

WHEREAS, to sustain the recovery from the ecological imbalance which is triggered by incessant hunting and other related activities of man, it is imperative to declare Sitio Cahuyong, Barangay Ginablan, Romblon, Romblon as a WILDLIFE, MANGROVES AND BIRD SANCTUARY;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Orlando Magano and duly seconded by members present the Body has -

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVES to enact the following Ordinance:

#### ORDINANCE NO. 23-2011

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING SITIO CAHUYONG, BARANGAY GINABLAN, ROMBLON, ROMBLON AS A WILDLIFE, MANGROVES AND BIRD SANCTUARY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Romblon, Romblon in session assembled that:

#### ARTICLE I - OBJECTIVES

SECTION 1. To sustain the recovery of the Municipality's improving ecological balance.

SECTION 2. To assist various environmental conservation efforts of the National Government Agencies.

## ARTICLE II - SCOPE

SECTION 1. This ordinance shall govern the provision of rules and regulations contributory to the maintenance of the ecological balance and the imposition of fees and penalties for violators within the territorial jurisdiction of Barangay Ginablan, Romblon, Romblon.

#### ARTICLE III - DEFINITION OF TERMS

SECTION 1. Definition of Terms – When used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall have the corresponding meaning.

- Hunting is the avert act and includes all preliminary acts of shooting, capturing, chasing and other similar acts directed against birds and wildlife.
- 2. Shooting means the intention to hit, kill or destroy the birds and wildlife through the use of air gun, slingshot and other similar gadgets.
- 3. Capture restraining the liberty of the birds and wildlife.
- 4. Wildlife means wild animals and birds including "Pato del Mar".

# ARTICLES IV - GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 1. No person shall be allowed to hunt, shoot, burn, capture wildlife within the territorial jurisdiction of Barangay Ginablan, Romblon, Romblon, except:

- 1. When it endangers lives of persons and property.
- 2. When it will be used to save lives and property.

However, when it shall be used to save lives and property and for educational purpose, a permit shall be secured from the Office of the Municipal Mayor based on the Certification from the Barangay Captain and confirmation of Ginablan Fisherfolks Association (GIFA), the appropriate authority concerned.

#### ARTICLE V - SPECIFIC PROHIBITIONS

The following acts shall constitute a violation of this Ordinance:

SECTION 1. Hunting, shooting and capturing of wild animals and birds including "Pato del Mar".

SECTION 2. Burning of beehives.

SECTION 3. Killing, wounding, taking, destroying, disturbing or taking away the nest or eggs of birds and "Pato del Mar" or keeping it in captivity.

SECTION 4. Destruction of habitats of any kind of wildlife.

SECTION 5. Violation of RA 9147 otherwise known as "An Act Providing For The Conservation And Protection Of Wildlife Resources And Their Habitats. Appropriating Funds Therefore And For Other Purposes".

SECTION 6. Violation of Section 94, RA 8550, conversion of mangroves to other uses.

#### ARTICLE VI - MISCELLANEOUS PROVISION

SECTION 1. No permit shall be issued to any person or entity where the purpose for which it is intended, runs counter with the principle of life preservation of birds and wildlife except under the circumstances under Art. IV. Sec. 1 par. 1 and 2 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. Any person may institute legal action against any one violating this Ordinance.

#### ARTICLE VII - FINES AND PENALTIES

SECTION 1. Administrative Fines. Any barangay officials, officers and members of GIFA and other concerned person or entity found violating this Ordinance shall be made to pay a fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00) for every violation hereof, payable to the barangay concerned.

SECTION 2. Penalty Clause. Violation of any provision of this Ordinance shall be punishable with the following:

First Offense – Fine of P500.00 with community service of 5 hours.

Second Offense – Fine of P1,000.00 with community service of 8 hours.

Third Offense - Fine of P2,500.00 or an imprisonment of not more than one (1) month or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 3. Fines and penalties shall be apportioned as follows: (a) 30% for the Municipal Government; (b) 30% for the Ginablan Fisherfolks Association (GIFA); and (c) 40% for the Barangay Government.

SECTION 4. In the event that private individual institute a legal action to any violator of this Ordinance, a 10% shall be given to him/her as an incentive which shall be taken from the 40% share of the barangay.

SECTION 5. The Barangay Treasurer shall be deputized to collect and issue Official Receipts.

#### ARTICLE VIII - FINAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 1. Repealing Clause. Any ordinance or regulatory provision inconsistent with any of the provision of this ordinance is hereby amended.

SECTION 2. Separability Clause. If for any reason any part of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, part or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in force and effect.

SECTION 3. Effectivity - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.




