


SUBJECT : **SUBMISSION OF REPORT ON THE CELEBRATION OF THE

SUBJECT : **CELEBRATION OF THE MONTH OF THE OCEAN 2022**

In celebration of the Month of the Ocean 2022, a lecture entitled *Crown-of-Thorns Starfish (COTS): A threat to Coral Cover* was delivered to the participants mainly from the Local Government Unit of Gloria, Oriental Mindoro and members of Philippine National Police which was held at Session Hall of the municipality of Gloria, Oriental Mindoro on May 24, 2022.

The lecture aims to inform the participants on the state of the Philippine ocean including the status of the country's marine species diversity, current issues of the coral cover of the Philippines mainly due to Crown-of-Thorns Starfish (COTS) or *Acanthaster planci* infestation, COTS biology and methods of collection (manual, biological control, single injection and its predators), coral baseline data (surveyed reefs across the Philippines) and coral reef degradation.
