

Dear Sir/Madam:

This is to formally complain Mayor Sue S. Cudilla of the Municipality of Araceli, Palawan for failure to implement the Ecological Solid Waste Management Plan (ESWMP) as part of the 10-year Solid Waste Management Plan (SWMP) of the municipality, duly evaluated by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources-Environmental Management Bureau (DENR-EMB), Region IV-B, through Palawan Council for Sustainable Development Staff (PCSDS) dated March 5, 2019.

As per evaluation of the ESWMP, the PCSDS rated the said plan with 97.22% compliance or 105 out of 108 required critical sections of the plan. For the period of almost one year, (July 1, 2019 to June 8, 2020), the Municipal Mayor did not take any action to comply with the ESWMP and was negligent in the disposal of solid waste and management of Material Recovery Facility (MRF) which is a clear violation of Republic Act 9003 or the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000. Attached herewith are pictures dated May 29, 2020 and relevant documents (ESWMP, transmittal of the 10-year SWMP) that may be needed in the evaluation of the violated provisions of the said act.

Anticipating your immediate appropriate action on this complaint.


